The Committee on Education for Democracy was approved by the General Assembly of CINGO in April 2022; since then, it contributed to sharing best practices across CoE member states, mainstreaming the most innovative and efficient methods to embed democratic values in all forms of education and training. We are seeking an extension of the mandate for one additional year to focus our work on advocacy outputs and ensure that the work done so far can meaningfully contribute to the policy priorities of the Council of Europe.

The purpose of the extension is for INGOs to follow the steps outlined by the new Council of Europe Education Strategy "Learners First". In particular, we would like to uphold the very first principle, i.e. to "renew the democratic and civic mission of education" by showing 1) how non-formal and informal pedagogies have a bigger role to play and 2) how civil society working in education and training is best-placed to answer this call. So far, the Committee collected a compendium of different existing inspiring practices to reinforce "Democratic participation" through non-formal and informal learning, linked to the Council of Europe Education strategy and Conference of INGOs Strategic Plan.

Showcasing the contribution of civil society to education and democracy has been the core pillar of this Committee for the past two years. Now, members of the Committee on Education for Democracy seek to bring civil society expertise directly into the work of the Council of Europe by offering policy recommendations that, based on the compendium and the practices it gathered, can enhance not only the role of education in our democracies, but also the part that civil society organisations play in it. Besides, allowing organising civil society into the very heart of decision-making is itself a democratic principle. The Committee would also like to contribute to the next Conference of INGOs Strategic Plan for the next three years.
