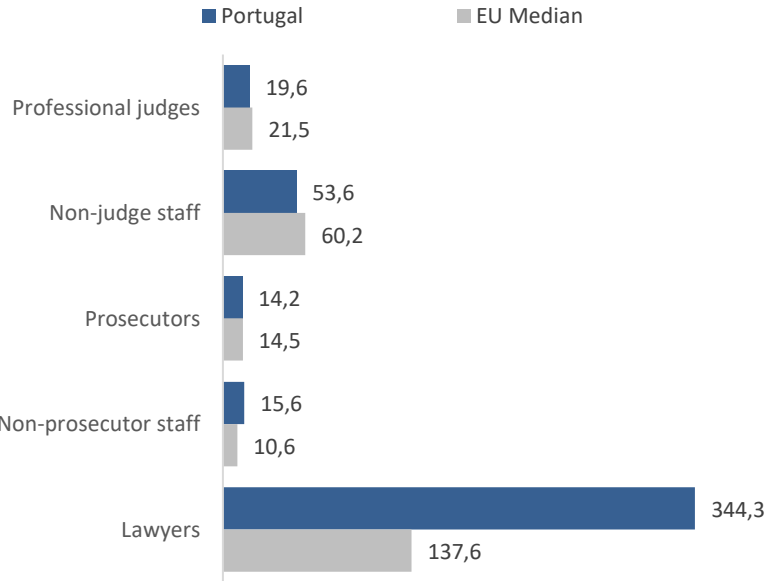

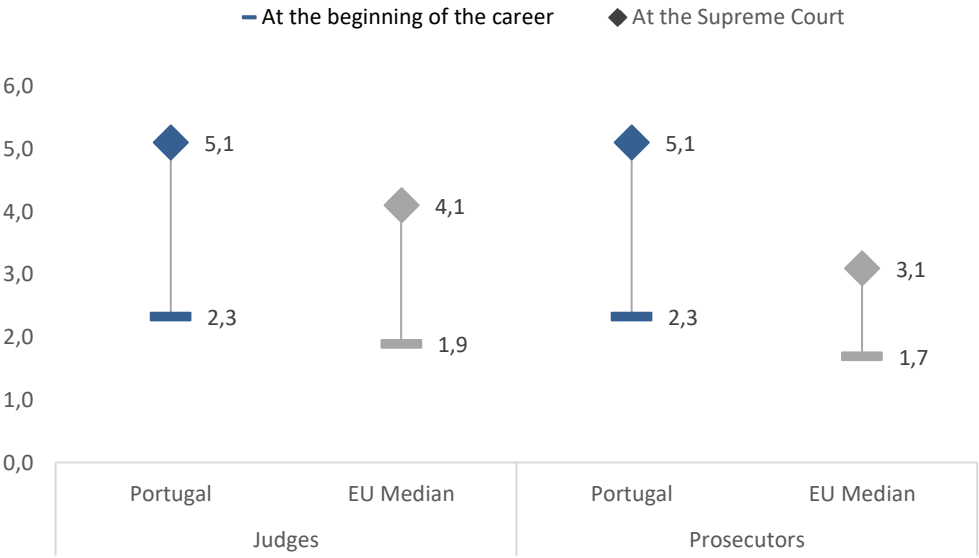

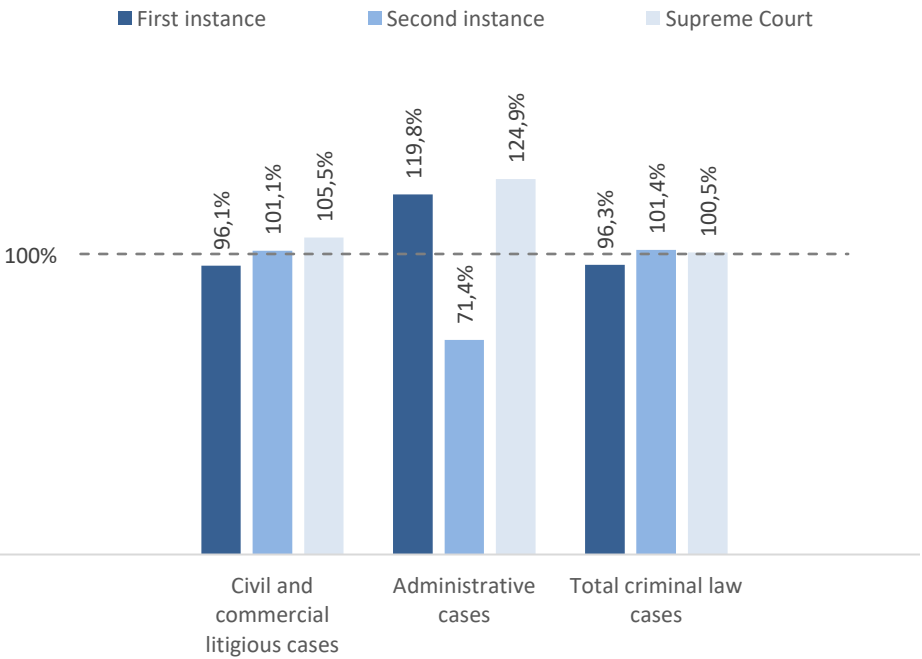


Gross salaries of judges and prosecutors vs average annual salary in 2023

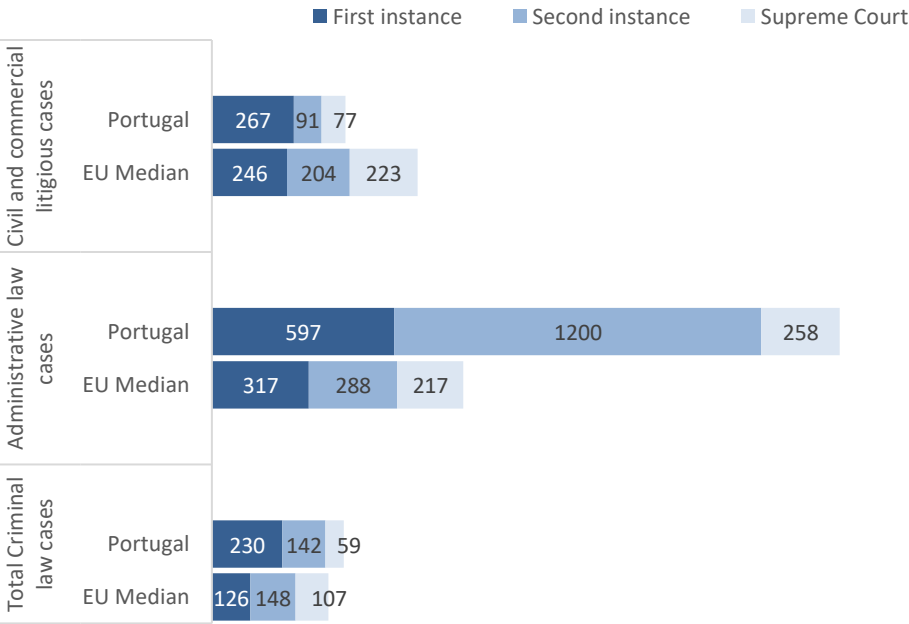

Clearance Rate by instance and by matter in 2023 (%)

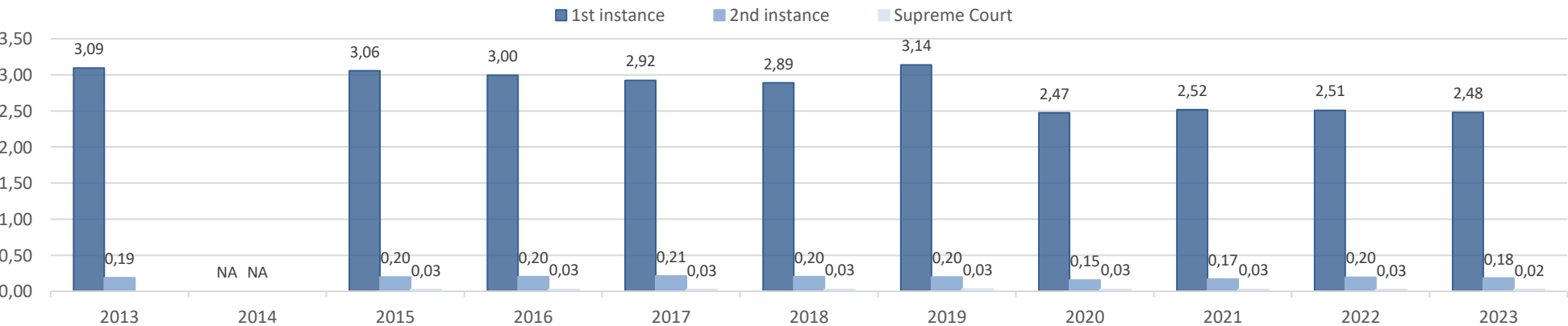


DispositionTime by instance and by matter in 2023 (days)

