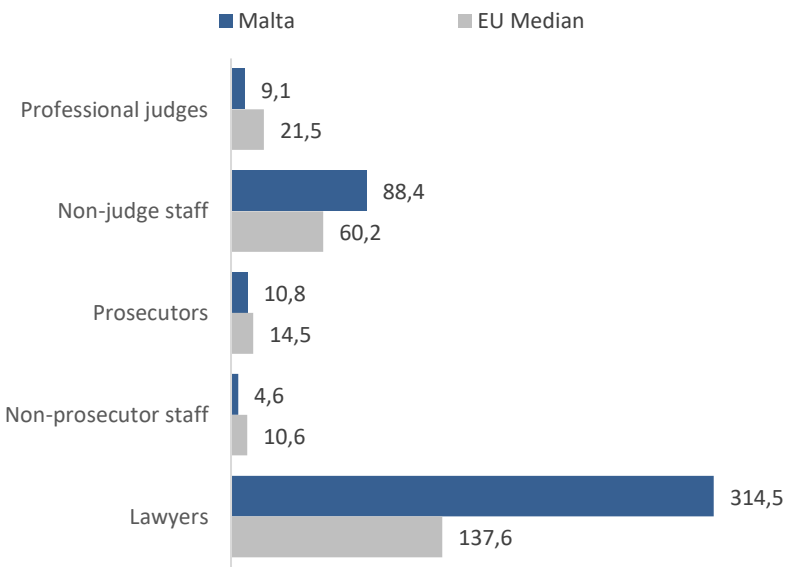

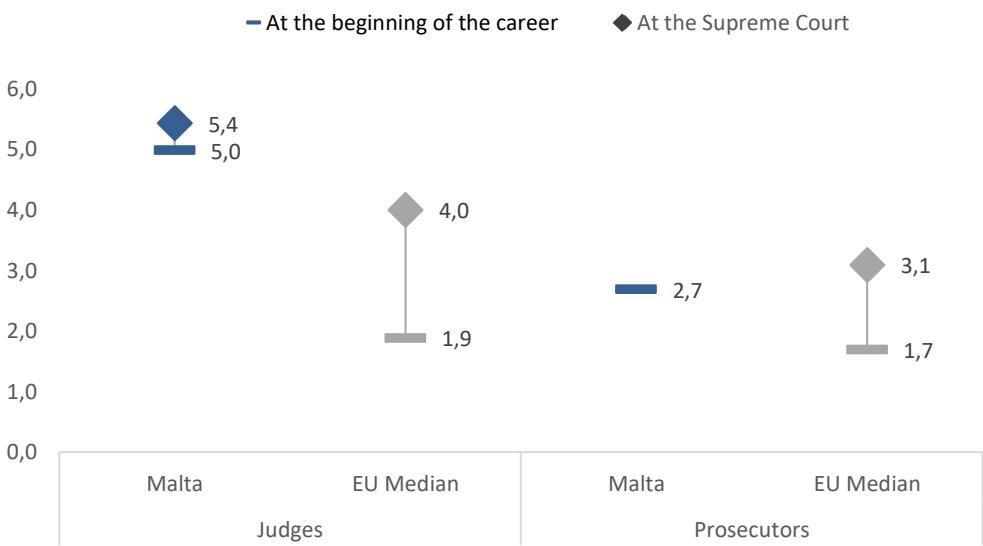

Judicial professionals per 100 000 inhabitants

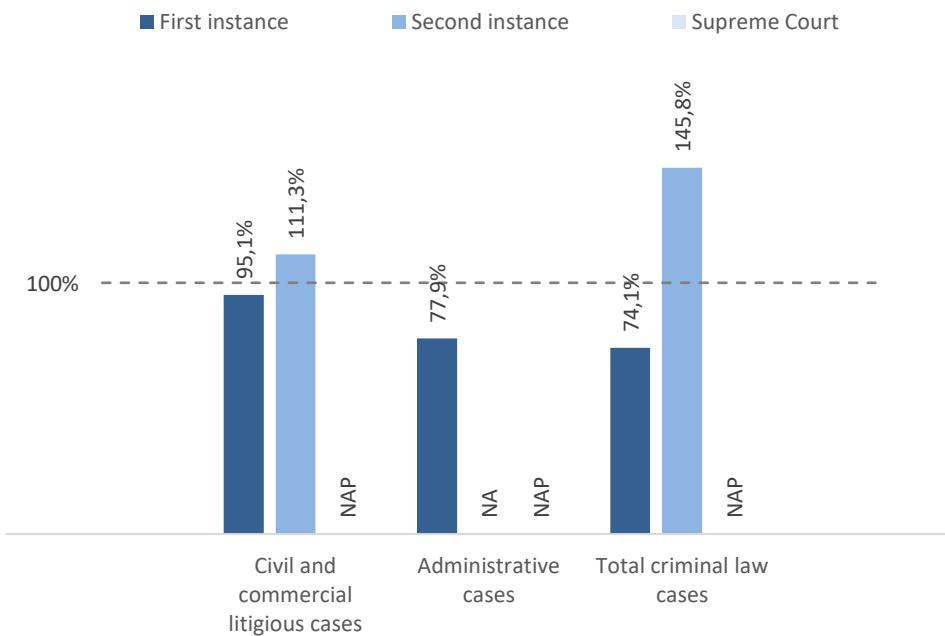


Gross salaries of judges and prosecutors vs average annual salary in 2023

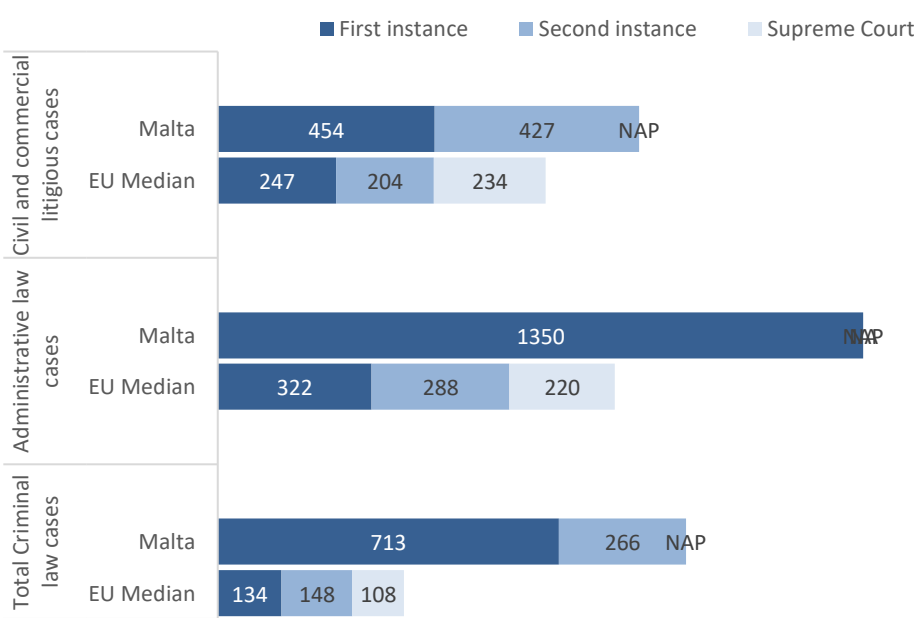

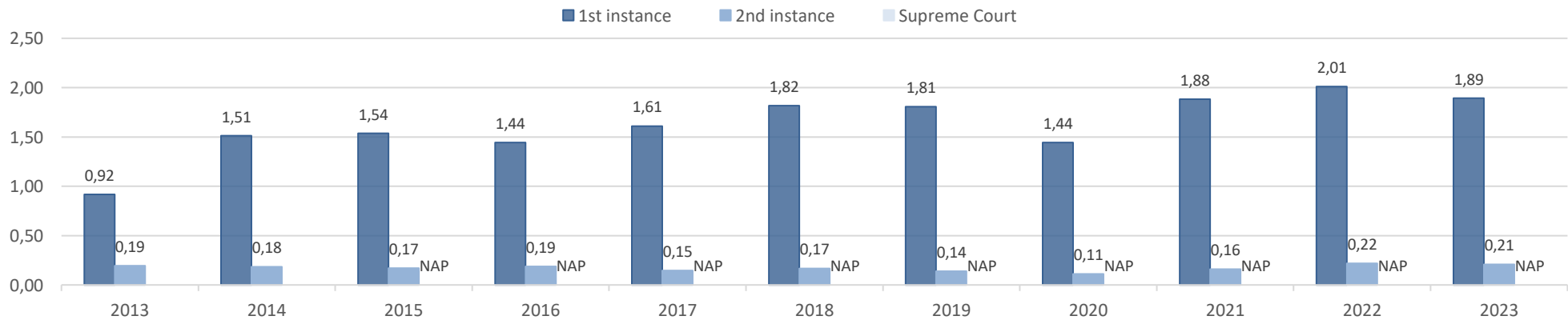


DispositionTime by instance and by matter in 2023 (days)



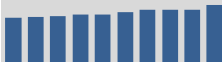
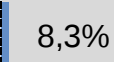
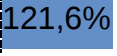
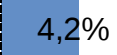
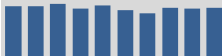
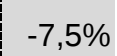
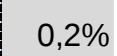
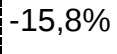
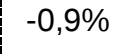
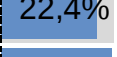
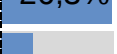
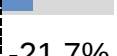
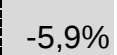
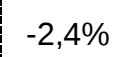
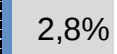
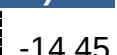
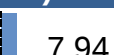
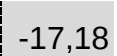
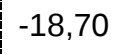
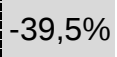
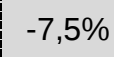
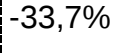
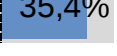
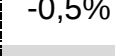
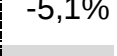
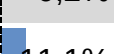
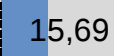
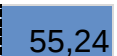
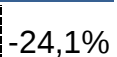
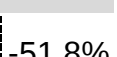
Incoming cases per 100 inhabitants

