**=>> Open** the possibility, with the secretariats concerned, of sending a representative of the E&H committee to the meetings of the PACE Committee on Social Affairs, Health and Sustainable Development and of the relevant CLRA committees when a report is related to the activities of the E&H Committee.

The objective is to offer the skills of our high-level experts to these assemblies and in turn to be able to disseminate their work.

- =>> **Disseminate** the texts and work of all the committees to all the pillars of the Council of Europe on all themes, without exception. In particular to the Steering Committees, the Congress and PACE committees as well as the competent GRs and the General Secretariat (formal transmission other than the Newsletter).
- =>> **Inform** the committee of the monitoring of the transmission to the CM and other bodies of the recommendations adopted by the Conference on the proposal of the Committee. Information on the response provided by the Secretariat General.
- =>> Finally, while bearing in mind that the Conference is not an institutional body but that civil society is one of the assets that the Council of Europe seeks to develop, see how the work of the committees can be taken into account in the general framework of the activity of the Council of Europe (Cf. Recent visit of the SG to the UNGA: no reference was made to the declarations and recommendations adopted on the climate for 14 years by the Conference of INGOs).
