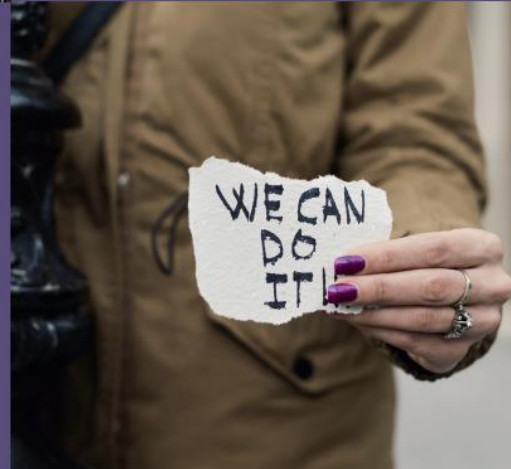

# How we do co-operation?

The project teams apply a systematic approach to planning, implementing and monitoring the activities carried out within the project by:

- Identifying concrete **needs and challenges** of the beneficiary country in co-operation with national authorities.
- Establishing **budgetary and human resources** requirements.
- Defining measurable and sustainable **goals**.
- Monitoring progress to ensure **ownership and sustainability** of results.

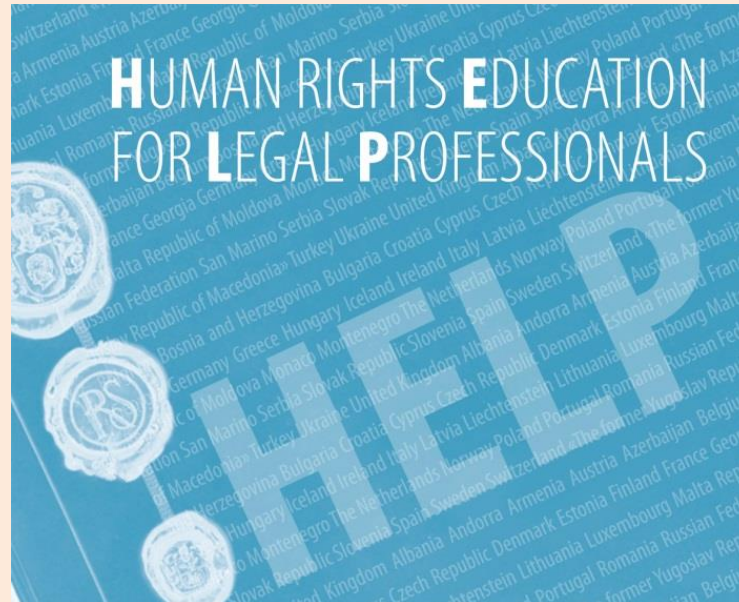
# Where do we currently work?




