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Findability



- On-going mapping research commissioned by the EFADs (European Film Agencies Directors) covering all 31 EFADs members (incl Norway).
- Results January 2019

- "Direct" financial obligations concerning investment in European production (including independent), for example through pre-acquisition and/or co-production by broadcasters and VOD services;
- a. "Indirect" financial obligations, such as obligations to contribute to film funds through taxes and levies on theatres, broadcasters, VOD services, online platforms, etc. The actual income for each national/federal film and audiovisual fund through these sources will also be reflected and if possible its proportion on the overall budget.
- Quotas on transmission time of European works (including independent) for broadcasters and minimum share of European works in catalogues for VOD services;
- Prominence obligations on VOD platforms

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Types of mandatory financial obligations

« Direct » financial obligations

- Programming budget
- Pre-acquisition and/or production

« Indirect » financial obligations

Financial contribution to film fund (restricted / unrestricted)

Diversity of national schemes

- Obligations on public and/or private broadcasters
- Fixed in law / public service contract / framework agreement
- Different calculation criteria (revenue threshold, programmes..)



Examples of mandatory contributions to film funds by VOD services

Czech Republic

Mandatory 0,5% fee on the price paid by end-user of their service in a calendar year to be paid to the Cinematography Fund

Croatia

2% of VOD service' annual gross income to the Croatian AV Centre

Belgium (Fr. C)

Co-production or pre-purchase of rights or contribution to the film fund (minimum amount fixed based on the operator's annual turnover)

Portugal

When 1% of direct investment not attainted, unspent investment amounts are given to the Institute of Cinema and Audiovisual (ICA)



Mandatory contributions to film funds by targeting VOD services

Germany

VOD providers targeting Germany will be subject to a 2,5% levy on annual revenues (Filmabgabe) to the German film fund

France

VOD providers targeting France will be subject to a 2% tax on annual revenues to the general budget





Examples of mandatory financial contributions 28 by broadcasters (beyond Art. 17 AVMSD)

France

At least 15% of net annual revenues to EU and FRlanguage AV works + possibility of sub-quota for independent AV works



Italy

At least 12% (15% for PSB) of net annual revenues to independent AV works



SPAIN

Spain

5% annual revenues (6% PSB) (60% cinema film / 40% TV film and series) + sub-quotas to independent AV works



Examples of mandatory financial contributions by VOD services (implementation of Art. 13 AVMSD)

France

15% minimum of annual revenues to EU and FR-language AV works (12%)



Spain

5% annual revenues (60% cinema film / 40% TV film and series)



Portugal

1% minimum of revenues in the production of EU cinematographic works




Art. 16 AVMSD Minimum proportion of broadcasting time of European AV works






Art. 13 AVMSD **Share of European works** in the catalogues



place particular emphasis on the European works in their catalogue [...] by using an attractive presentation to highlight the list of European works available.

exhibition of visuals and making trailers available

enable the public to search for such works by origin

proper identification of origin of programmes available in the catalogue as well as providing the option to search for European works, or the placement of information and materials promoting European works