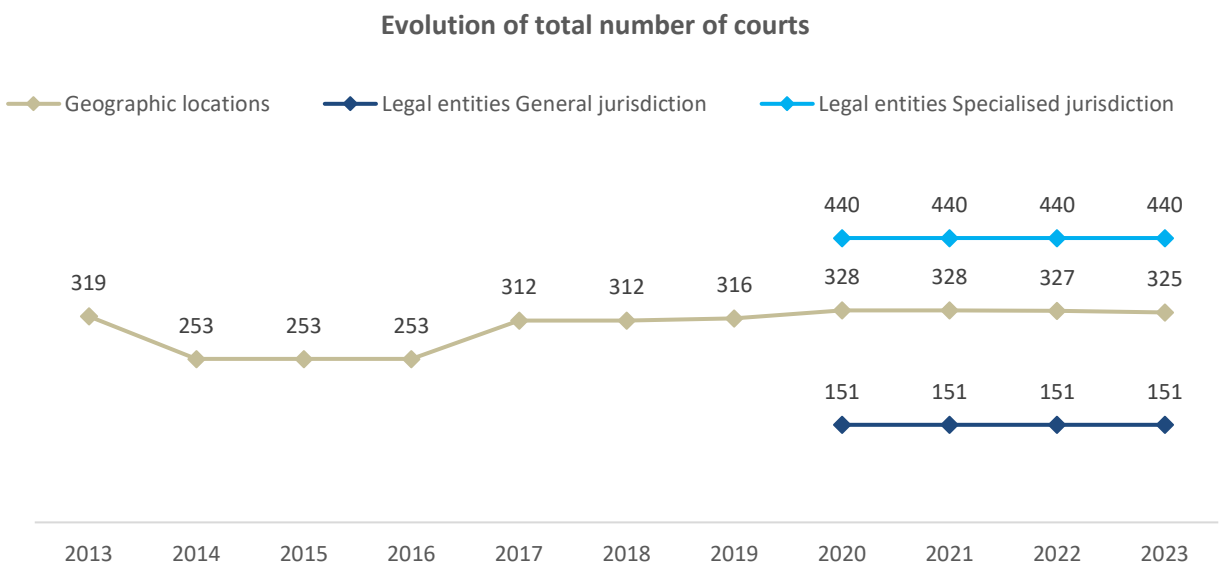
1. Judicial organisation in Portugal (2023 data)

In 2023, Portugal has a total of 591 courts (legal entities) in 325 geographic locations. The number of courts - legal entities include 151 general jurisdiction courts and 440 specialised jurisdiction courts. It is worth noticing that the percentage of the first instance specialised courts over the total number first instance courts is remarkably above the EU median (75,1% vs 25%).

Under the Portuguese Constitution, there are two set of courts: judicial courts, which have general jurisdiction in civil/commercial and criminal matters and encompass specialised courts, and administrative and tax courts, whose role is to settle disputes arising out of administrative and tax relations. The latter are specialised in this domain only. The ordinary justice administration in Portugal is organised on a three-level structure which includes: 145 first instance courts of general jurisdiction, 5 courts of appeal and the Supreme Court of Justice. The administrative justice which is autonomous, i.e. independent from the civil justice, is organised on a three-level structure which includes: 17 Administrative and Tax courts (first instance), and 3 higher instance courts of administrative jurisdiction.

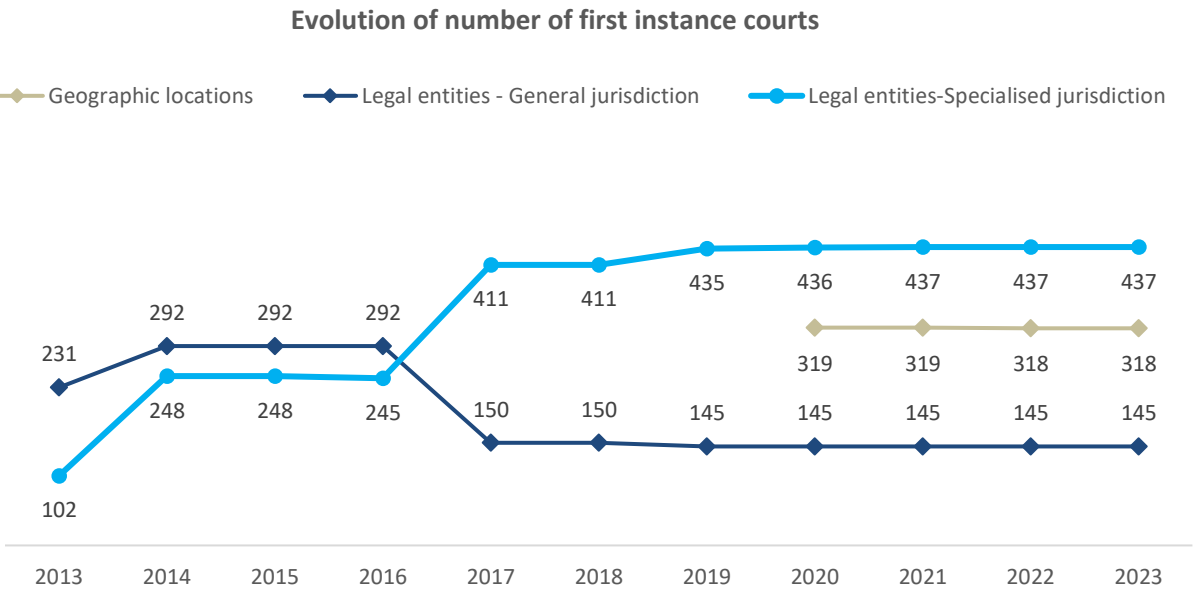

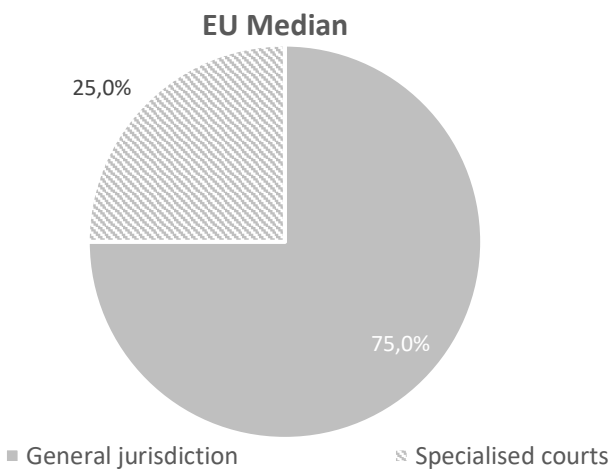
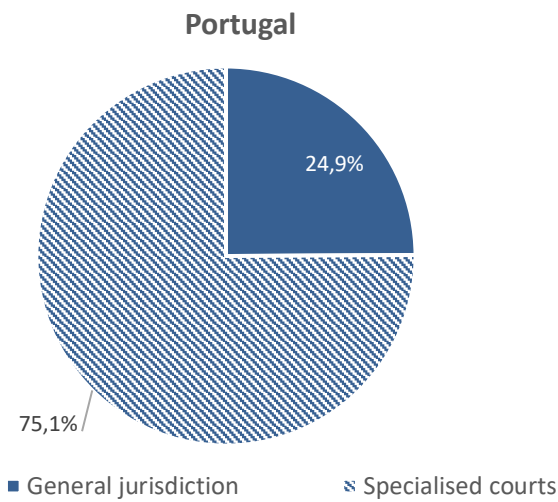

The distribution between first instance general jurisdiction courts and first instance specialised courts in Portugal is 24,9% - 75,1% (distribution tendency in EU: 75,0% - 25,0%). It is the highest percentage of first instance specialised courts in the EU.

As regards specialised courts, the data provided for 2023 include 17 first instance courts and 3 higher instance courts of administrative jurisdiction. In Portugal, Administrative courts belong to a separate jurisdiction and, under the law, are not considered specialised courts.

Commercial courts deal with, inter alia, winding up of the company, insolvency and suspension and revocation of company resolutions.

Internet related disputes: only for Internet domain system (DNS) issues, which are under the jurisdiction of the Intellectual Property Court; for all other Internet related issues, general jurisdiction courts are competent.

Other specialised courts: includes all other courts that are not listed in the categories above. This category includes Civil Central Judicial Divisions, Criminal Central Judicial Divisions, Civil Local Proximity Judicial Divisions, Criminal Local Proximity Judicial Divisions, Petty Criminality Local; Proximity Judicial Divisions, Criminal Examination Judicial Divisions, Enforcement Judicial Divisions, Central Criminal Examination Court, Competition Court and Maritime Court.

