



**Jesper Hjortenberg** was appointed National Member for Denmark at Eurojust on 1 September 2010. He has been a prosecutor since 1988 and has worked at the Office of the Danish Director of Public Prosecutions for many years. From 2002 to 2007, he was Head of the International Division of the DPP's Office, and since 2007 served as Deputy Director with responsibility for casework and international matters. He prosecuted a large number of cases before the Danish Supreme Court from 1996 to 2010. Mr Hjortenberg participated

in negotiations for the EU 2000 Convention on mutual legal assistance and the 2002 Eurojust Decision as part of the Danish delegation at the meetings in Brussels, and has been Danish member of the Council of Europe Steering Committee on Crime Problems (CDPC) for many years. He is currently Vice Chair of the CDPC and was earlier Vice-Chair and Chair of the CDPC from 2011 to 2015.
