

Miroslav Mikolášik (1952) holds a postgraduate certificate in general medicine, anaesthesiology and reanimation and studied at Medical Faculty of the Charles University in Prague. During his political career, in 1999 he was appointed Ambassador of the Slovak Republic to Canada. In 2004, he was elected Member of the European Parliament, re-elected in 2009 and 2014. As a member of the Christian Democratic Party in the Slovak Republic, which is part of the European People's Party, Miroslav Mikolášik sits on the European Parliament's Committee on Environment, Public Health and Food Safety (ENVI), Committee on Regional Development (REGI) and the Subcommittee on Human Rights (DROI). He is the founder and honorary president of the non-profit association Donum Vitae and he also lectured at the Institute of Medical Ethics in Bratislava. In 1978 - 1990, 1992 - 1994 and 2002 - 2004 he was practising medicine. Currently he serves as chairman of the EPP Working Group on Bioethics and Human Dignity in the European Parliament.