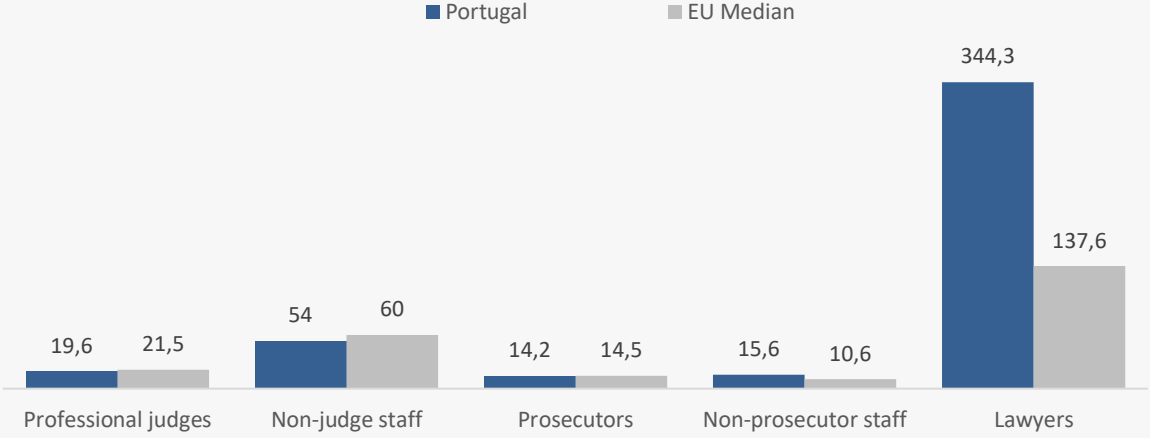

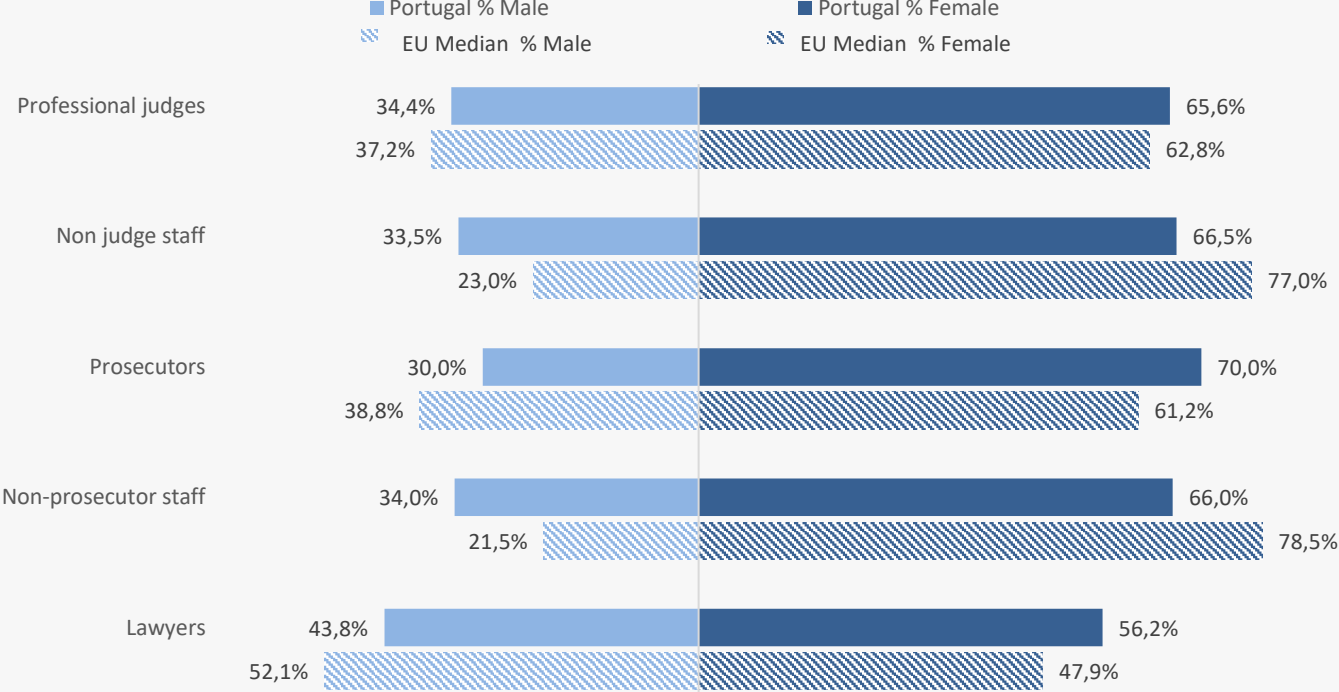
Judicial professionals per 100 000 inhabitants

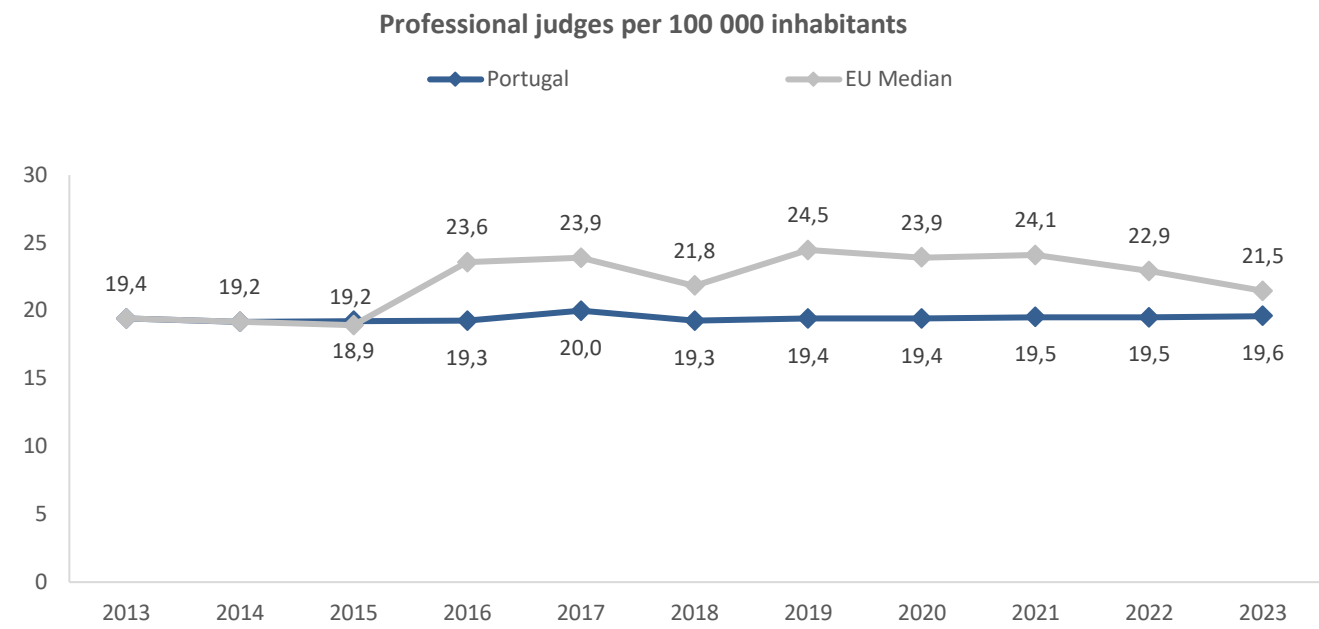

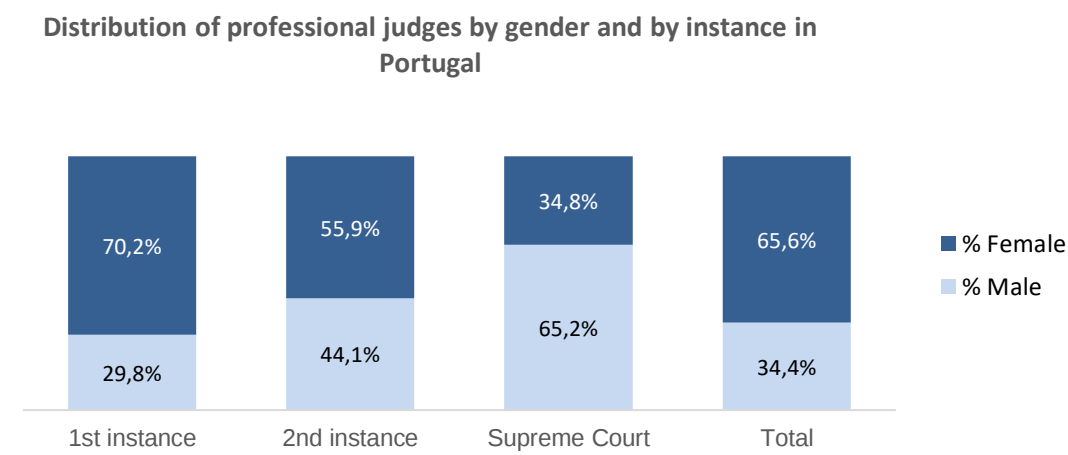
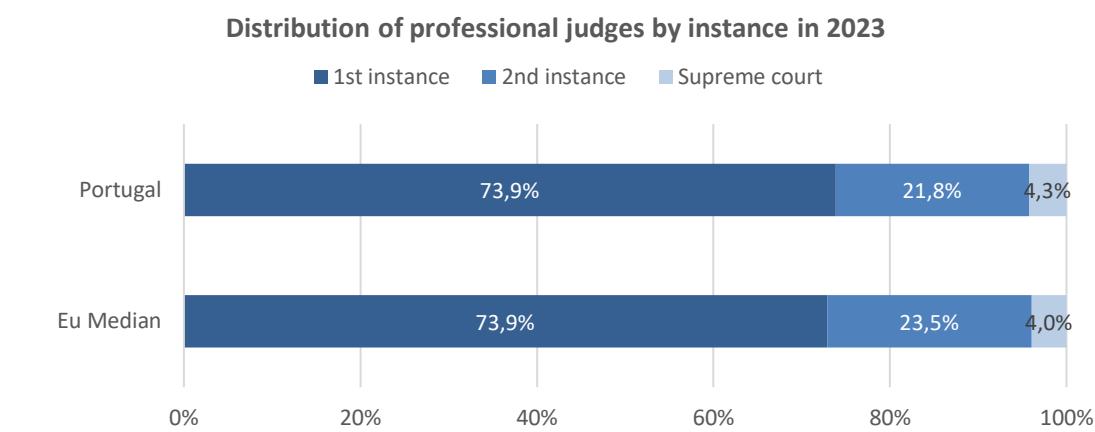


According to 2023 data, the total number of professional judges sitting in courts (all instances) in Portugal is 2 087, which is 2,2% more than in previous cycle.

