

Statement of interpretation on Article 11§1

In the course of the examination of the second report submitted by the Government of Cyprus, the Committee found that this government's replies to a request made after the examination of the first report by that State for, in particular, detailed information on industrial medicine, gave the impression that this sector was concerned only with occupational diseases. The Committee was obliged to point out that, in its view, industrial medicine is not confined to this aspect but should also cover problems concerning the adjustment of individuals to the occupational surroundings, accident prevention etc.