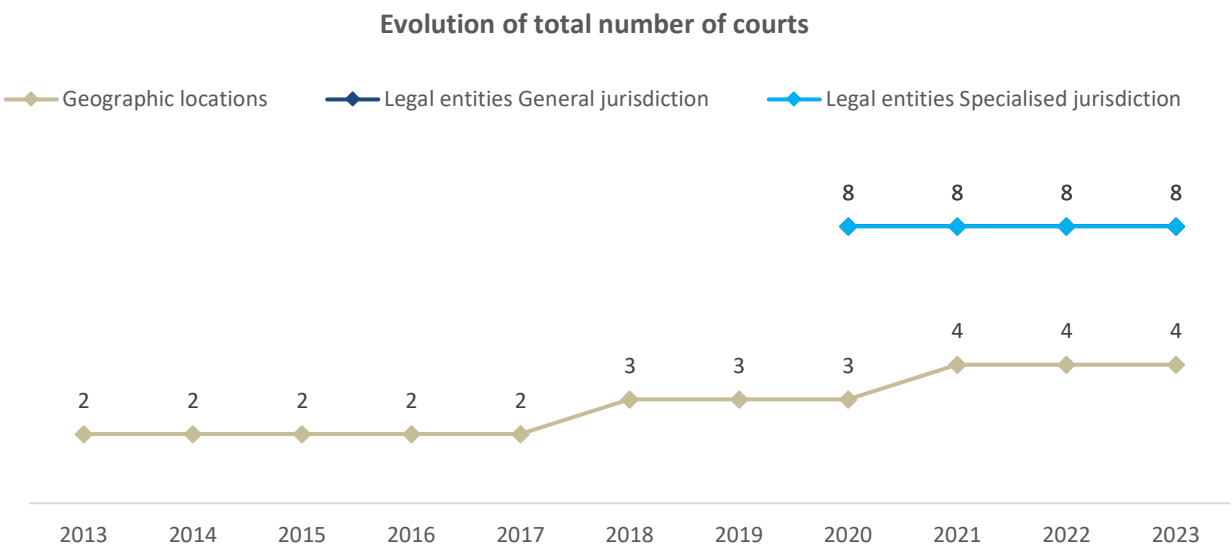
1. Judicial organisation in Malta (2023 data)

The Maltese judicial system consists of 16 courts in total, divided into first and second instances. The 4 first-instance courts of general jurisdiction include the Court of Magistrates (Civil and Criminal Jurisdiction), the Criminal Court, and the Civil Court, First Hall. Additionally, there are 7 specialised first-instance boards and tribunals, such as the Rent Regulation Board, Land Arbitration Board, Rural Leases Control Board, Small Claims Tribunal, Court of Voluntary Jurisdiction, Administrative Review Tribunal, and the Juvenile Court. The Constitutional Court serves as a specialised second instance court.

The system operates with two levels of jurisdiction, with the second instance being the highest. There are 4 second instance courts of general jurisdiction.