More precisely, in Portugal, there are 19,6 professional judges per 100 000 inhabitants (this figure is below the EU median of 21,5 judges per 100 000 inhabitants)

The total number of judges is distributed among the different judicial instances in the following way: 1 542 are sitting in the first instance courts (of which 1 083 are female); 456 are sitting in the second instance courts (of which 255 are female) and 89 are sitting at the Supreme Court (of which 31 are female).

Regarding the male-to-female distribution, it is notable that while female judges constitute 65,6% of the total number of judges, their representation tends to decline as one progresses through the higher judicial instances.

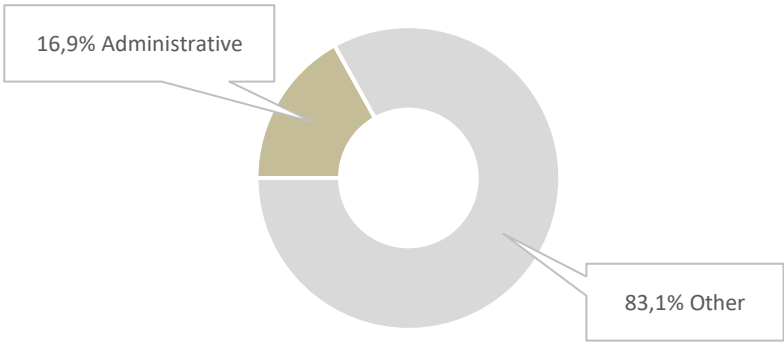

Distribution of the total number of professional judges by matter



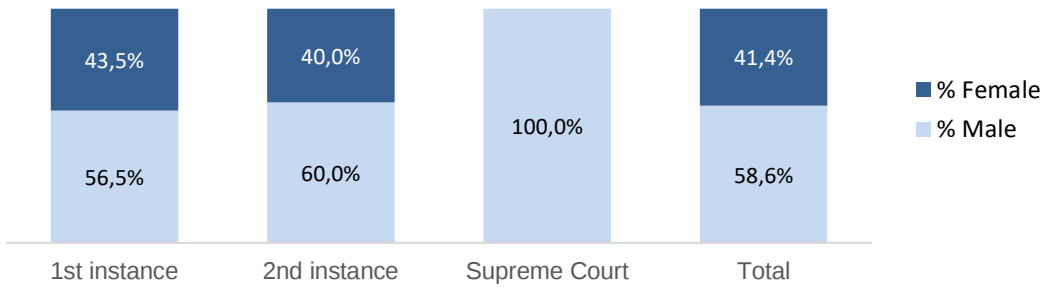

Distribution of court presidents by gender and by instance in Portugal

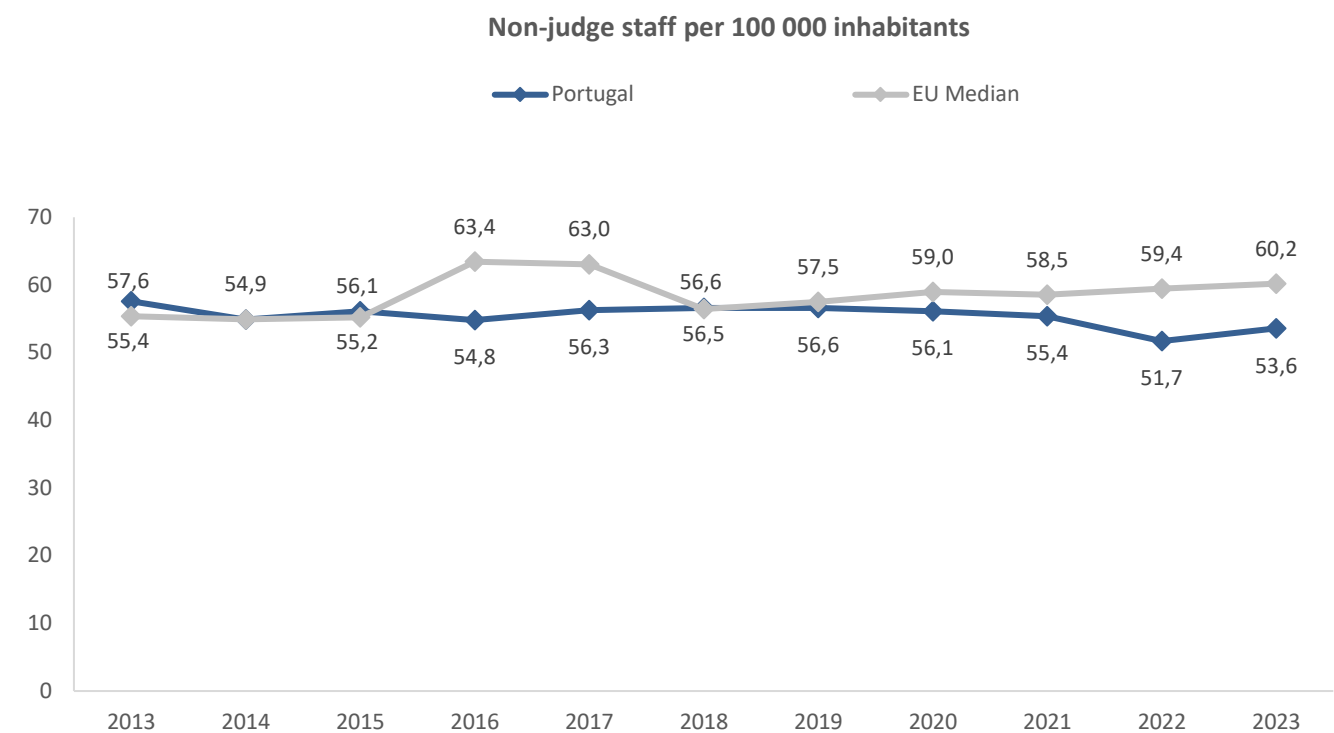


In this cycle, the total number of female court presidents (all instances) is 12, which represents 41,4% of the total number of court presidents.

The total number of court presidents is distributed among the different judicial instances in the following way: 23 are sitting in first instance courts (of which 10 are female); 5 are sitting in second instance courts (of which 2 are female), and 1 is sitting in Supreme Court (male judge).

In 2023, Portugal has 5 698 non-judge staff (of which 3 792 are Female). The total number of non-judge staff in comparison with the previous cycle reveals an increase of 5,3%. The number of non-judge staff per 100 000 inhabitants has increased (from 51,7 in 2022 to 53,6 in 2023). During the same period, the number of judges per 100 000 inhabitants evolved from 19,5 judges per 100 000 inhabitants in 2022 to 19,6 in 2023.

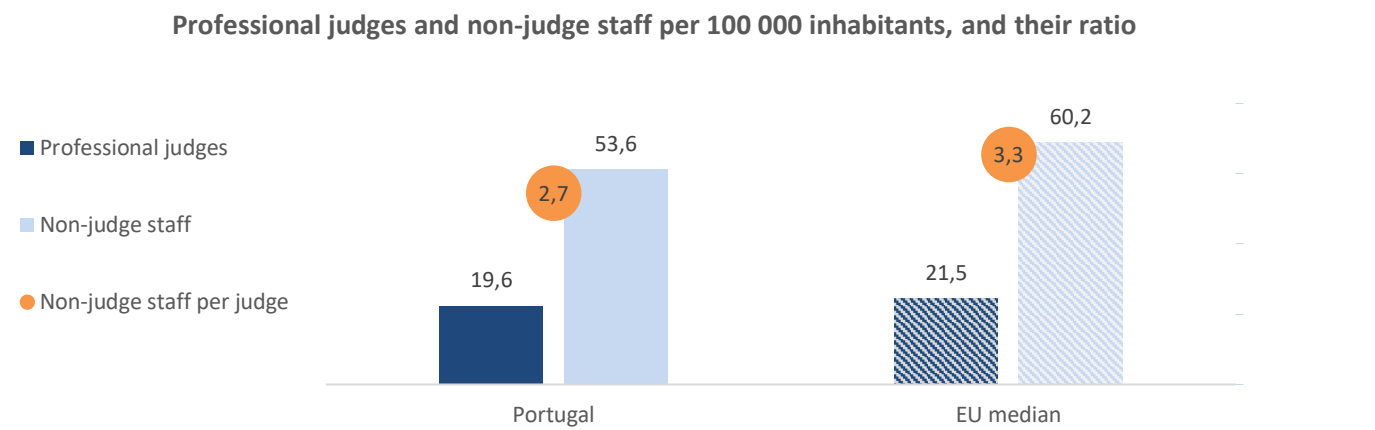
In this cycle, the non-judge staff is broken down as follows:

- 4 967 non-judge staff whose task is to assist the judges such as registrars (of which 3 332 are Female);
- 81 staff in charge of different administrative tasks and of the court management (of which 26 are Female);
- 426 technical staff (of which 310 are Female);
- 224 other (of which 124 are Female);

The data for the year 2023 reflects a change in the criteria for recording data on non-judge staff by the courts. The personnel working in the central units of the courts began to be registered in the court's common services personnel area.

