In the Kozjansko Regional Park, the apple is no mere fruit. Green woodpecker Common redstart Eurasian wryneck Common redstart, red-backed shrike, High-trunk meadow orchards, important hawfinch, greenfinch, European Natura 2000 protection areas, are an goldfinch and blackbird extremely important habitat for birds: the green nestle amidst the woodpecker, grey-headed woodpecker, wryneck, treetops of fruit trees. hoopoe, little owl and the Eurasian scops owl. Red-backed shrike Hoopoe Eurasian scops owl



Butterflies, ladybirds, bees, bumblebees, earwigs, and beetles maintain the natural balance in the orchard.