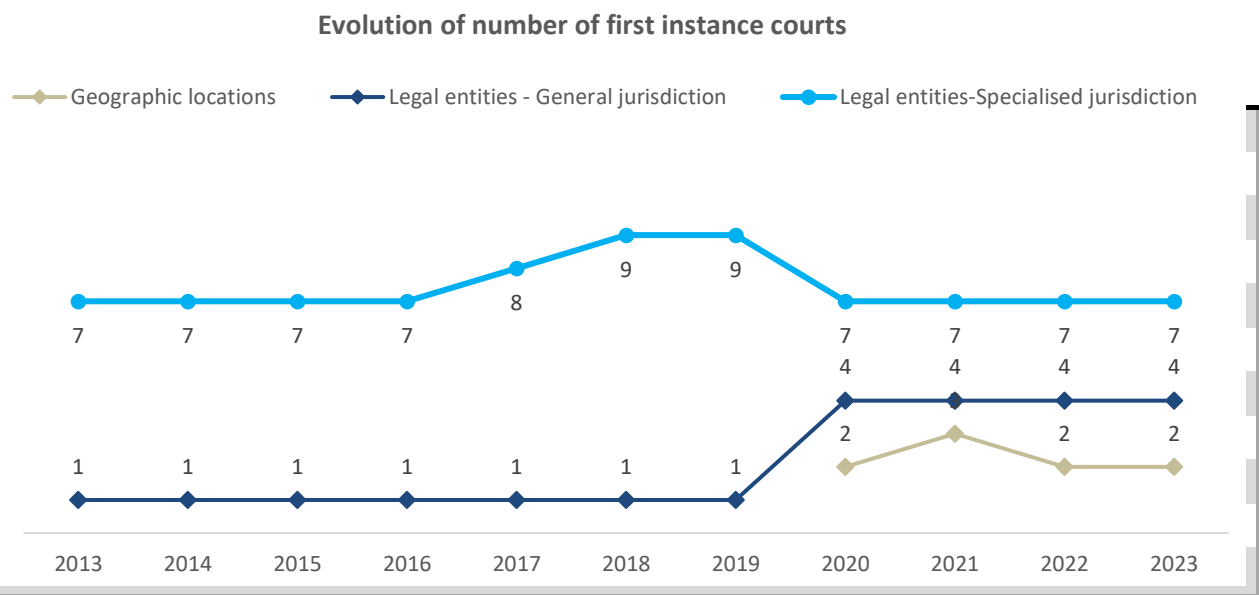

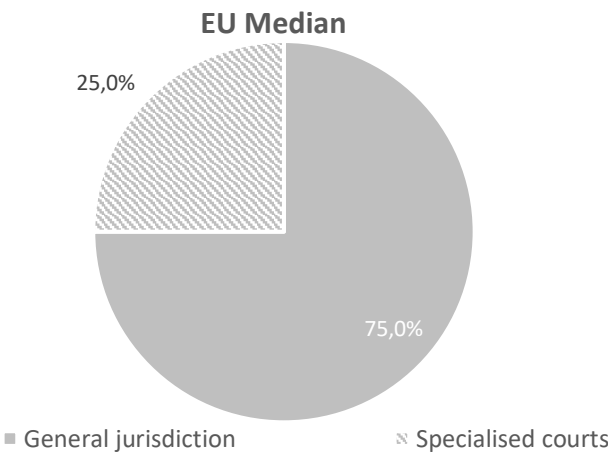

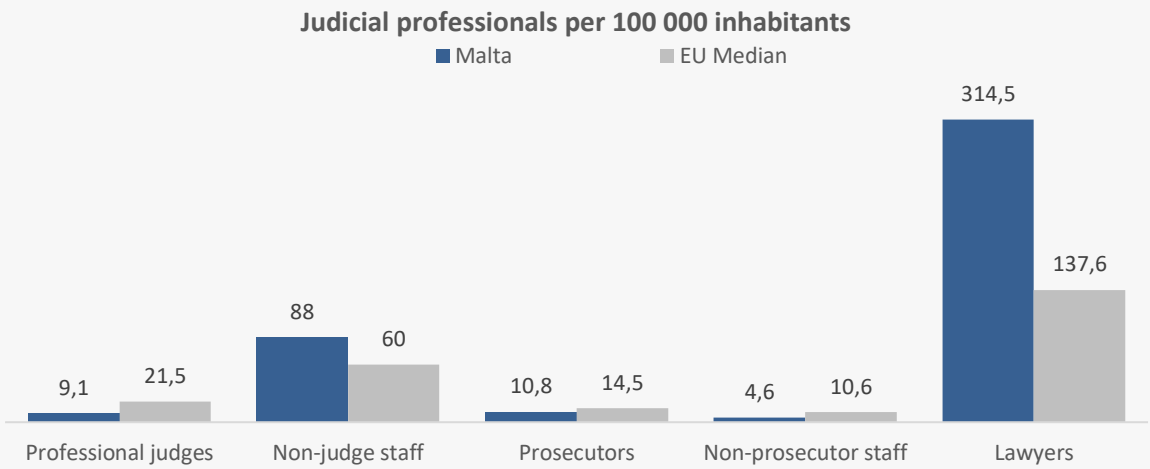

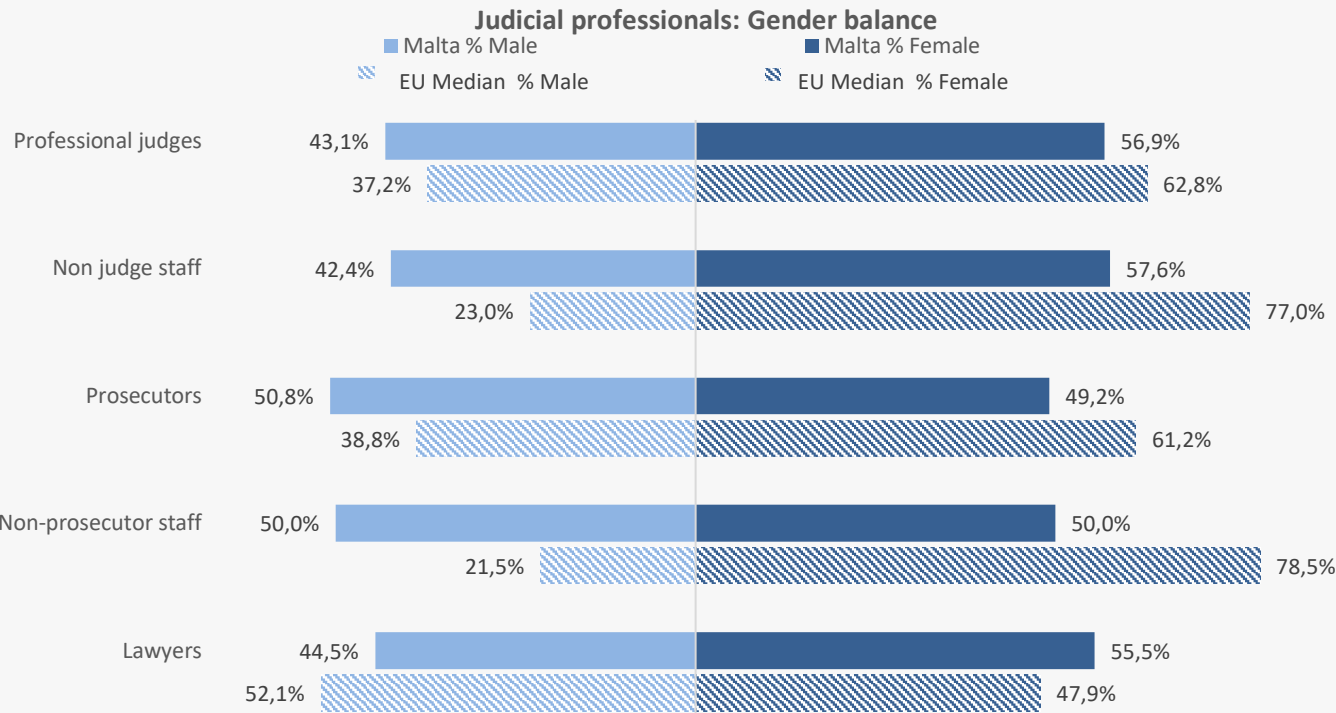

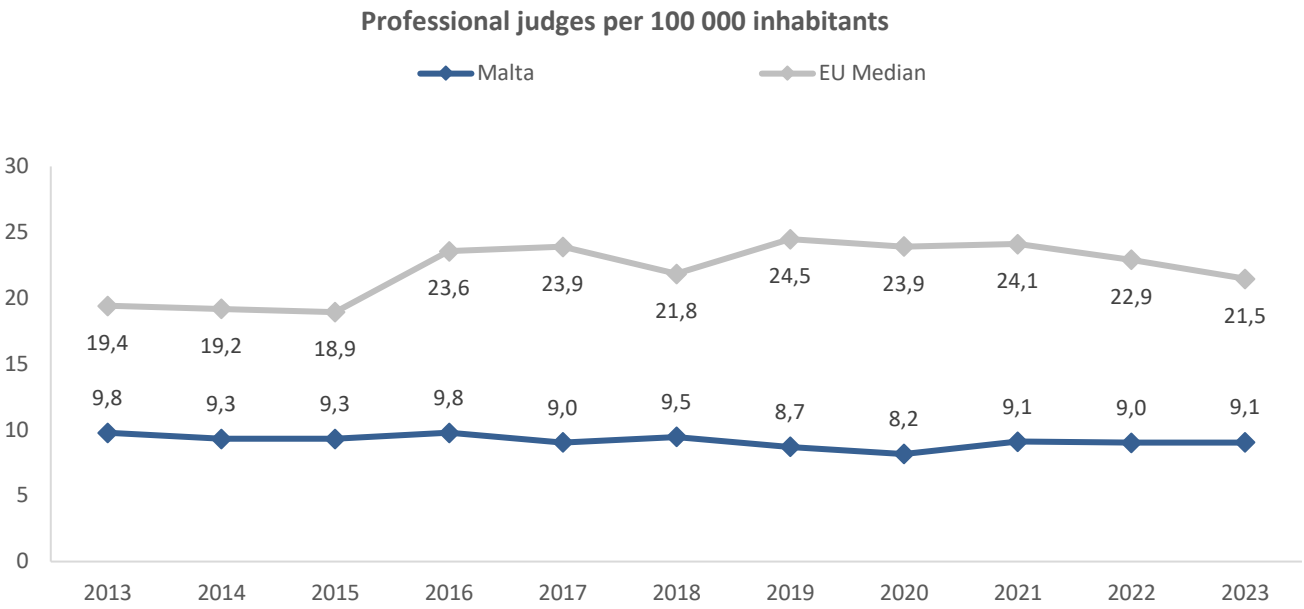

According to the 2023 data, the total number of professional judges sitting in courts (all instances) in Malta is 51, which is 8,5% more than in previous cycle, as over 2023, 4 additional members were appointed to the judiciary, increasing the total number serving on the bench.

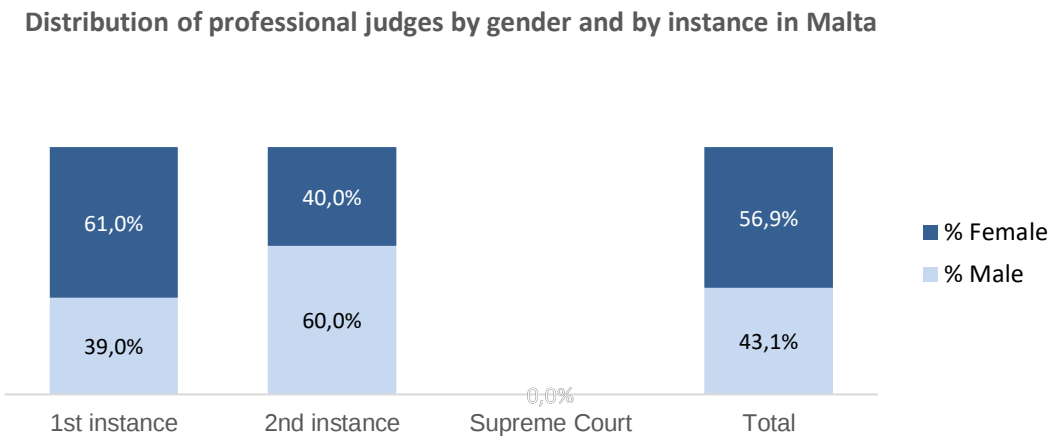
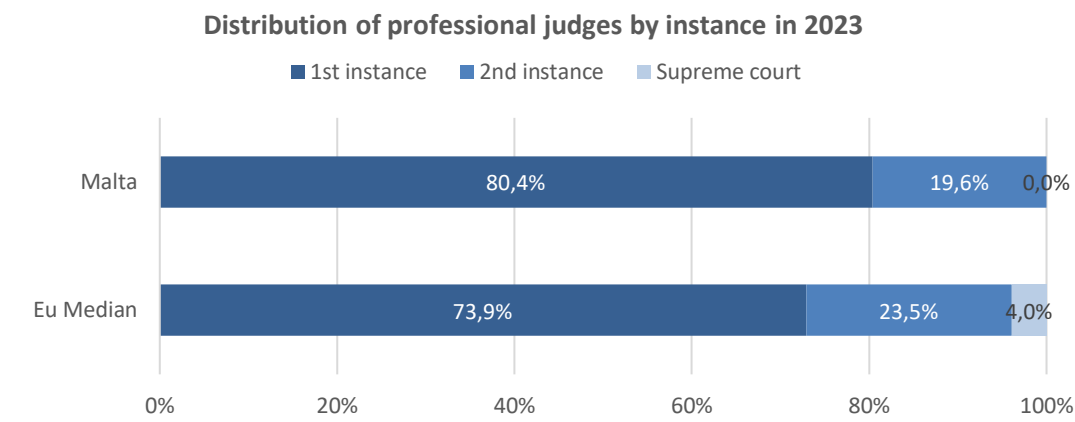
More precisely, in Malta, there are 9,1 professional judges per 100 000 inhabitants (this figure is below the EU median of 21,5 judges per 100 000 inhabitants)

The Constitutional Court is presided by the 3 judges who compose the Court of second instance also known as the Court of Appeal in its Superior Jurisdiction.

The number of 1st Instance 'judges' also includes magistrates that preside over 1st Instance Courts.

In this cycle, the total number of female professional judges (all instances) is 29, which represents 56,9% of the total number of judges.

The total number of judges is distributed among the different judicial instances in the following way: 41 are sitting in the first instance courts (of which 25 are female); 10 are sitting in the second instance courts (of which 4 are female). In Malta there is no Supreme Court, the Court of Appeal being the Court of second instance.

Compared with the EU distribution of professional judges per instance, the trend in Malta is similar. The number of judges at first instance is predominant, while judges at second instance are less numerous.

As regards the distribution male/Female, it has to be specified that although females judges represent 61% of professional judges at first instance, their percentage is lower at second instance with 40%. In the total of professional judges 56,9% are female.

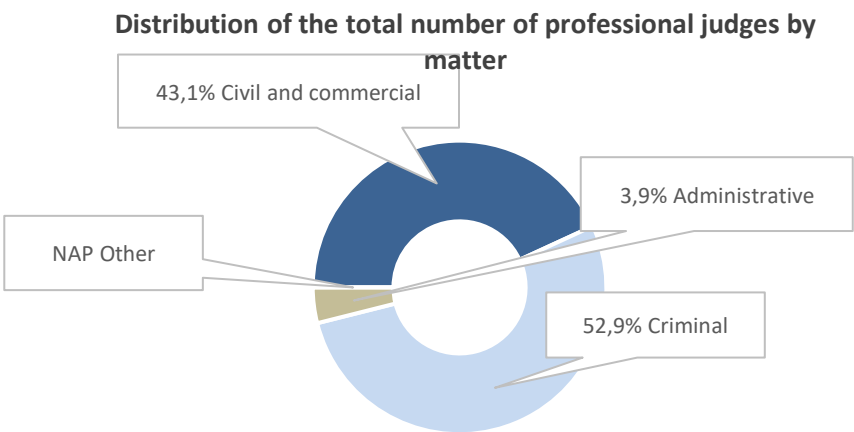

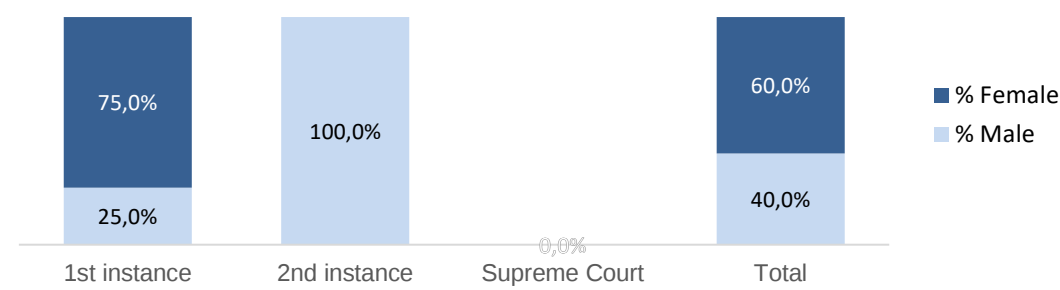

Distribution of court presidents by gender and by instance in Malta

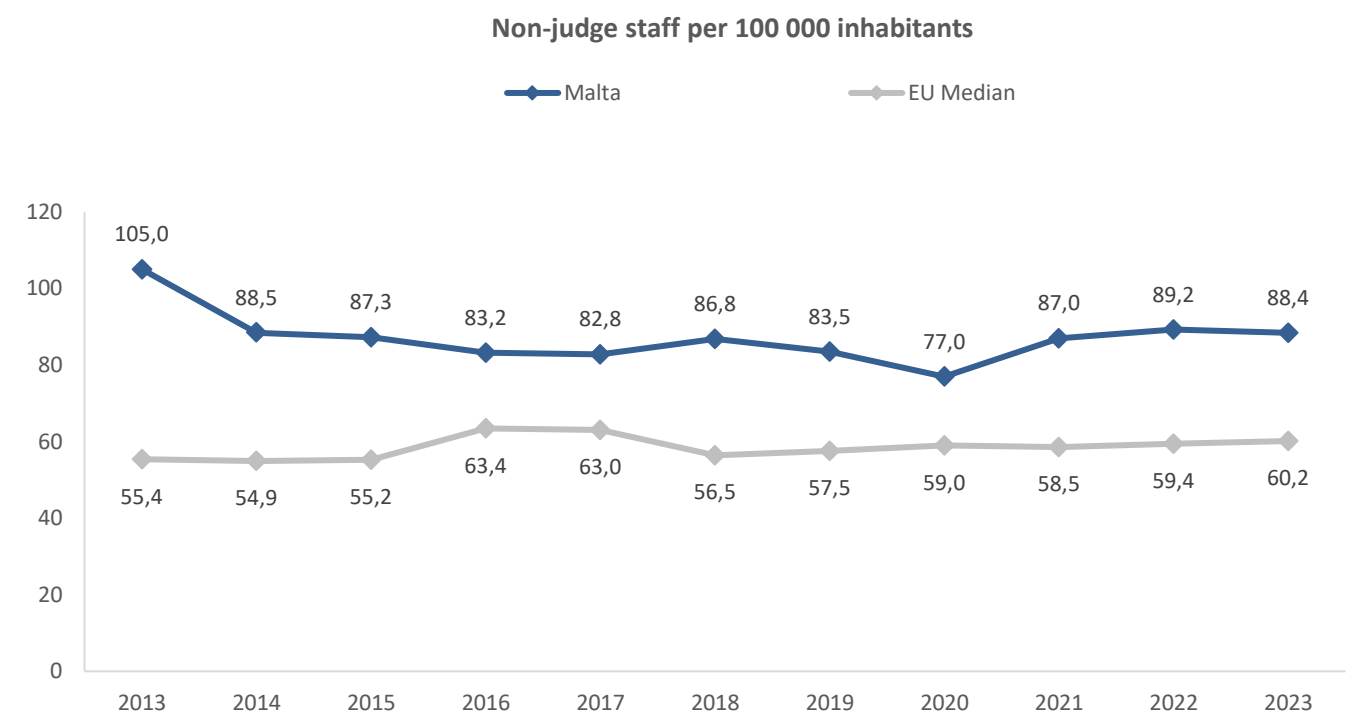


In this cycle, the total number of female court presidents (all instances) is 3, which represents 60,0% of the total number of court presidents.

