
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Data protection landscape



- 144 countries have adopted data protection laws
- 30 African countries
- 5 African countries have ratified Convention 108
- Currently 42 countries have signed the modernised Convention108+ and 8 have ratified it
- Mauritius is the 1st African country to ratify Convention108+
