

Statement of interpretation on Article 19§8

The first Cyprus report gave the Committee an opportunity to interpret the terms "workers lawfully residing within their territories" appearing in paragraph 8 of Article 19 of the Charter; the Committee specified in this connection that in order to benefit from the protection here provided for, a migrant worker must be in possession of all papers legally required by the country of residence for regular residence, including if need be, a residence permit and a work permit.
