- Western Balkans: Kosovo* (phase III July 2021)

- Targeted support upon demand: Latvia
- Co-operation with WAVE-Network and UN Women

Physical trauma

Psychological trauma

Feelings of shame and guilt



VICTIM

Personal, sometimes intimate and/or degrading facts

Link with the Abuser's (spouse, ex-spouse, neighbour, friend...)

Abuser's strategy (psychological control)

Furthermore, the victim's stressed state may not allow her to understand all the information, so you should use **short and easy-to-understand words**.

It is necessary to **reassure the victim**, to be present for her as much as possible.


