## Steering Committee for the Rights of the Child (CDENF)

Abridged report of the 11th plenary meeting (Strasbourg, 1-2 April 2025)

#### Opening of the meeting and adoption of the agenda

The Steering Committee for the Rights of the Child (CDENF) held its 11th plenary meeting in Strasbourg (France) on 1-2 April 2025, with Ružica Boškić (Slovenia) in the Chair.

At its plenary meeting, the CDENF:

took note of and approved its workplan for 2025, to be updated as appropriate by the Secretariat in advance of the next plenary meeting;

#### elected:

- o Ružica Boškić (Slovenia) as its Chair for a second term of office of one year, starting on 1 July 2025:
- Solvor Bäcklund (Norway) as its Vice-Chair for a second term of office of one year, starting on 1 July 2025;

### designated:

- Maria João Fernandes (Portugal) as expert member of the Drafting Committee on Human Rights and Drug Policies (DH-PDA);
- Marino di Nardo (Italy) as CDENF representative as observer to the Committee of experts on access to origins (CJ-OR)
- welcomed the designation of Célia Chamiça, (Portugal), as CDENF reference person for digital technologies, including artificial intelligence;
- took note of the information provided on relevant transversal activities led by other Council of Europe bodies and sectors;
- took note of a presentation by Astrid Podsiadlowski, European Union Agency for Fundamental Rights (FRA), on research on the challenges and good practices towards integrated child protection systems:
- held an exchange of views and information on the national implementation of the Strategy for the Rights of the Child in 2023-2024 and during the first quarter of 2025;

- took note of a presentation on the Pathfinding Global Alliance to end all forms of violence against children, and held an exchange of views with Najat Maalla M'jid, UN Special Representative of the Secretary-General on Violence Against Children;
- took note of the update of the progress of the work of the Committee of Experts on the prevention of violence (ENF-VAE);
- took note of the presentation of the Draft Recommendation on age-appropriate comprehensive sexuality education to strengthen responses for inter-alia preventing and combating violence against children and provided first comments in the light of the ongoing written consultation on the draft document;
- **thanked** the outgoing Chair of ENF-VAE, Mária Vargová (Slovakia), for her important contribution to the work on the prevention of violence against children over the last two years;
- took note of the presentation of the draft report covering international and European law developments and case-law analysis for the thematic review of the Guidelines of the Committee of Ministers on child-friendly justice;
- **held a first exchange** with the consultant on the thematic review of the Guidelines on child-friendly justice in view of the upcoming written consultation process on the draft report;
- **took note** of information on the preparation towards the first meeting of Committee of Experts on access to child-friendly justice through multidisciplinary and Interagency services (ENF-JUS);
- took note of a presentation of a comparative study on tools and methods to ensure the best interests
  of the child in civil court proceedings in member and observer States developed in the framework of
  a cooperation project;
- **took note** of first elements of a Child Rights Impact assessment tool (CRIA) on artificial intelligence, in view of the development of a draft tool to be presented during the next plenary meeting;
- took note of the following date of its upcoming meeting:
