

Observation interprétative de l'article 7§5

The Committee stressed that if it was to fulfil a useful supervisory role in respect of this provision, the Contracting States must supply it with full information on the minimum rates and wages actually paid to young workers and apprentices for all branches of industry and in all parts of the national territory.

The Committee found that, in the three reports submitted to it, information was lacking on one or other of the above points. As a result, the Committee was unable to state whether or not the governments of Italy, Norway and the United Kingdom fulfilled the undertakings deriving from Paragraph 5 of Article 7 of the Charter.
