

8.1 million people

were displaced across Europe (UNHCR, February 2023)



5.4 million people

were internally displaced within Ukraine with protracted (more than 6 month) displacement prevalent (IOM, January 2023)


BUSINESS RELOCATION AND JOB LOSSES



were forced to move to the western regions, only according to official data (Ministry of Reintegration, December 2022)





TASK: to develop a new version of the strategy based on current data about regions and communities, their challenges and problems. State regional policy is becoming more community-led




GEOINFORMATION SYSTEM MONITORING COMMUNITY CAPABILITIES

TASK: to create autonomous and decentralized process of energy supply, to develop of distributed generation, microgrid and smartgrid systems, to stabilize of life support systems of communities in the conditions of war and terrorist attacks of russia



KEY LEGISLATIVE INITIATIVES OF THE MINISTRY FOR RESTORATION 2023-2024

- reformatting of local state administrations into prefecture-type bodies
- Sestablishment of new legal and organizational principles of service in local self-government bodies
- improvement of the powers of local self-government bodies and the status of their officials during wartime and in the case of the creation of military administrations

KEY LEGISLATIVE INITIATIVES OF THE MINISTRY FOR RESTORATION WARTIME AND POST-WAR RESTORATION

improvement of financial decentralization mechanisms

- > enabling all territorial communities (not only municipal ones) to carry out local borrowing;
- > improving the administration of local taxes

development of tools for involving residents in making important decisions for the community

- > improvement of the order of organization, functioning and termination of the body of self-organization of the population;
- > development of people's power at the level of local self-government.
