

Assets

The **image** of what the declarant owns, including abroad:

- Real estate assets,
- Financial investments.
- Bank accounts, etc.

IncomeLoans and debt

Interests and activities

All **information** related to:

Pecuniary interests of the declarant and his/her spouse:


- Professional activity,
- Secondary activities,
 - Actions, etc.

Non-pecuniary interests:

- Memberships or unremunerated positions,
 - Charities and volunteering, etc.



577 MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

Among them, 351 declared for the first time


COMPLIANCE WITH LEGAL DELAYS


Out of the 571 initial declarations

- 487 in compliance with the delays
- 84 after the deadline
- 6 missing declarations on 19 October

587 DECLARATIONS PUBLISHED

- 571 initial interests and activities declarations
- 16 modificative declarations






INCREMENTAL PUBLICATION OF ASSET DECLARATIONS FOR INCOMING MEMBERS OF THE PARLIAMENT

ACCESS LIMITED

- Specific disclosure for MPs
- Local Government offices

PUBLICATION WAVES

- After in-depth control of all declarations of the constituency
- 42 departements concerned



Departments where MPs assets declarations can be accessed (27 Oct. 2017)




PUBLICATION DILEMMA

Declarations are published **after being controlled**, creating a tension between:

- Publication of controlled and complete information (e.g. with a public statement, updates, etc.) to better inform citizens;
- Delays between reception and publication of declarations.





OPENNESS

- Declarations of candidates to the presidential elections (March 2017)
 - → 250 000 pages viewed in 48 hours
- Declarations of interests and activities of incoming deputies (October 2017):
 - → 200 000 pages viewed in 48 hours
- Publicity of declarations: importance of the data format
 - → Open data




TWO COMPLEMENTARY COMPONENTS OF A THOROUGH CONTROL






DATA COLLECTION – INSTRUMENTS AND PARTNERSHIPS





A DATA-DRIVEN CONTROL STRATEGY



OBJECTIVES

- Control the consistency and completeness;
- Investigate potential omissions or unexplained variations during office

CLEAR ENFORCED SANCTIONS





INFRACTIONS AND SANCTIONS

INCRIMINATION	SANCTION
Non-submission of a declaration	3-year imprisonment, 45 000 € fine and loss of civic rights
Non-submission of an end-of-mandate declaration for a member of the Parliament	15 000 € fine
Substantial omission or false declaration	3-year imprisonment, 45 000 € fine and loss of civic rights
Non-compliance with an injunction	1-year imprisonment, 15 000 € fine
Non-communication of requested information or elements	1-year imprisonment, 15 000 € fine



FIRST RESULTS

REFERRALS TO PROSECUTORS

- 25 cases referred;
- Systematic judicial investigations and proceedings.

SANCTIONS – FIRST EXAMPLES

- April 2016: six-month suspended sentence and 60 000€ fine for a **senator**;
- September 2016: a 1-year ineligibility and 2-month suspended sentence and a 5 000€ fine for a former Minister;
- November 2016: 45 000€ fine for a member of the National assembly;
- October 2017: four-month suspended sentence and a 30 000€ fine for a former **Member of the** National Assembly.



OTHER REFERRALS

CORRUPTION INCRIMINATIONS

- About 20 additional referrals on suspicions of :
 - Illegal taking of interest
 - Nepotism
 - Embezzlement
 - Corruption



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
