- Decision regarding Marcis Skadmanis' proposal support through Microsoft Philanthropies it is agreed (with input from AS, PS and CS), that this can have a frame of critical dialogue partnership, to not walk into a trap of tech-washing (AS, PS, CS), but to engage this partnership as a dynamic process, with important input from civil society.