Ratio between professional judges and non-judge staff

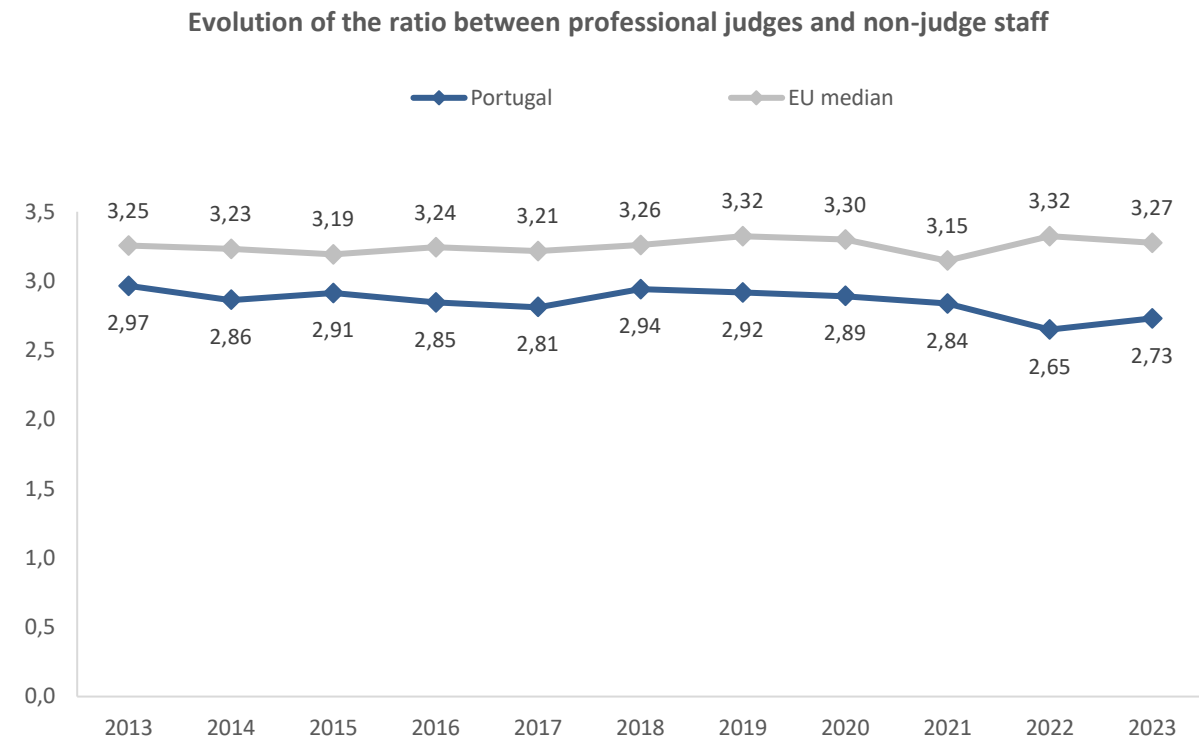

In Portugal, there are 19,6 professional judges per 100 000 inhabitants (this figure is below the EU median of 21,5 judges per 100 000 inhabitants) and about 2,7 non-judge staff per judge. There has been a small increase compared with previous cycle when this ratio was at 2,6 non-judge staff per judge.

