

**INFORMATION NOTE REGARDING THE DECREE LAWS ON THE MEASURES TAKEN
WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE STATE OF EMERGENCY**

1) Decree Law No. 688 dated 29 March 2017

Public officials who were reinstated to their profession and students whose studentship rights have been returned:

416 public officials who were dismissed from profession in accordance with the previously enacted Decree-Laws have been reinstated to their duties after the re-evaluations determined that they had no connection or affiliation with the terrorist organizations. Accordingly, the actions taken against these persons shall be deemed to have ceased with all their effects and consequences as of the date of the publication of the relevant decree law. In order to prevent any unjust treatment, review requests of public officials who have no connection with terrorist organizations are being investigated in detail and those whose objections are accepted are reinstated to their profession.

2) Decree Law No. 689 dated 29 April 2017

Measures with respect to public officials:

Some public officials who have connection, affiliation or membership with the terrorist organizations have been dismissed from profession.

Public officials who were reinstated to their profession and students whose studentship rights have been returned:

236 civil servants who were dismissed from profession in accordance with the previously published Decree Laws have been reinstated to their duties after the re-evaluations determined that they had no connection or affiliation with the terrorist organizations. As mentioned above, the actions taken against these persons shall be deemed to have ceased with all their effects and consequences as of the date of the publication of the relevant decree law. In order to prevent any unjust treatment, review requests are being investigated in detail and those whose objections are accepted are reinstated to their profession.

Measures related to institutions and organizations

Some newspapers, periodicals, foundations, associations and private health institutions which have belonging to, affiliation or connection to the terrorist organizations and have special importance in the funding of terrorist organizations have been closed down.

Students studying abroad

Some students who have been studying abroad with scholarship and have membership, affiliation or connection to the terrorist organizations have been dismissed from studentship. In this respect, it was aimed to prevent the armed terrorist organizations from recruiting members abroad.
