He was Director General for Probation and Prison Services for two times (1994-2001 and 2016-2019).

From 1995 until 2015 he was member of the CPT (Committee for the Prevention of Torture) elected on respect of Portugal and Vice President of the Europrise European Prison and Correctional Services (2018/2019) and at present time he is member of OSCOT Observatory on Security, Organized Crime and Terrorism and of the International Penal and Penitentiary Foundation and of the International Penal and Penitentiary Foundation.