Evolution of the ratio between professional judges and non-judge staff

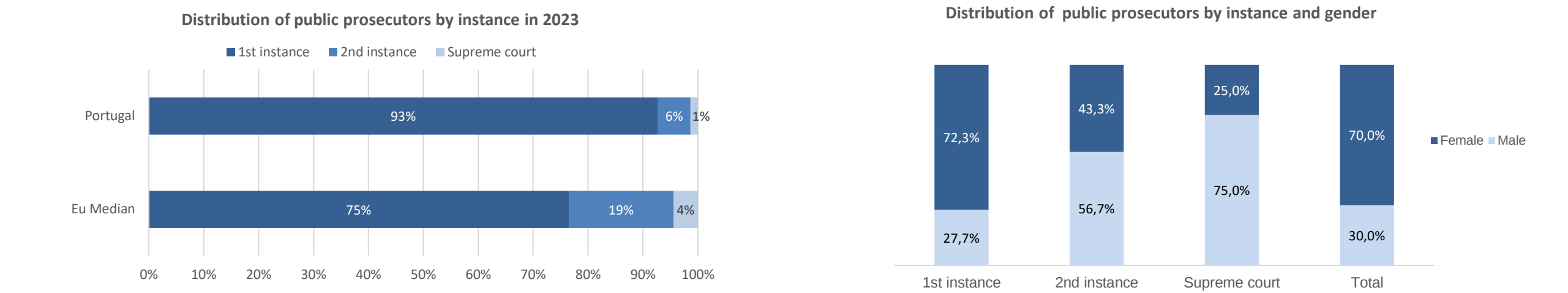

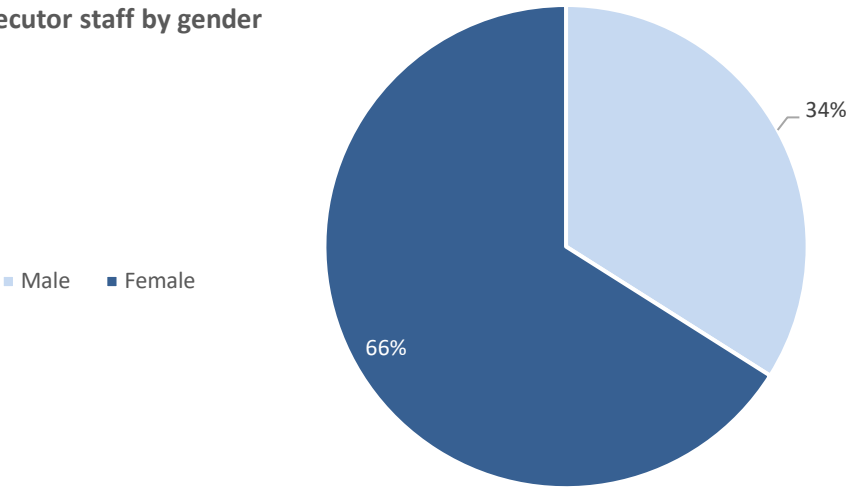

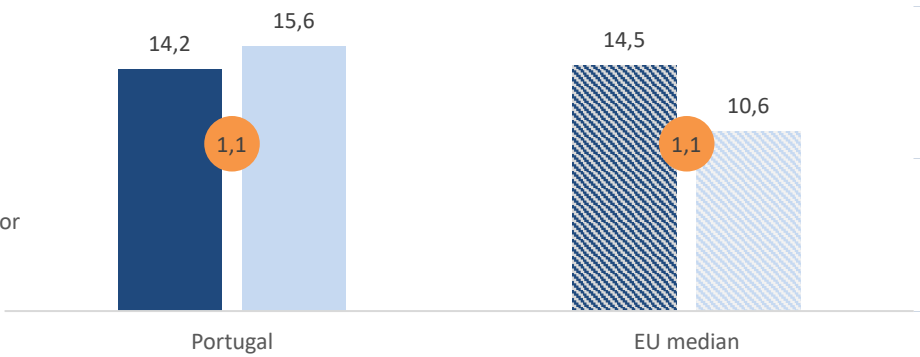

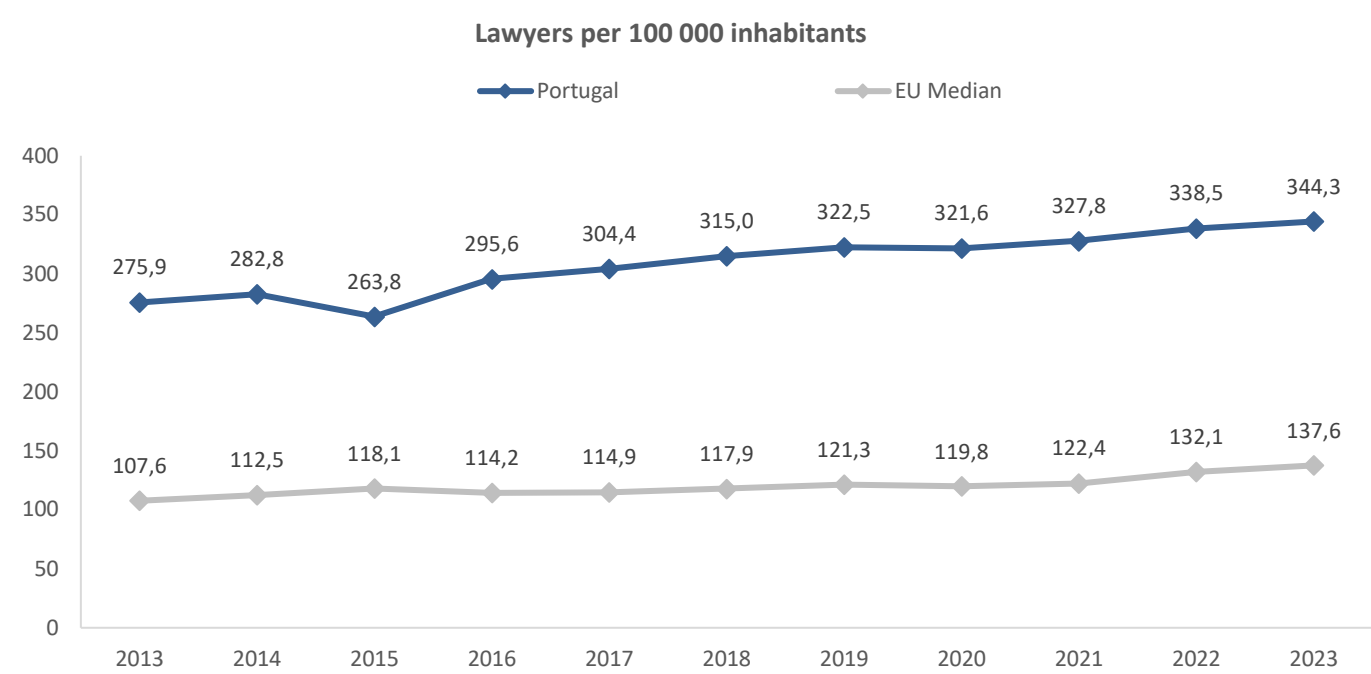

In the European Union, the absolute gross salary for a judge at the beginning of career ranges from a minimum of 25 759€ to a maximum of 144 856€.

According to 2023 data, the absolute gross salary of a judge at the beginning of his/her career in Portugal is 49 953€, which is slightly below the EU median of 58 128€. (-14% below)

The right to compensation in the cases listed is provided for in Law no. 67/2007 of December 31, which establishes the regime of non-contractual civil liability of the State and other Public Entities, specifically providing for an autonomous regime of State liability for damages arising from the exercise of the judicial function (chapter III, arts. 12 to 14).

In particular, with regard to Wrongful arrest/detention, it is important to mention article 225 and 226 of the Criminal Procedure Code, which provide for the right to compensation for illegal or unjustified deprivation of liberty by establishing a special regime. These articles also give effect to Article 27(5) CRP, which states that "Deprivation of liberty contrary to the provisions of the Constitution and the law shall constitute the State's duty to compensate the injured party under the terms established by law".

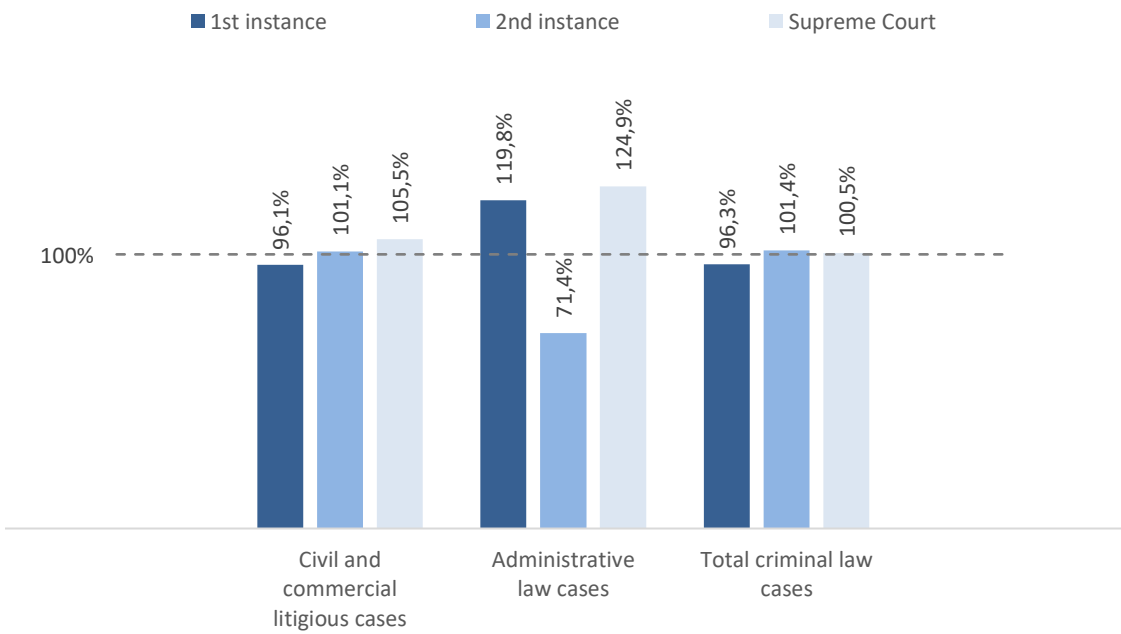

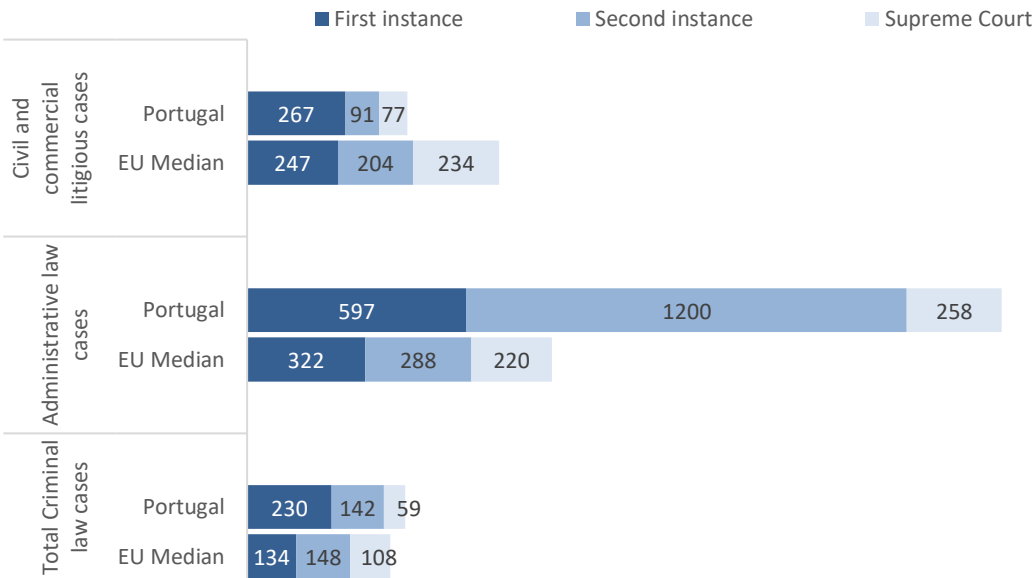

In 2023, criminal law cases were the fastest in Portugal, particularly at the third-instance level, where the Disposition Time was 59 days, well below the EU median of 108 days.

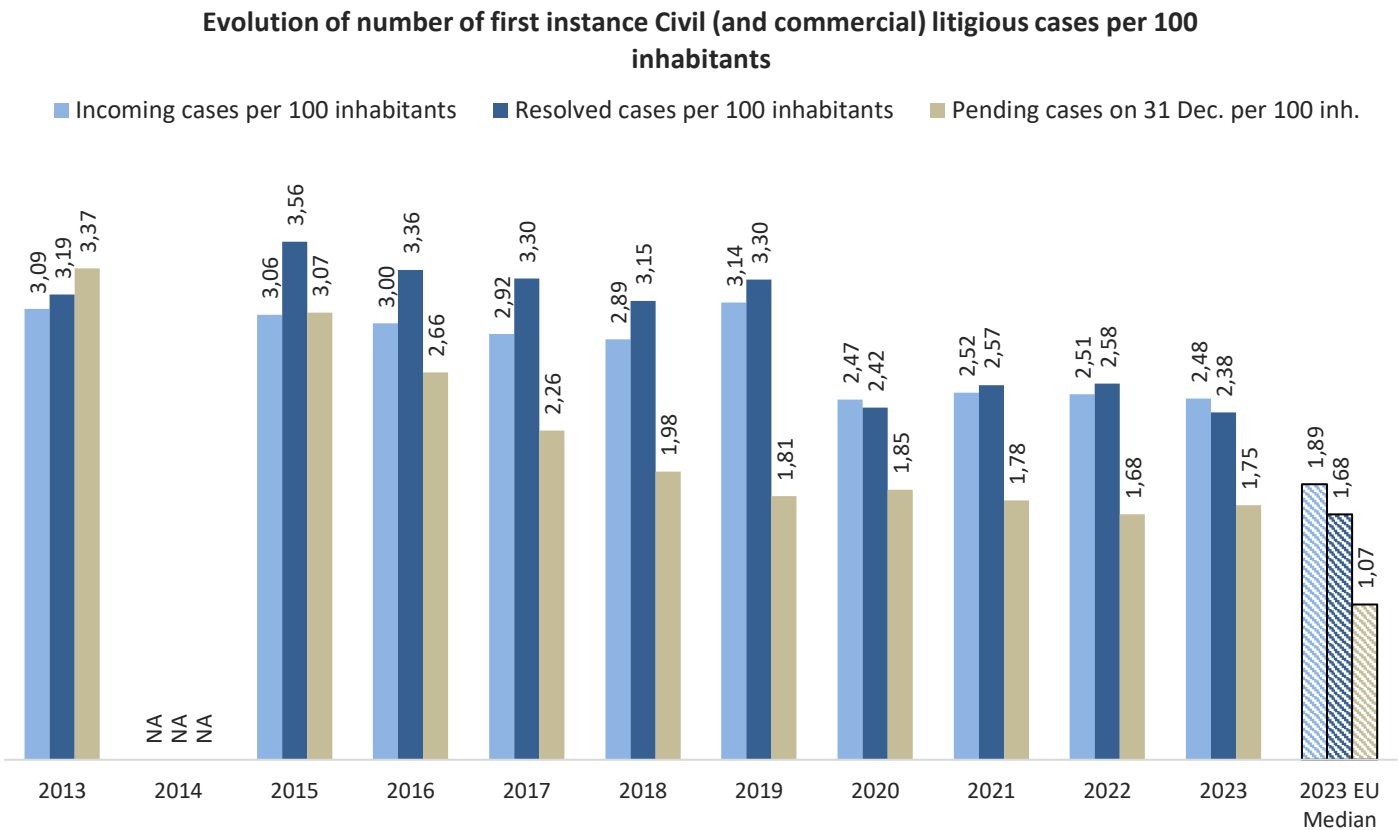
The handling of administrative cases showed improvement compared to the 2022 cycle. Clearance Rates increased across almost all instances: at first instance, from 111.7% to 119.8%, and at third instance, from 99.1% to 124.9%. Similarly, Disposition Times decreased at nearly every level: at first instance, from 747 to 597 days, and at third instance, from 300 to 258 days. This trend was not observed at second instance, where the Clearance Rate declined from 78.4% to 71.4%, and the Disposition Time increased from 1064 to 1200 days. However, it should be noted that in 2023, Portugal implemented a Decree-Law establishing specialised chambers in the central second instance administrative courts. The coming years will reveal whether this initiative reverses the trend at this level.

