Committee on Migrants' Rights and Women's Rights (and the Gender Issue)	The consideration of women's rights and the gender issue was addressed and gave rise to an intervention during the autumn 2023	Continue to address vulnerable people, including women, children, families and LGBTQI+ people	Intensify and develop contacts with the INGOs concerned.

6. Migration and education	Access to the Right to Education has not been sufficiently addressed in recent months. This is a goal for the end of the mandate.	Ask the INGOs of the Conference and problematize the issue to facilitate its study. Contact the CoE Education Department	Organize a webinar or roundtable discussion on access to education for migrants, especially children.

9. Is there anything else you would like to share with INCE members and/or the Standing Committee of the COING?

Since its creation, the Committee on the Rights of Migrants has been committed to improving migrants' access to their human rights. Among the conclusions drawn so far, it appears that the bridge between the different headings of safety, health, education and physical integrity appears to be accommodation.

Accommodation is undoubtedly one of the aspects that should be developed in a future mandate of the Committee on the Rights of Migrants in the event that it is renewed.
