

Statement of interpretation on Article 7§10

The Committee recognised that this paragraph is very general in scope and aims to ensure protection against all physical and moral dangers to which children and young people are exposed, whether or not such dangers are a result of their work. Because of the way in which the questions were phrased on the "form" according to which the governments of the Contracting States submitted their reports, in accordance with Article 21 of the Charter, most governments replied only on the measures taken in connection with young workers. The Committee therefore expressed the wish that the second governmental reports would contain comprehensive information on the protection of young people against the moral and physical dangers to which they are exposed.