Finally, civil (and commercial) litigious cases (across all instances) are nearly as swift as criminal law cases in Portugal. At the first-instance level, the Disposition Time is 267 days, slightly higher than the EU median of 247 days. However, at the second and third-instance levels, the Disposition Times are significantly shorter than the EU median, at 91 days compared to 204 days and 77 days compared to 234 days, respectively.

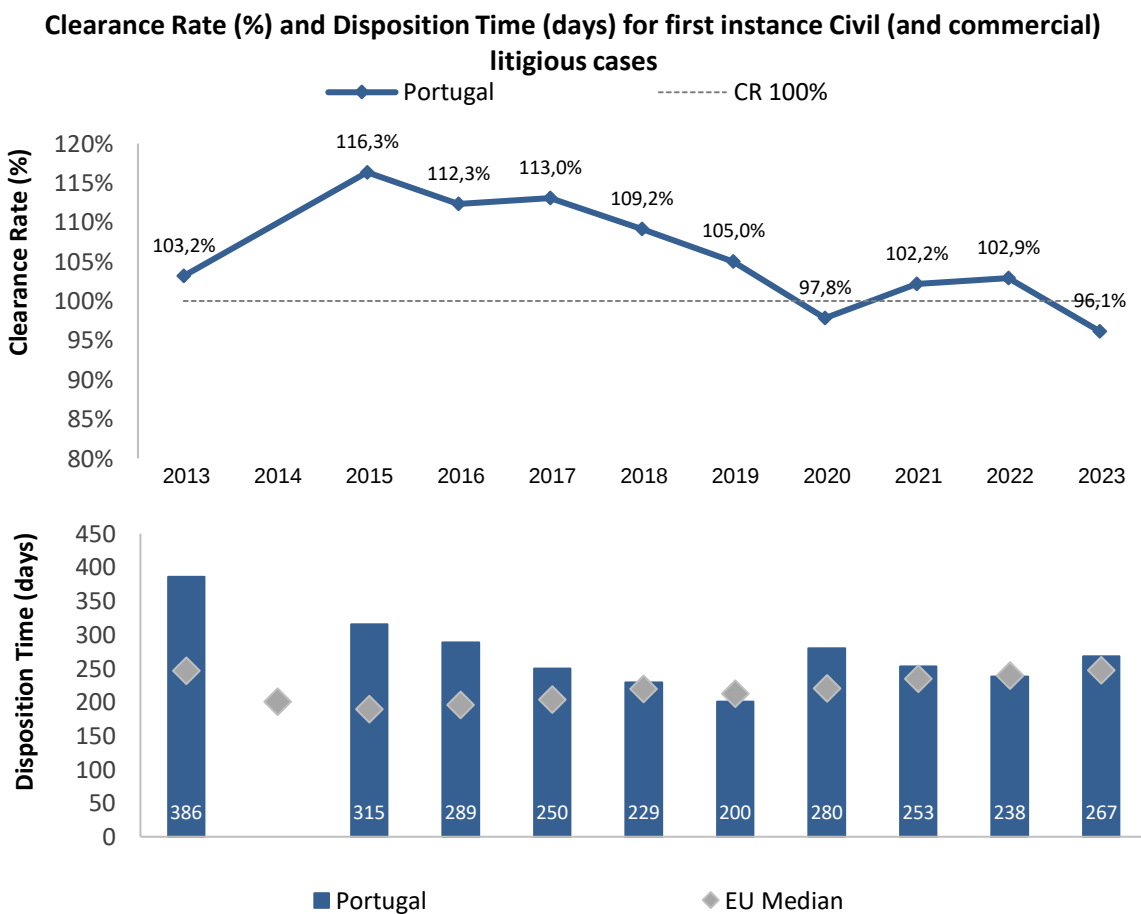

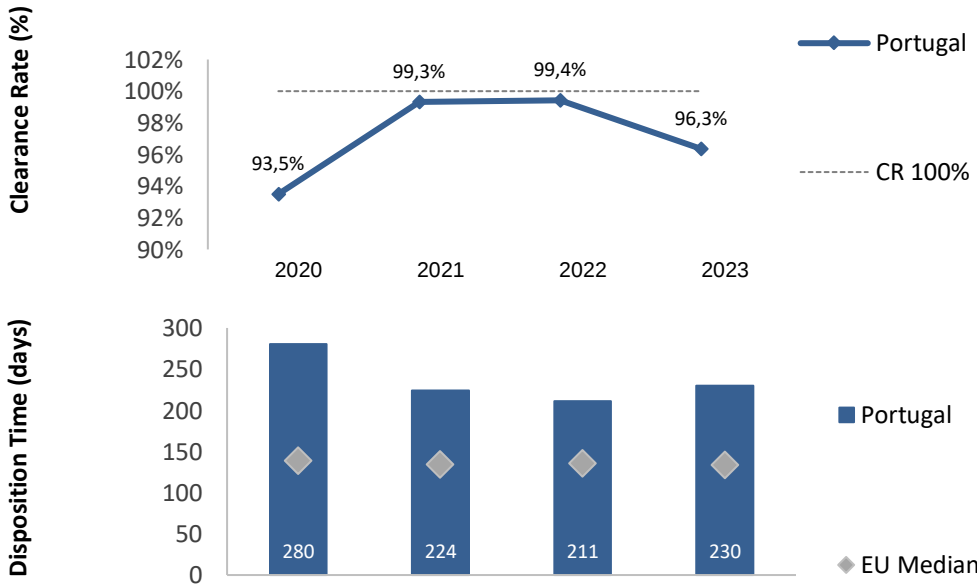

Clearance Rate (%) and Disposition Time (days) for First Instance Total criminal law cases



