

Statement of Interpretation on Article 10

On examining the reports submitted as part of the third cycle of supervision, the Committee was led, once again, to lay stress on the information it requires to be able to determine whether or not a State satisfies the provisions of Article 10.

It recalled that Article 33 applies to all the paragraphs of this article, which involves an obligation on the States to supply recent statistics in each biennial report to permit the Committee to determine whether these provisions are applied to the great majority of the workers concerned.

It made it clear that, irrespective of the application of Article 33, the wording and content of this article by themselves make it necessary for such information to be included in every report.
