Restructuring and streamlining of the Rules of Procedure

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Information memorandum¹

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1. Background

1. The Parliamentary Assembly has regularly revised its Rules of Procedure to ensure that the Rules of Procedure are up to date, consistent and effective, including through general revisions of the Rules of Procedure. The last such general revision took place in 1999. Since then, many amendments have been made to the Rules of Procedure and the complementary texts. As a result, the Rules book, containing the Rules of Procedure and some of those complementary texts, has become rather unwieldy. It now runs to 52 pages of Rules with 130 footnotes, plus 22 Appendices with another 114 footnotes on an additional 127 pages.²

2. On 11 April 2025, the Bureau of the Assembly seized the Committee on Rules, Ethics and Immunities ('Rules Committee') to prepare a report on the "Modification of various provisions of the Rules of Procedure", as a follow-up to [Resolution 2596 \(2025\)](#) on "Respect for the Rule of Law and the fight against corruption within the Council of Europe" in which the Assembly resolved to "revise the structure of its Rules of Procedure to make it more coherent, accessible, and user-friendly..." (paragraph 5.1). This follows the explanatory report to [Resolution 2551 \(2024\)](#) on "Modification of various provisions of the Assembly's Rules of Procedure" which called for "significant editorial work" to be undertaken "to make the Rules of Procedure more reader-friendly and ensure coherence" (paragraph 77). These explicit references highlight the recognition of the need to restructure and streamline the Rules of Procedure to ensure that the Rules are coherent and user-friendly, reflecting the standards expected of a parliamentary institution devoted to upholding respect for the Rule of Law.

2. The process, drafting style and approach

3. From June 2025 to May 2026, the Rules Committee discussed and developed its ideas for the work to restructure and streamline its Rules of Procedure. The Committee agreed that the streamlining would involve shortening the rules and reducing the number of footnotes and appendices, as well as deleting obsolete rules, harmonising any contradictory provisions, and simplifying the language where possible and appropriate. The streamlining of the rules would thus not contain any significant "material" changes to the rules. The object of the streamlining exercise would be to:

- improve the coherence between the different provisions of the Rules of Procedure and the complementary texts,
- increase the effectiveness of the rules by ensuring they are easy-to-read, more accessible and more user-friendly.

4. As in 1999, the draft resolution adopted by the Rules Committee and then the Assembly should include, as an Appendix, the complete Rules of Procedure – which, then as now, would not be amendable in plenary given that specific substantive amendments would be out of scope for a simple streamlining exercise.

5. In order to understand the intention and relationship between the 'old rules' and the 'new rules' the transposition tables are set out in the Appendix to this information note, which should be declassified to assist with transparency of the process. Appendix I contains a transposition table setting out the source of the 'new rules'. Appendix II contains a transposition table setting out the new location for each of the 'old rules'. This way the destination of the rules can be easily traced for transparency and accountability which should assist if there are any questions as to intention or origin of the text.

6. In terms of the drafting style, this has been simplified as follows:

- **Definitional terms:** drafting techniques have been used to define certain words to simplify the drafting making it easier to read. For example, general committees are categorised as "thematic" or "institutional"³. Similar definitional techniques are used for referring to "office-holders of the Assembly", for example, instead of listing all of the roles on each occasion.
- **Clarification:** clarifications have been made to reflect existing, well-established practice. For example, to make clear who can attend public, private and in camera meetings, or to clarify how networks are created. These are not material changes but make the process clearer.

³ The institutional committees are those whose members are proposed by political groups (the Committee on the Honouring of Obligations and Commitments by Member States of the Council of Europe (Monitoring Committee), the Committee on Rules, Ethics and Immunities and the Committee on the Election of Judges to the European Court of Human Rights). The thematic committees are those whose members are proposed by national delegations (the Committee on Political Affairs and Democracy, the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights, the Committee on Social Affairs, Health and Sustainable Development, the Committee on Migration, International Protection and Economic Co-operation, the Committee on Culture, Science, Education and Media, and the Committee on Equality and Non-Discrimination).

- **Language:** the language has been updated so as to be aligned with Council of Europe official instructions (e.g. 2021 style guide, 2024 guidelines).
- **Removal of obsolete provisions:** the provision referring to the 'roll-call procedure' in committee has been removed as this is archaic and no longer used. The language has been clarified to best reflect Parliamentary Assembly practice and realities.
- **Replacement of 'age' with 'length of service in the Assembly':** following complaints by some members that the Assembly's existing practice of asking the oldest member to chair for the election of the President was overtly ageist, this has been replaced with the member who has been a member of the Assembly for the longest period of time – thus reflecting experience of Assembly procedures (rather than simply age).
- **Footnotes:** footnotes have been removed where possible to make it easier to read. The information has instead been incorporated within the text, hyperlinked or deleted, where unnecessary. This is again recorded in the transposition tables.

3. The structure of the rules

7. The Rules Committee agreed to split the Rules of Procedure into four separate parts: (1) Basic Principles of the Assembly; (2) Rules on the Functioning of the Assembly; (3) Rules on the Functioning of Committees; and (4) Code of Conduct for members of the Parliamentary Assembly. Specifically:

- the **Basic Principles of the Assembly** group together the essential "raison d'être", Principles and competences of the Assembly – many of which are found in other documents (such as the Statute or the General Agreement on Privileges and Immunities) and which is a notable omission in the current Rules of Procedure, when contrasting them with the rules of other interparliamentary assemblies;
- the **Rules on the Functioning of the Assembly** and the **Rules on the Functioning of Committees** are separate self-contained documents (for Assembly and for Committee work respectively). The intention is that this should make it easier, for example, to access the Rules on the Functioning of Committees as a smaller, largely self-contained, set of rules;
- the **Code of Conduct for members of the Parliamentary Assembly** would be integrated as one of the four core parts of the Rules (rather than as an Appendix) as envisaged by the [Resolution 2596 \(2025\)](#) 'Respect for the rule of law and the fight against corruption within the Council of Europe';
- there would **no longer be voluminous appendices to the Rules of Procedure**, making the overall Rules of Procedure much shorter and focussed on the core rules and principles, with modalities set out in revised, easily accessible documents on the webpage.

4. The structure of the complementary texts

8. The current appendices to the Rules are both too long (taking up around 70% of the Rules document) and do not always contain all of the relevant documents and information – such as Bureau documents setting out modalities for the application of the rules, or decisions of the Rules Committee interpreting the rules. Some of these additional documents are referenced in existing footnotes to the Rules of Procedure, or in the appendices, but not all. The Rules Committee decided that it would improve clarity to produce easy-to-access modalities documents grouping together the relevant modalities provisions – rather than multiple footnotes, appendices and other documents.

9. The Committee therefore additionally agreed to pursue, later in 2026, a significant piece of work on the restructuring, accessibility and transparency of the complementary texts. The transposition tables set out in the Appendix indicate where any provisions of the existing rules, footnotes or complementary texts would be found under the revised structure – including hyperlinks. Key elements of the revised complementary texts would be:

- **hyperlinks** to relevant statutory texts and **Assembly guidelines** which could be readily accessible on the 'Assembly Procedure' webpage;
- hyperlinks to documents relevant to the **external relations of the Assembly** (available on the 'Assembly Procedure' webpage, ideally through a specific 'external relations' webpage);
- a new **compendium** on the **modalities relating to the organisation of Assembly business**;
- the adoption of **modalities for the participation of special guests, observers, partners for democracy and other guests**;

- a new compendium of **modalities relating to the organisation of committee business as well as the Terms of References of Assembly Committees**⁴;
- **modalities relating to access to and use of the Council of Europe premises**;
- a **compendium of the determinations and interpretations given by the Rules Committee**.

⁴ The terms of reference of committees require a resolution of the Assembly prepared by the Rules Committee, and not simply a Bureau document. Certain of the other complementary texts similarly require a resolution of the Assembly (e.g. the procedure for the Election of Judges Committee; the procedure in the Monitoring Committee; the Guidelines on Privileges and Immunities).