The total number of court presidents is distributed among the different judicial instances in the following way: 4 are sitting in first instance courts (of which 3 are female) and 1 is sitting in second instance courts.

In 2023, Malta has 498 non-judge staff (of which 287 are Female). The total number of non-judge staff in comparison with the previous cycle reveals an increase of 7,3%.

In 2023, the number of non-judge staff per 100 000 inhabitants has decreased (from 89,2 in 2022 to 88,4 in 2023).

During the same period, the number of judges per 100 000 inhabitants evolved from 9,0 judges per 100 000 inhabitants in 2022 to 9,1 in 2023.

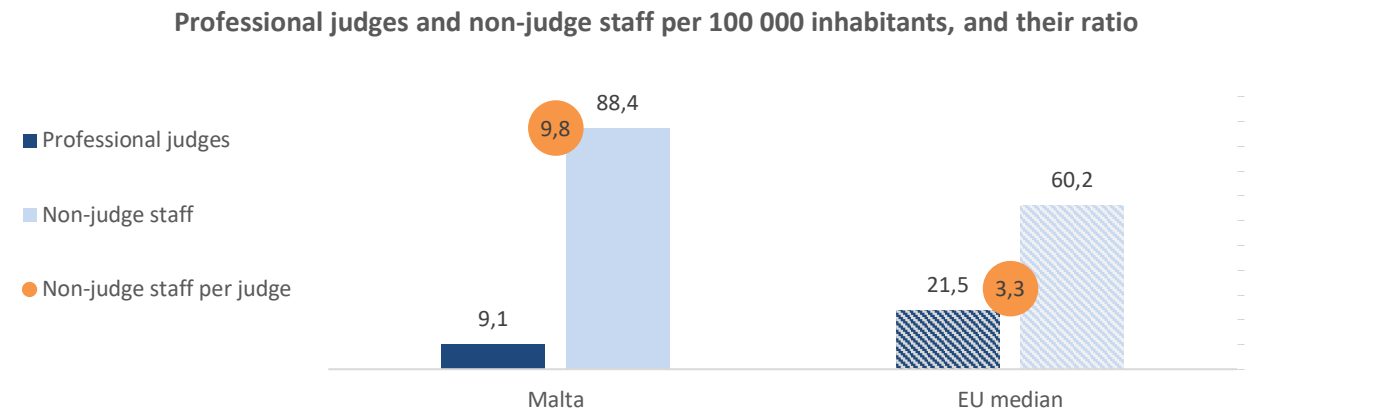
In this cycle, the non-judge staff is broken down as follows:

- 324 non-judge staff whose task is to assist the judges such as registrars (of which 232 are Female);
- 47 staff in charge of different administrative tasks and of the court management (of which 20 are Female);
- 11 technical staff (of which 3 are Female);
- 116 other (of which 32 are Female);

The distribution of gender by category listed above is a reflection of the changes resulting from the recruitment process. The Court Services Agency is an impartial employer and is constantly seeking to recruit additional staff to support the increasing number of the judiciary, and functions/ operations in court. Fluctuations in the gender ratio are purely incidental.

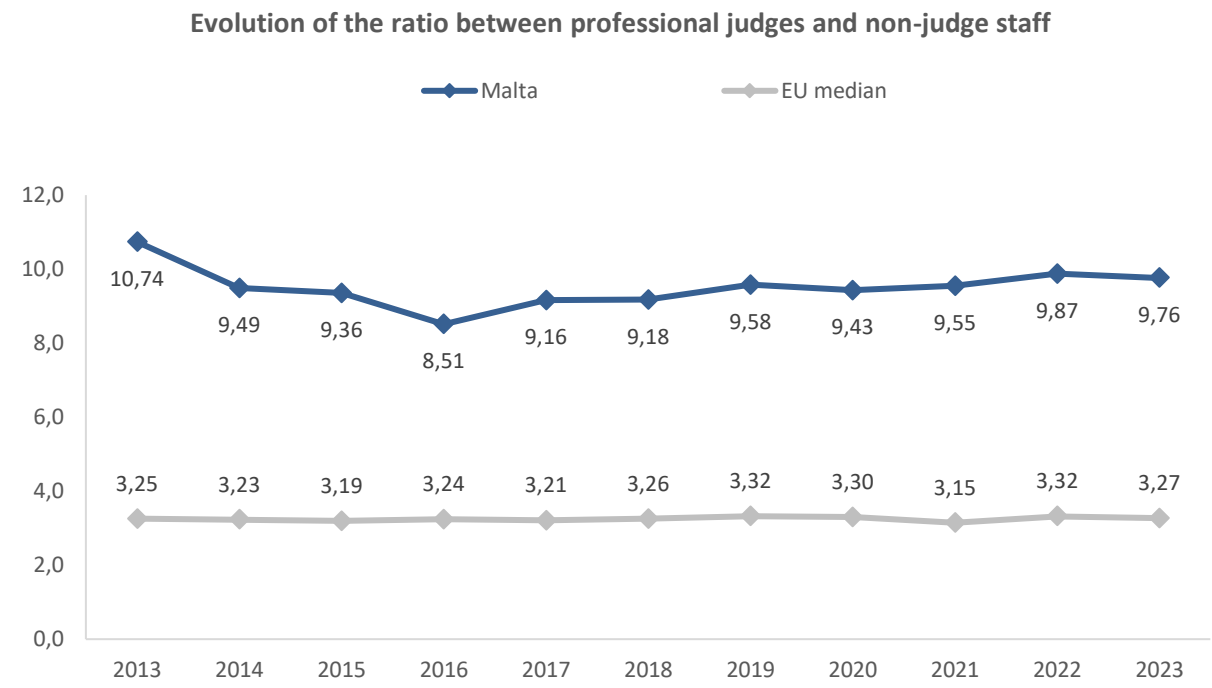

In Malta, there are 9,1 professional judges per 100 000 inhabitants (this figure is below the EU median of 21,5 judges per 100 000 inhabitants) and about 9,8 non-judge staff per judge. There is no significant difference compared to the previous cycle when this ratio was at 9,9 non-judge staff per judge.

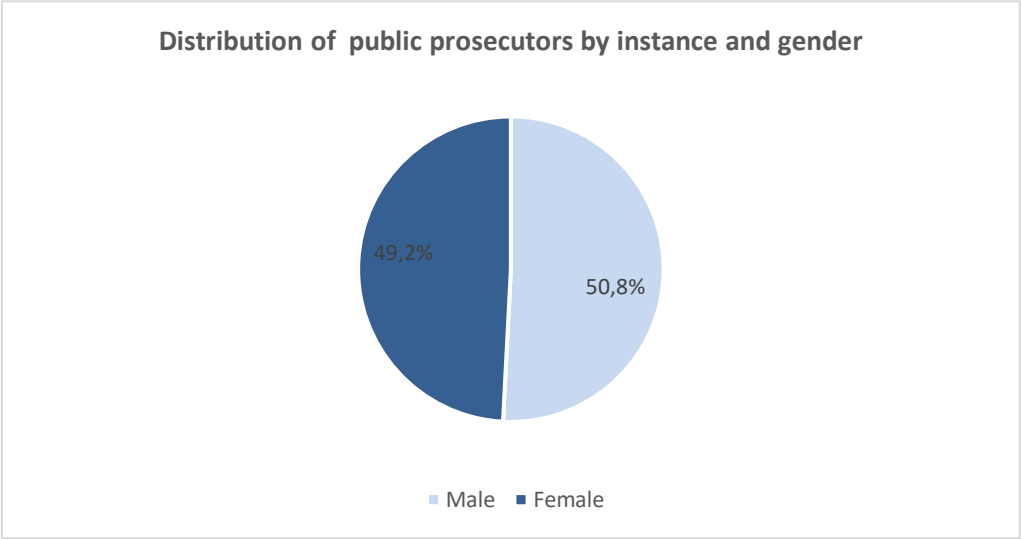

In this cycle, the total number of Female prosecutors (all instances) is 30, which represents 49,2% of the total number of prosecutors. All full-time lawyers have been included in the above figure, except the Attorney General herself. The increase in the number of prosecutors follows a recruitment drive throughout 2023.

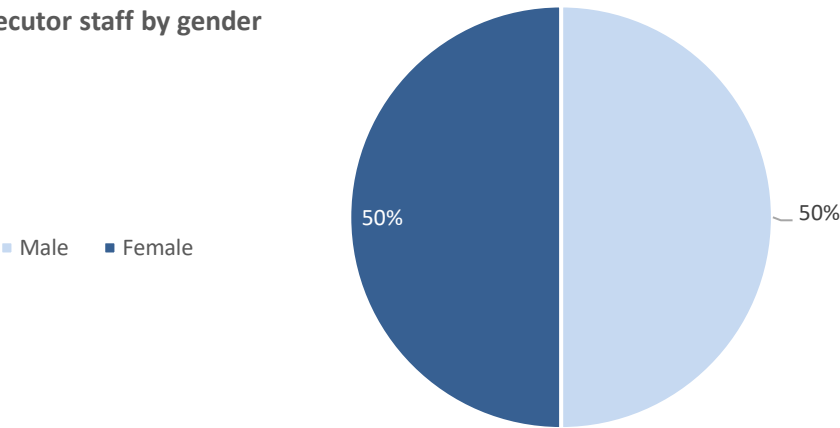

Non-prosecutor staff by gender

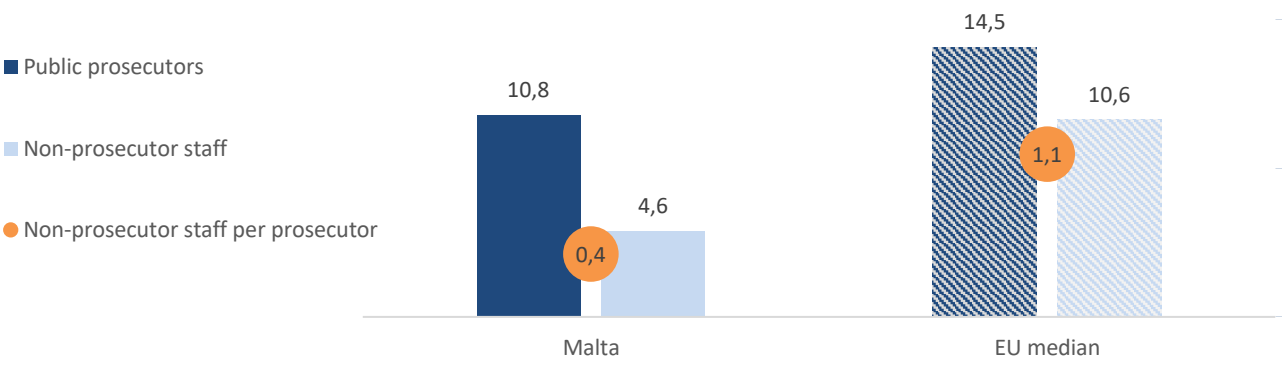

Public prosecutors and non-prosecutor staff per 100 000 inhabitants, and their ratio

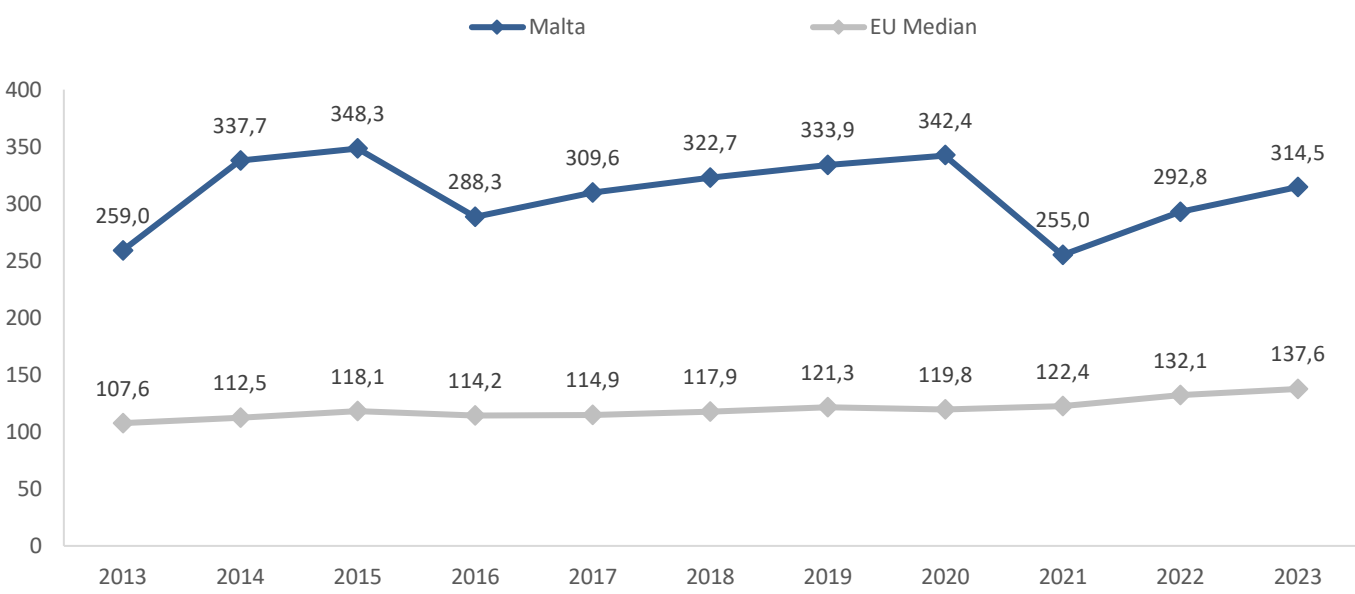

Lawyers per 100 000 inhabitants

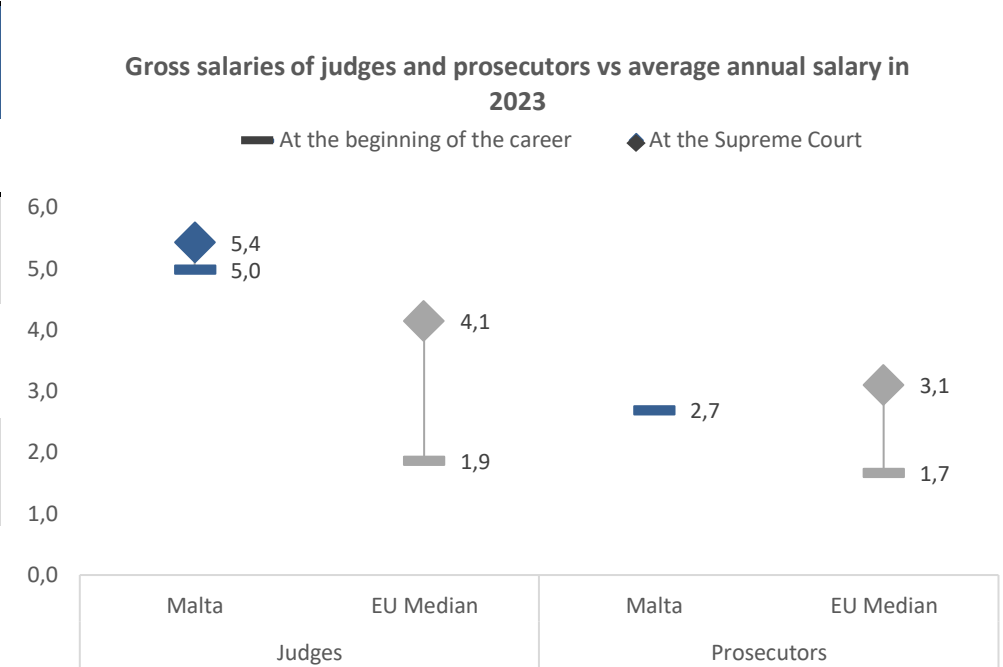

In the European Union, the absolute gross salary for a judge at the beginning of career ranges from a minimum of 25 759€ to a maximum of 144 856€.

According to 2023 data, the absolute gross salary of a judge at the beginning of his/her career in Malta is 108 905€, which is significantly above the EU median of 58 128€. (87% above)

Compared with the annual average salary in the country, the salary for a judge at the beginning of his/her career is 5,0 times higher (the EU median is 1,9).

At the highest level, the range of the EU absolute gross salary for a judge is from 58 623€ to 266 974€. Malta is the country that is at the median level of the absolute gross salaries for judges at the highest level (118 595€).

For the public prosecutors, the range for the absolute gross salary at the beginning of career is from a minimum of 25 759€ to a maximum of 101 592€.

In 2023, the absolute gross salary of a public prosecutor at the beginning of his/her career in Malta of 58 722€ is rather above the EU median of 49 953€ (18% above).

Compared with the annual average salary in the country, the salary for a public prosecutors at the beginning of his/her career is 2,7 times higher (the EU median is 1,7).

At the highest level, the minimum absolute gross salary for prosecutors in the European Union is 51 456€ and the maximum is 199 670€. The EU median is 93 759€.

The increase in gross and net wages is the result of a recalculation of wages after adjustments for National Insurance (NI) and taxes across the three tax categories (Single, Parent, Married). Additionally, salaries were revised retroactively to 2023.

Under Article 3 of the 7th Protocol of the European Convention on Human Rights, individuals have the right to compensation in cases of wrongful conviction. Similarly, Article 5(5) of the Convention, as incorporated into Maltese law through Chapter 319, establishes the right to compensation for unlawful detention. However, there is currently no available data on the application or implementation of these rights within Malta.

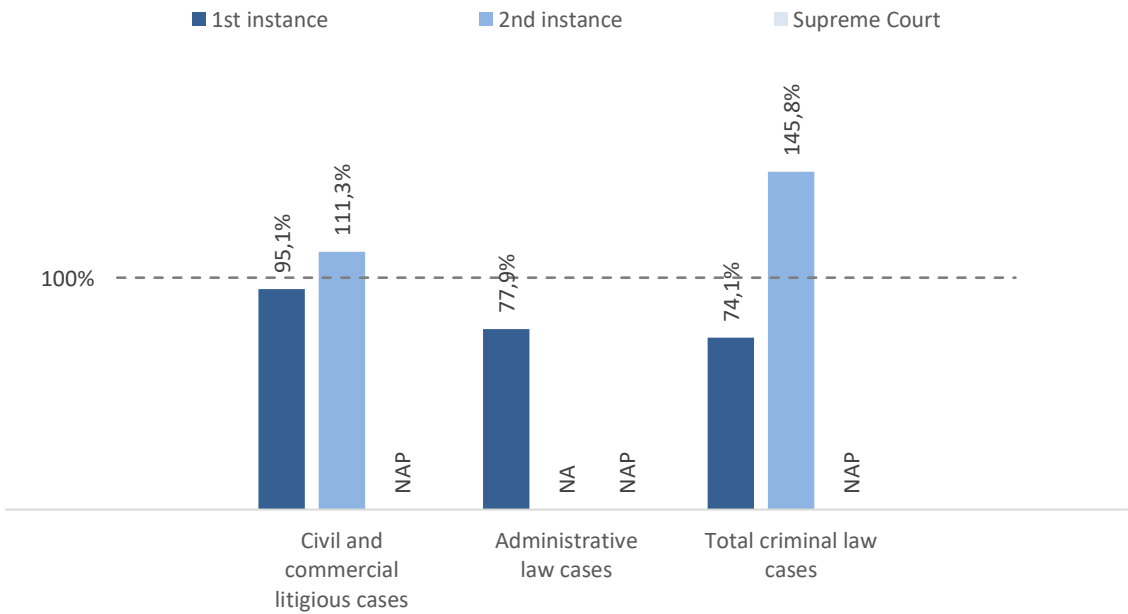

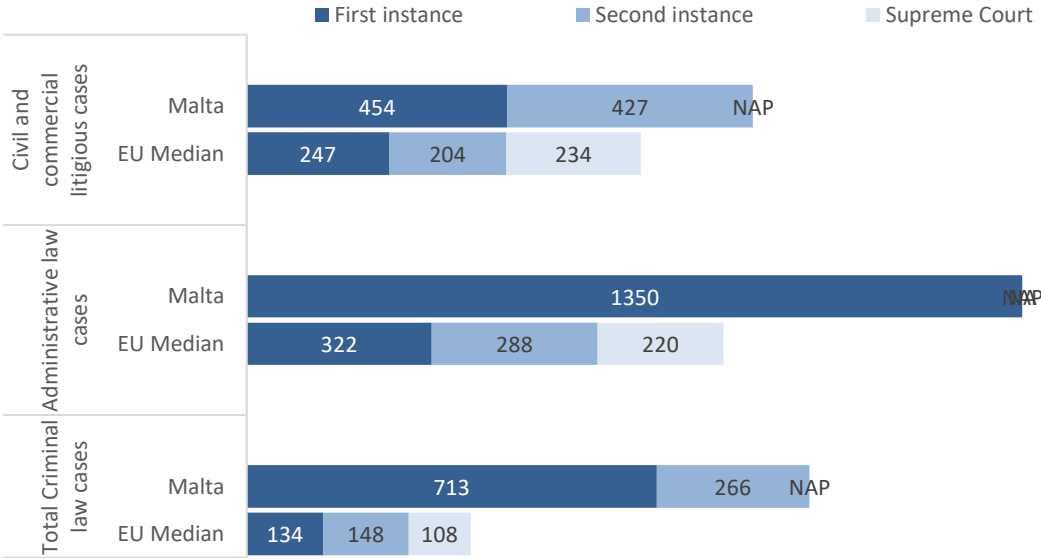

Compared to the previous cycle, the clearance rate in the Maltese judicial system has improved at second instance, exceeding 100% for civil and commercial litigious cases and particularly for second-instance criminal cases. However, the Clearance Rate at the first instance remains below 100% across all legal matters and particularly, in administrative and criminal law matters, indicating a possible backlog in those courts.

In terms of Disposition Time, significant discrepancies are evident when compared to the EU median. While first-instance civil and commercial litigious cases are processed relatively quickly, administrative cases at the first instance take an average of 1 350 days, exceeding significantly the EU median of 322 days. Similarly, the Disposition Time for first-instance criminal cases is notably higher than the EU median, highlighting inefficiencies in these areas.

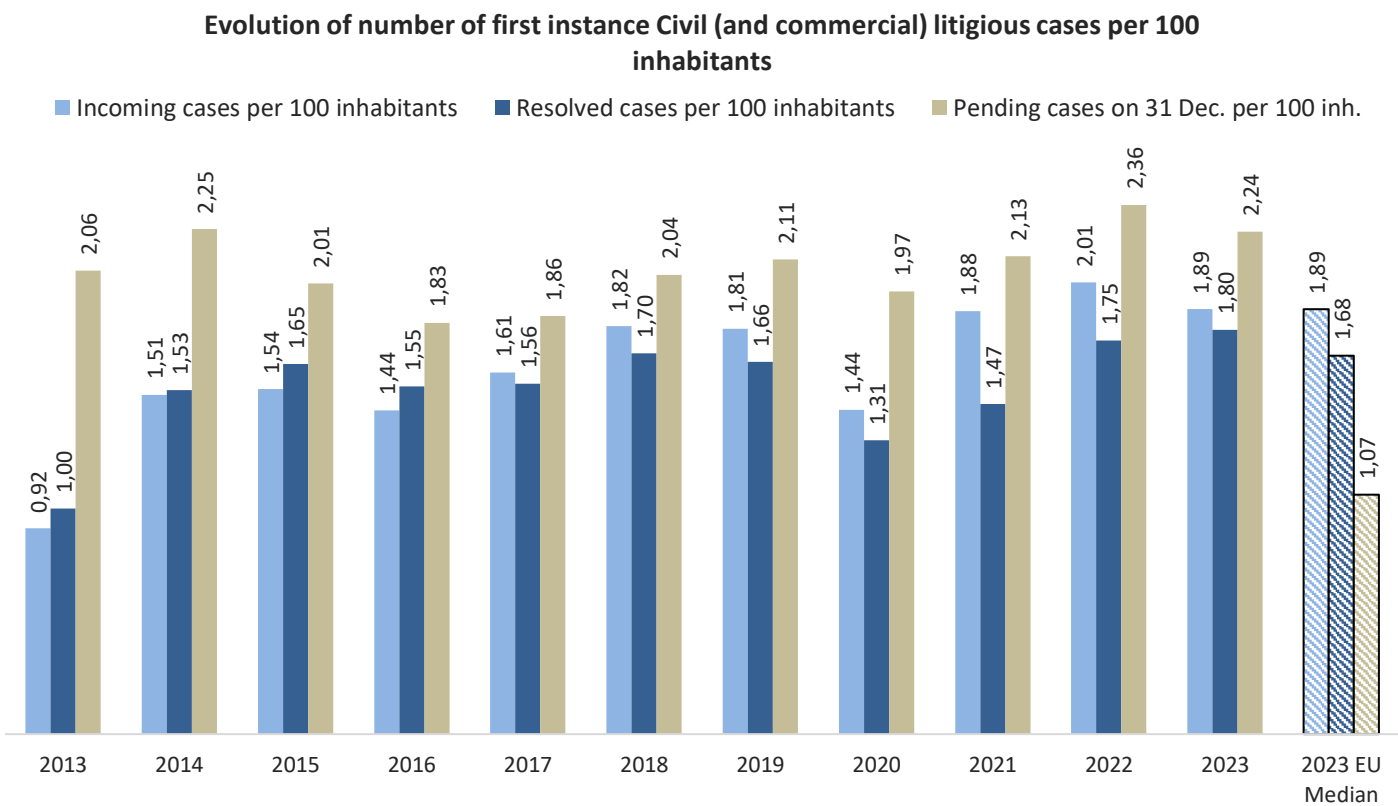
The vast majority of cases heard before the courts of Malta are litigious cases. Nevertheless, there is the Court of Voluntary Jurisdiction which deals with adoptions, appointment of tutor, curators and other administrators, interdiction and incapacitation and opening of secret wills.

The horizontal inconsistencies are due to the current Case Management System, that still relies heavily on the input of deputy registrars and clerks working with the judiciary.