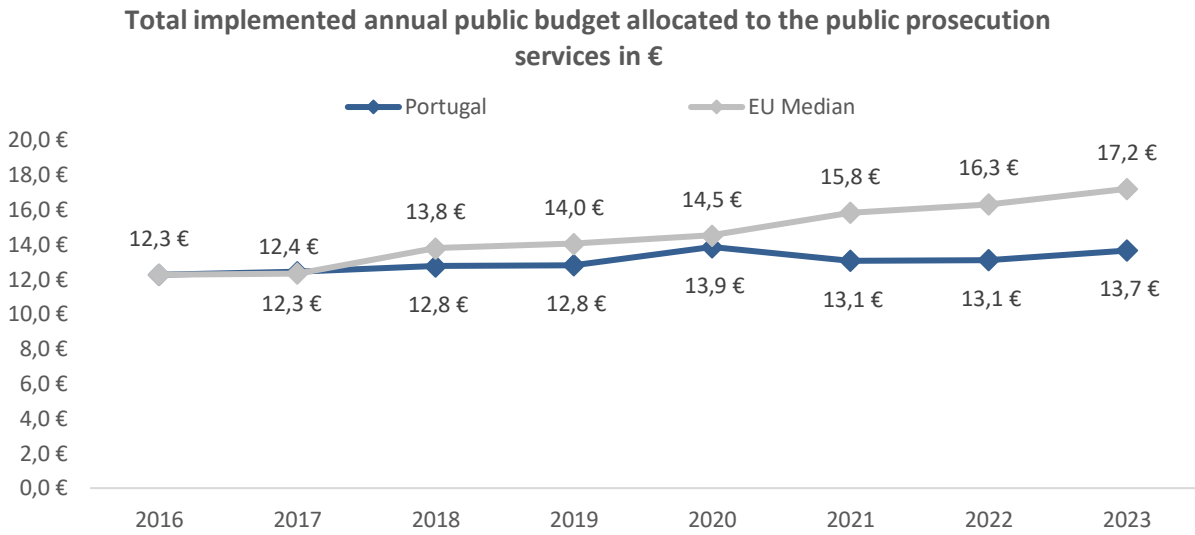

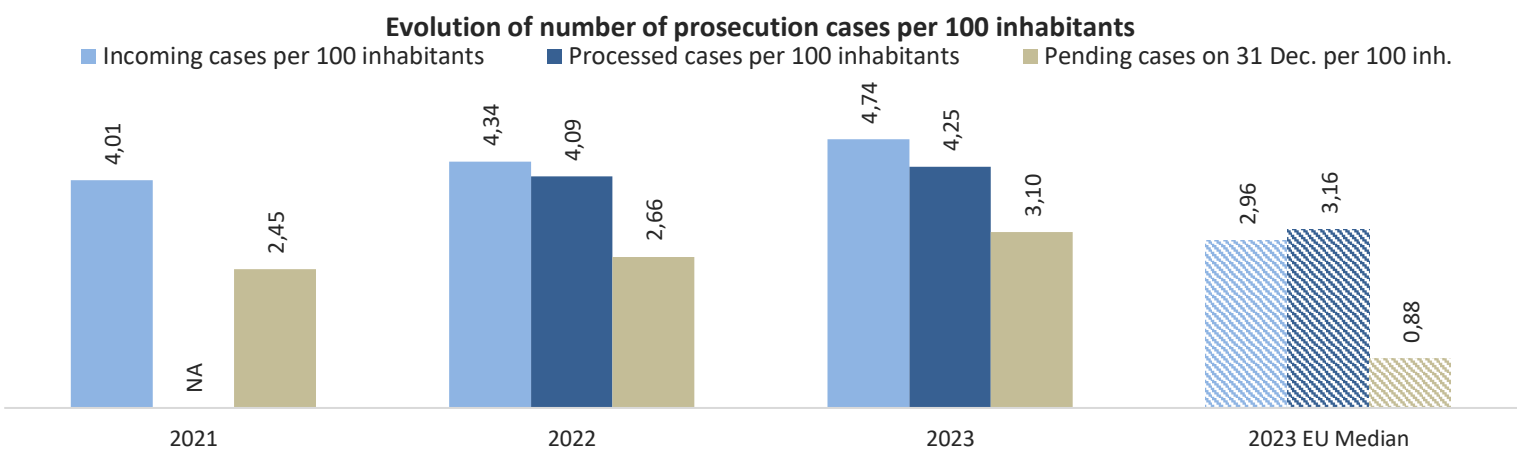

The counting unit for criminal proceedings at the investigation stage is the case, consistent with the unit used for counting incoming and outgoing cases in other matters. Incoming and outgoing cases also account for internal case transfers between units, with 36,432 such transfers recorded in 2023. Outgoing cases include those that are merged to form a single case. Cases remain open when the offender is unknown until the competent public prosecutor decides to close them after all identification efforts are exhausted. For statistical purposes, if a case is reopened, it is treated as a new case from the date of reopening.

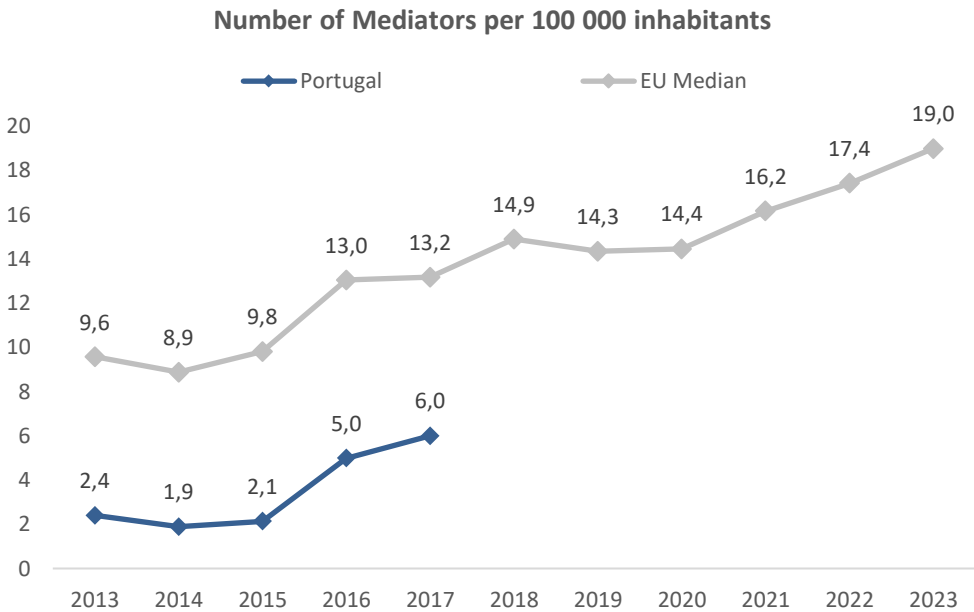


In 2023, the number of incoming, processed cases and pending cases at the end of year cases per 100 inhabitants are well above the EU median. Indeed, the incoming cases per 100 inhabitants are 4,74 (vs the EU median of 2,96), the processed cases are 4,25 (vs 3,16) and the pending cases at the end of the year are 3,10 (more than three times the EU median of 0,88).

In Portugal, there is a national registry managed by the Ministry of Justice, on private mediators and also a national registry on public mediators, but one can not determine who among them practice court- related mediation. Besides, since the registration of private mediators is not mandatory, there are also some mediators that are not registered and may practice court-related mediation.

In general, the mediator must:

- a) Be in full enjoyment of civil and political rights;
- b) Has attended and successfully completed a conflict mediation course given by a training entity certified by the Ministry of Justice under the terms of the law, or with a course in mediation of conflicts recognized by Justice Ministry;
- c) Have command of the Portuguese language.

3 - The requirement provided for in paragraph b) is also considered fulfilled by conflict mediators who:

- a) Being nationals of Member States of the European Union, or of the European economic area, have seen their qualifications obtained outside Portugal, recognized by the DGPJ, under the terms of Law no. No. 41/2012, of August 28;
- b) Being third-country nationals, having obtained, after an application submitted to the DGPJ, equivalence and recognition of their qualifications obtained outside Portugal, verified that it is the reciprocity of treatment of Portuguese mediators in their country of origin.

The integration on the list depends on the request of the interested party and a favorable decision by the Director General of Justice Policy.

In 2023, there are 522 notaries which represents 4,9 notaries per 100 000 inhabitants.

In 2004, a new status of the notarial profession was approved. Since, the notaries are private professionals under the authority (control) of public authorities. They compete for licenses and take office before the Minister of Justice and the president of the Chamber of Notaries. As a transition period is still running, some notaries work as public agents (before 2004, notaries were exclusively public officials). Since 2018, with Decree Law 115/2018, 21st December, "public notaries" ceased to exist and were transfered to the special carrear of registrar.

8. Systems for measuring and evaluating the performance of courts and public prosecution services in Portugal  
(2023 data)

In Portugal, quality standards are determined for the judicial system at national level (e.g. quality systems for the judiciary and/or judicial quality policies). Specialised personnel within the public prosecution services is entrusted with implementation of these national level quality standards.

The Law on the organisation of the judicial system (Law 62/2013 of 26 August) sets out that the High Council for the Judiciary and the Prosecutor-General, in liaison with the member of Government responsible for the justice, establish, within their respective competences, the strategic objectives for first instance courts for a three year period. These entities are also responsible for setting, every year, the strategic objectives of first instance courts for the following judicial year.

After taking into account the results obtained in the previous year and the strategic objectives formulated for the subsequently year, the president of the court and the public prosecutor coordinator, after hearing the judiciary administrator, articulate proposals for the procedural objectives for each court. For instance, the Prosecutor General's Directives and Instructions define good practices of functional performance at national level and their compliance may be viewed an indicator of the quality of the work developed (example, Directive 5/2019, on acting in cases of domestic violence (<https://dre.pt/home/-/dre/126870404/details/maximized> - text in Portuguese).

In addition to Directives and Instructions, the performance assessment system for prosecutors is based on quality criteria/performance parameters, as a rule, uniformly applied at national level.

The High Council of the Public Prosecution Service has “inspectors” (“inspectores”) who assess the quality of the work carried out by the prosecutors, applying national quality criteria or standards.

The procedural objectives of the district focus primarily on the number of completed cases and their duration, taking into account factors such as the nature of the cases and their value. These objectives are determined in relation to the available human resources and operational capacity of the district, and they are guided by established procedural reference values.

These objectives must not influence, restrict, or dictate the decisions made in specific cases, whether regarding the merits of the matter or the choice of the most suitable procedural form.

They are to be incorporated into the annual objectives set for judicial officers and taken into account during their performance assessments. Furthermore, they must be reflected in the evaluation criteria for magistrates, as defined by their respective Councils.
