Concept

Through a short series of webinar, the CINGO Committee on Education for Democracy seeks to leverage on civil society and their wealth of knowledge to share working practices that are effective in learning, teaching and shaping democracy. The experience of democratic processes is essential in all learning environments, in that democracy is not something that is aseptically taught but rather something that needs to be experienced. In a learner-centred approach, involving learners in the design of their education remains a central endeavor. This is all the more appropriate for non-formal and informal learning environments.