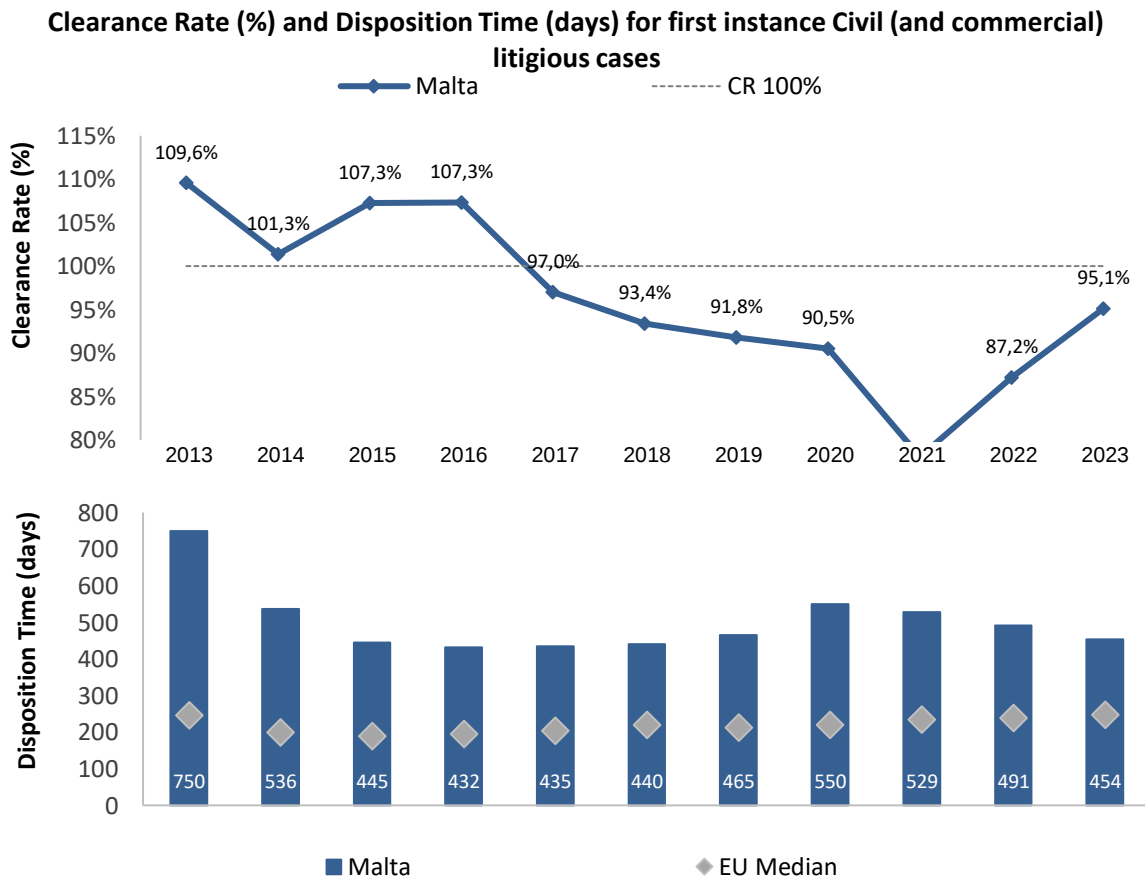

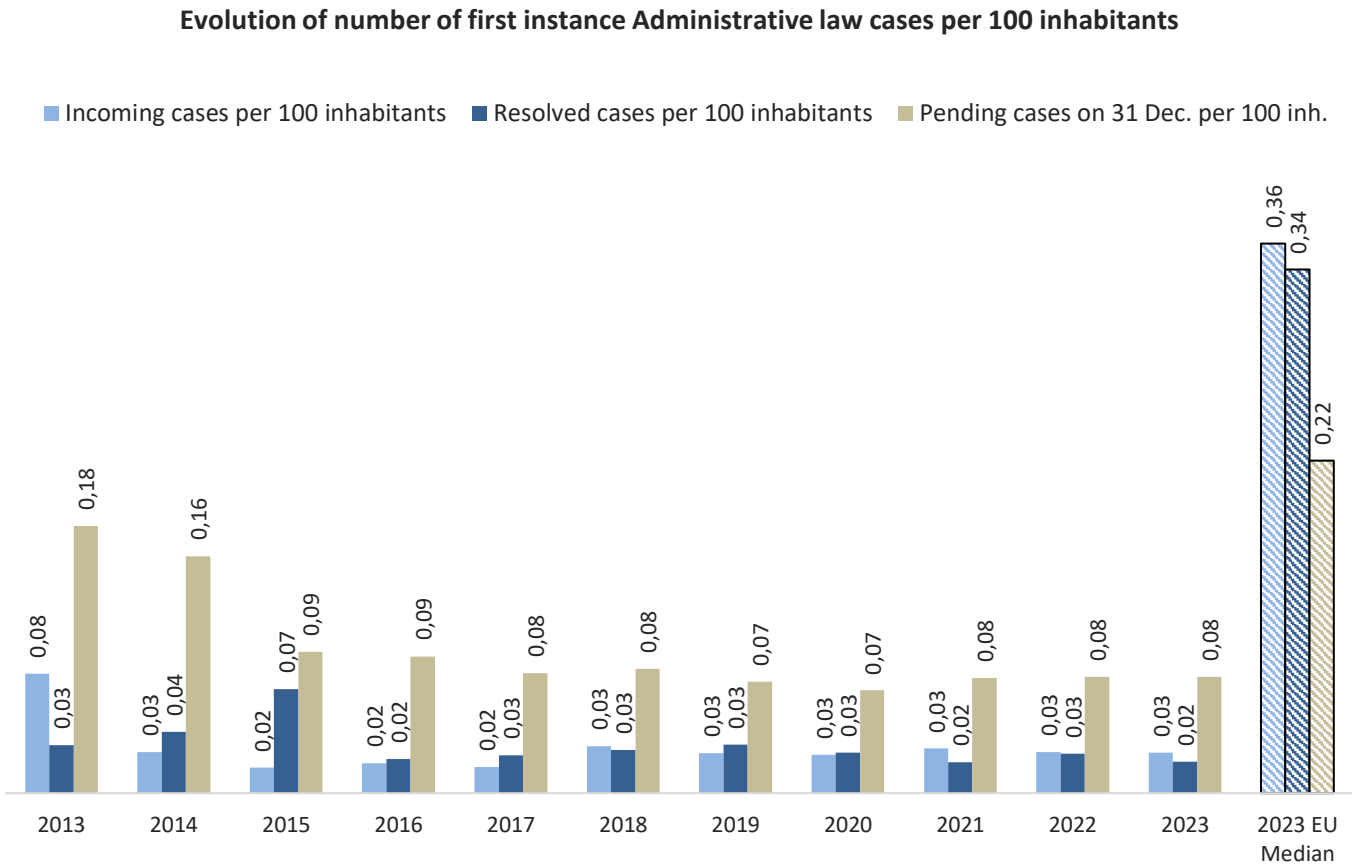

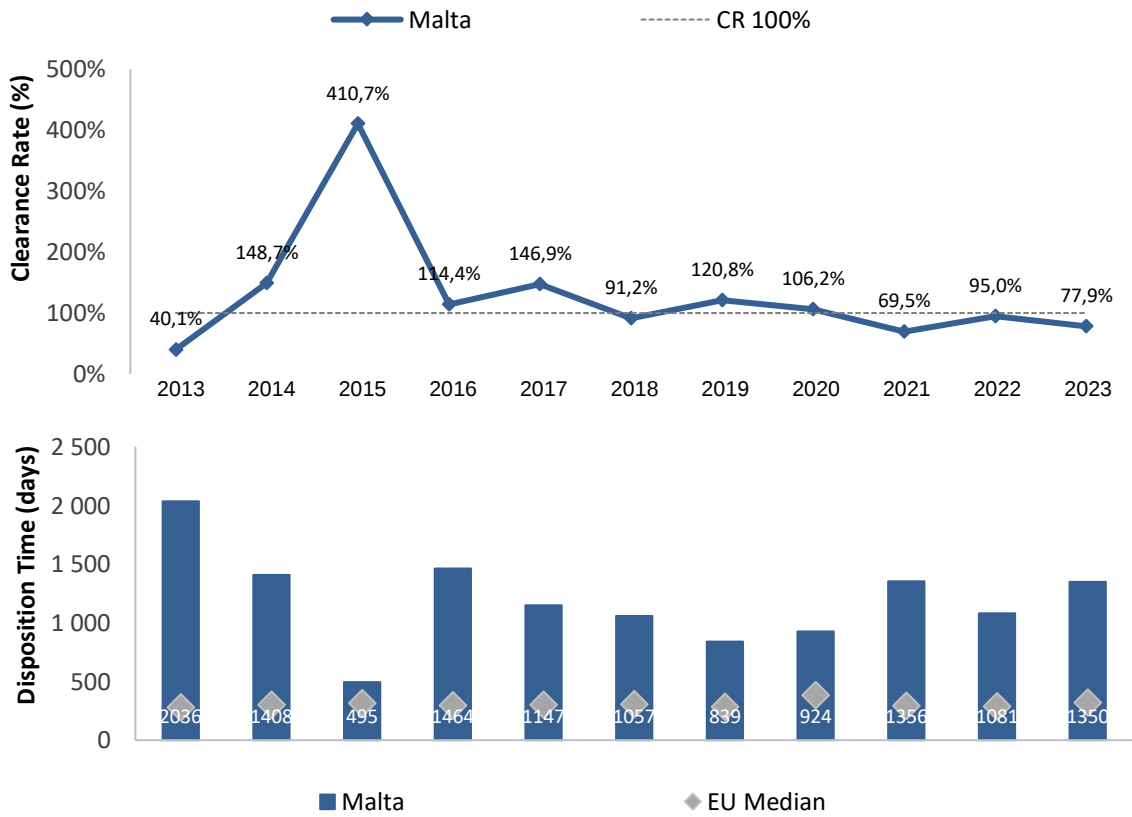

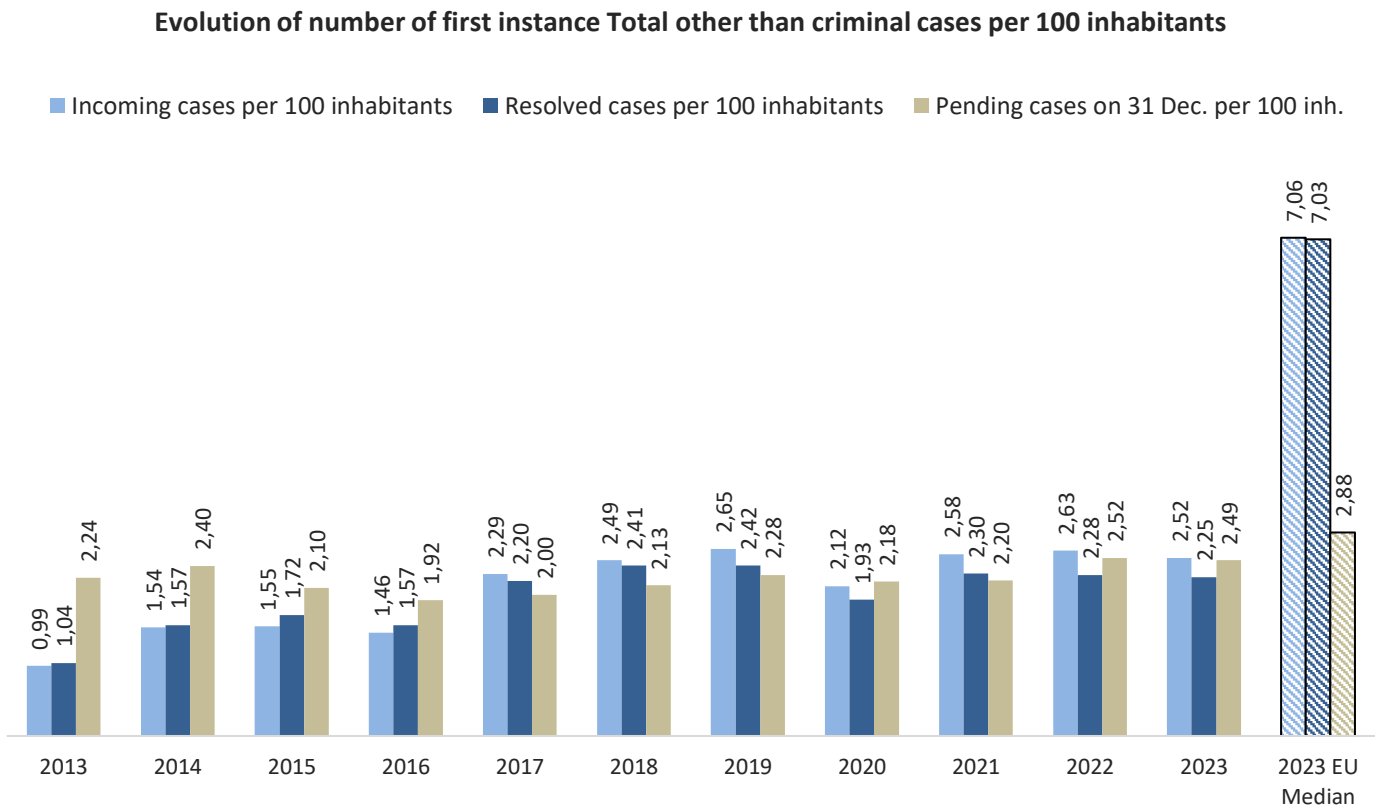

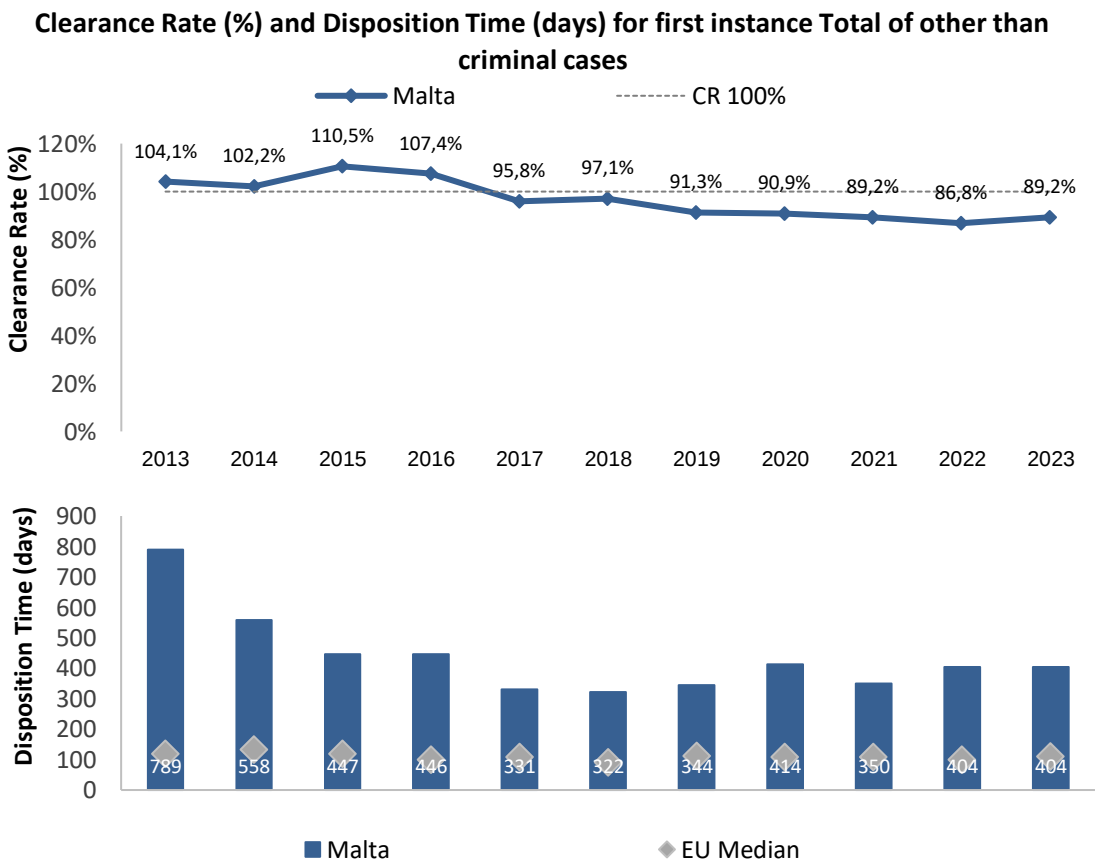

The number of total incoming criminal cases in 2023 in Malta (2,43 per 100 inhabitants) is somewhat above the EU median (1,64 per 100 inhabitants).

The increase in the number of incoming severe criminal cases results from an increase in the number of criminal court halls, which enables twice as many 'juries' to be held and more 'pending' cases to be brought to trial (in this particular court, the system is a bit different. Trials are brought forward when it is their turn, so the fact that the court administration increased the halls, enables more trials to be opened). In addition, the improvement in the efficiency of the Office of the Attorney General, the chief prosecutor, has resulted in more bills of indictment to be issued.

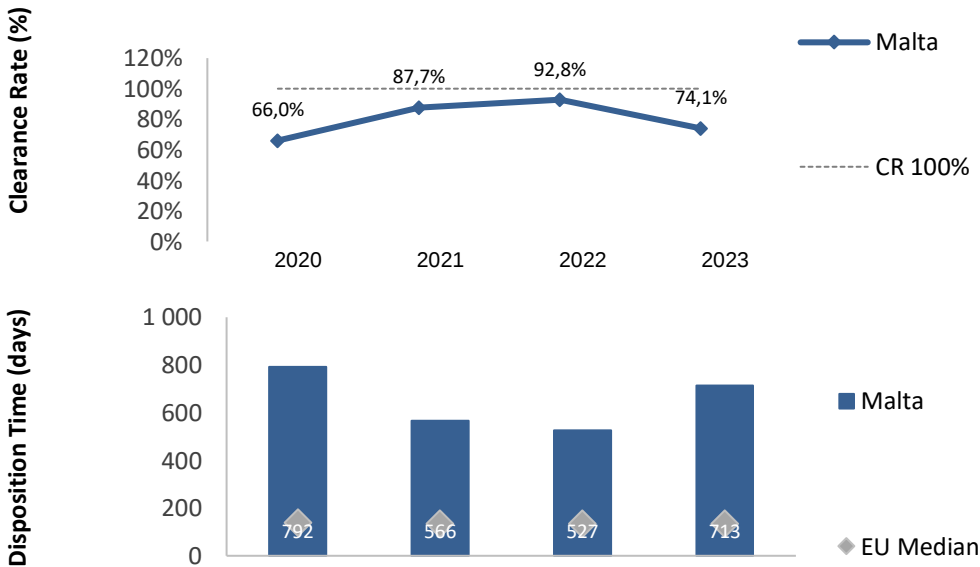

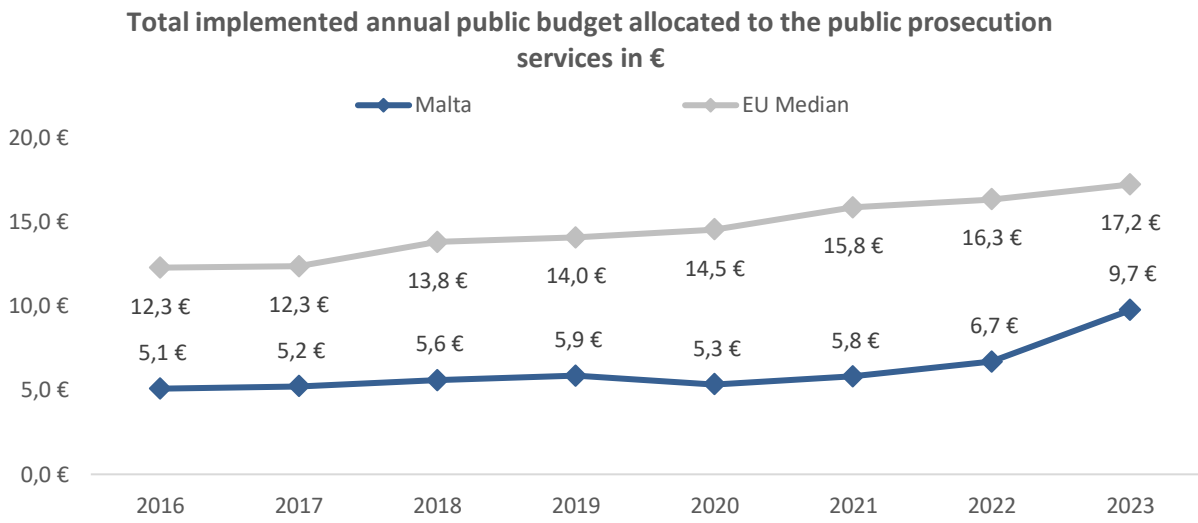

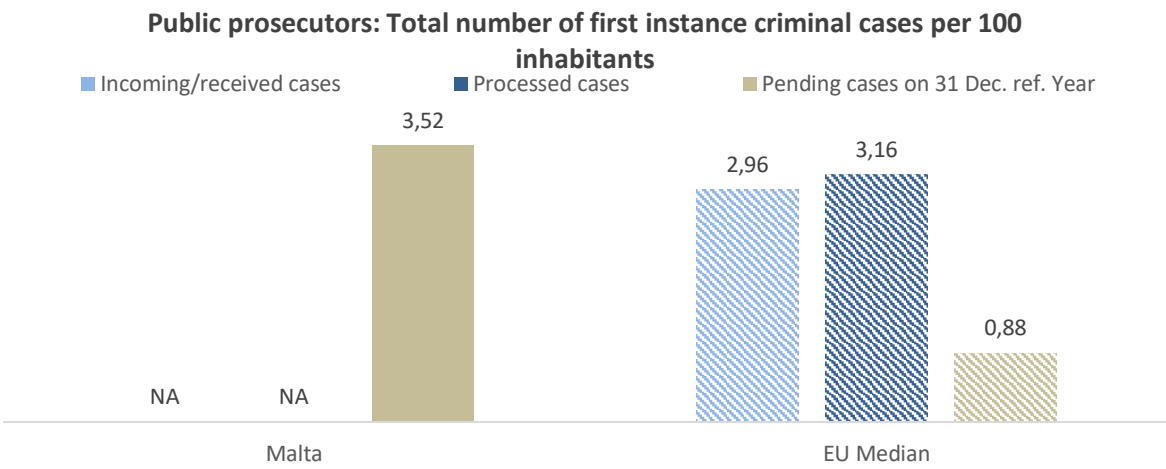
The public prosecution services are carried out by the Attorney General's office. The Attorney General not only acts as a public prosecutor but also as the principal legal advisor of all the Government Departments. As a result, the amount budgeted cannot be considered as being funds allocated solely for public prosecution services, but also for other purposes relating to legal work and advise for the Government, both locally and internationally.

Due to an increase in the number of lawyers within the Office of the Acttorney General, the implemented budget was raised. This translated into added costs in respect of wages and training.

Public prosecution caseload: Number of first instance criminal cases

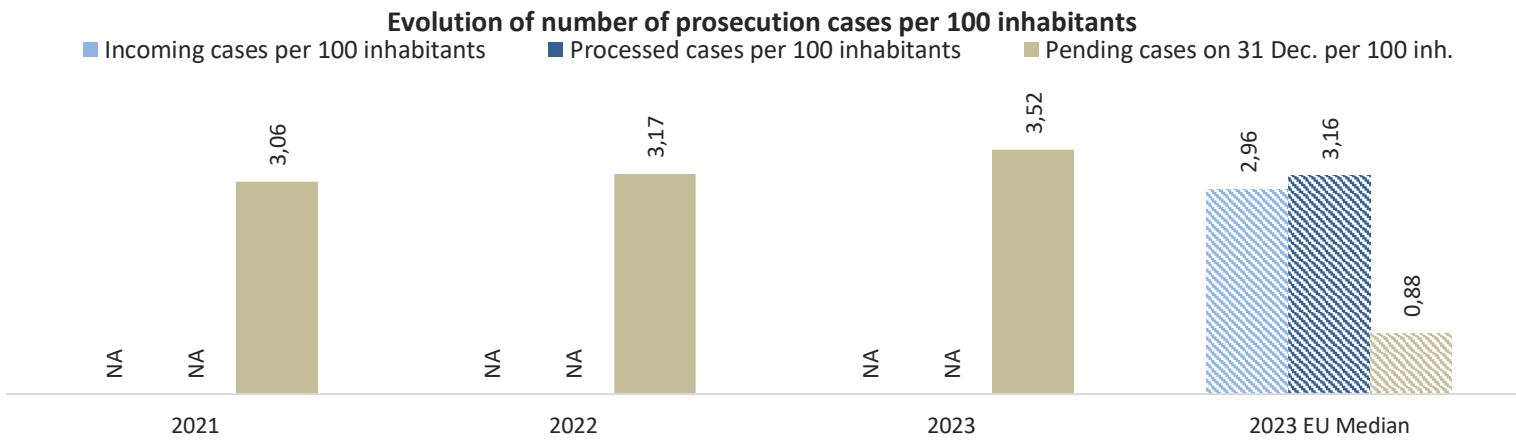

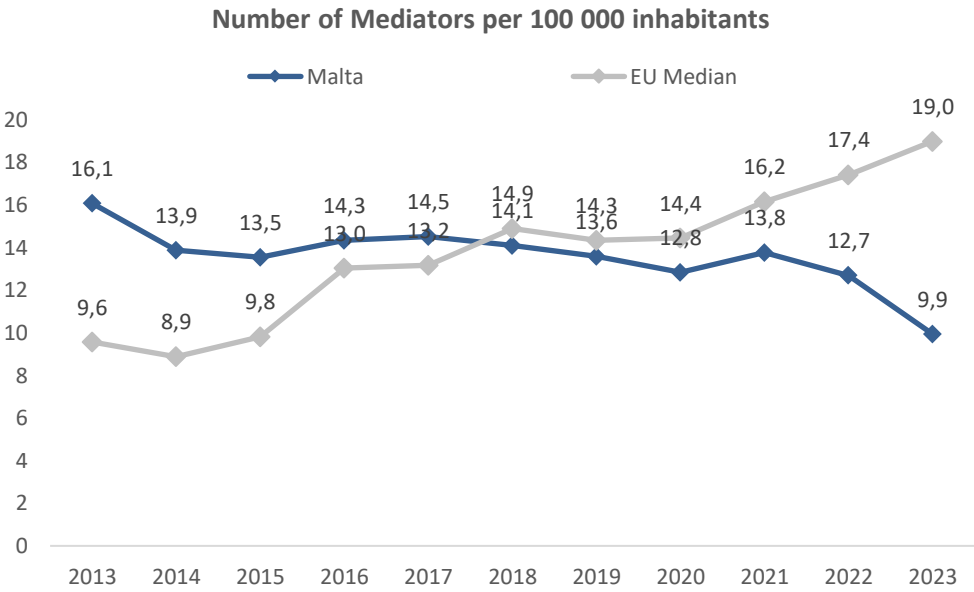

In 2023, there are 392 notaries which represents 69,6 notaries per 100 000 inhabitants.

The Notary is a Public Officer and as such is an emanation of the State. At the same time the notary is a professional with their own personal office, independent of the State and of the parties. This dual-nature ensures the right balance between the legal-fiscal functions for which the notary is the ultimate reference point.

Conveyance (property sales, purchase, leasing, etc.), financing collateral (hypothecation of immovable), succession (wills, trusts, etc.) and matters pertaining to civil status (matrimonial regimes, personal separations, etc.) are all within the ambit of the profession and form the portfolio of a notary’s day-to-day work. It is only through a notarial act that most transactions related to the above are given legal effect and this adds certainty and improves efficiency. Being a necessary passage at Law, the notarial requirement makes for a very cost-effective way of crystallising a state of certainty in that notarial tariffs are stipulated by law and the citizen is all the more protected. The notarial intervention is thus imposed by law to safeguard legality and ensuring at all times that the autonomy of the private citizen never goes beyond what is legally and statutorily permitted.

## 8. Systems for measuring and evaluating the performance of courts and public prosecution services in Malta (2023 data)

In Malta, quality standards are determined for the judicial system at national level (e.g. quality systems for the judiciary and/or judicial quality policies). However, there is no specialised personnel within the courts or the public prosecution services entrusted with implementation of these national level quality standards.

There is a Code of Ethics for the members of the Judiciary which, though not providing for the organisation and quality of the judicial work, lays upon the members of the Judiciary certain obligations, important in ensuring the transparency and independence of the judicial process.
