EXPERT MEETING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A COUNCIL OF EUROPE DATABASE FOR THE EUROPEAN LANDSCAPE CONVENTION

REPORT

*Document by the General Secretariat
Cultural Heritage, Landscape and Spatial Planning Division*

1. The representative of the Secretariat of the Council of Europe explained that the objective of the meeting was to organise a very preliminary expert meeting in order to establish a Council of Europe Database on the European Landscape Convention taking the opportunity offered by the new technologies for interactive systems. This activity would be articulated with HEREIN and a draft recommendation should be prepared to be presented at the 5th Conference of the Council of Europe on the European Landscape Convention on 30-31 March 2009 for adoption by the member States of the Council of Europe.

2. Mr Jean-François SEGUIN, Chair of the Conference of the Council of Europe on the European Landscape Convention welcomed the participants (see List of participants in the appendix).

3. Presentations were made on the following internet database systems: Council of Europe's HEREIN (Council of Europe), Le NOTRE (ECLAS) and Landscape Observatory of Catalonia. The experiences of France, Italy and Slovenia were also presented.

4. The participants discussed the proposal and Mr Jean-François SEGUIN summarised the discussions as follows:
