# 27th Plenary meeting

Strasbourg, 29 November – 2 December 2011

ABRIDGED REPORT

DG I – Human Rights and Rule of Law

The Consultative Committee of the Convention for the Protection of Individuals with regard to Automatic Processing of Personal Data (T-PD), established under Article 18 of the *Convention for the Protection of Individuals with regard to Automatic Processing of Personal Data* [ETS No. 108], held its 27<sup>th</sup> meeting in Strasbourg from 29 November to 2 December 2011, with Mr Jean-Philippe Walter (Switzerland) in the chair. The agenda, as adopted by the T-PD, and the list of participants are set out in Appendices I and II.

#### The T-PD:

1. gave a first reading of the **proposals of modifications to Convention 108** drawn up on the basis of the results of a public consultation process and the work carried out in the Bureau, and instructed the latter to review these proposals in the light of the exchange of views and comments made, with a view to a written consultation of delegations in early 2012;

2. took note of the Study on **Recommendation (89)2** on the protection of personal data used for **employment** purposes, drafted by Mr Giovanni Buttarelli and asked its Bureau to finalise the corresponding draft Recommendation in 2012;

3. took note of the preliminary report by Mr Joseph Cannataci and Ms Mireille Caruana on **Recommendation (87)15** on regulating the use of personal data in the **police** sector and invited those delegations which had not already done so to reply to the questionnaire by 28 February 2012. Delegations which had already forwarded their replies could, in the meantime, supplement or amend the information previously provided;

4. took note of the presentation by Mr Joël Sollier from **Interpol** and of the new code on data processing in the light of the challenges of international police co-operation.

5. took note of the information on **Data Protection Day** 2011 and of the initiatives for the 2012 event, and of the major developments and activities in the data protection field since its last plenary meeting;

6. took note of the information presented by Ms Jacqueline Peschard concerning the 33<sup>rd</sup> **International Conference of Data Protection and Privacy Commissioners** (Mexico, 2-3 November 2011) and thanked her for the opportunity that was provided to promote Convention 108 during this "privacy week", and in particular at the General Assembly of the Ibero-American Network of Data Protection (RIPD);

7. discussed its **work programme** for the coming years;

8. held an exchange of views with the Steering Committee on the Media and New Communication Services (**CDMC**) and took note of the finalisation by this Steering Committee of the draft recommendations on social networks and on search engines;

9. adopted its **opinion** on Parliamentary Assembly **Recommendation 1984(2011)** on "the protection of privacy and personal data on the Internet and online media";

10. determined the criteria to be applied in examining the possible admission of new **observers** and took a positive decision on the request from the European Association for the Defence of Human Rights (AEDH) to obtain Observer status.

11. agreed on the amendments to be made to its rules of procedure;

12. elected Ms Nevena Ružić (Serbia) successor member of the Bureau for a term of office lasting until the next plenary meeting;

13. elected Ms Eva Souhrada-Kirchmayer Council of Europe Data Protection Commissioner, and warmly thanked the previous Commissioner, Mr Karel Neuwirt, for his commitment and the excellent quality of his work;

14. took note of the dates of the 28<sup>th</sup> plenary meeting (19-22 June 2012), as well as of the dates of the Bureau (6-8 February 2012 in Strasbourg and 16-18 April 2012 in Paris).
