

Ina Verzivolli is the Chairperson of the Albanian State Agency for Child Rights and Child Protection, the agency mandated with monitoring the implementation of the rights of the child in Albania as well as the lead agency in child protection. She is dedicated to strengthening the protection of children's rights in Albania, with a particular focus on building an effective and integrated child protection system. Ms. Verzivolli has led the process of drafting of new legislation on child rights protection, the national action plan for child rights and is currently involved in the coordination of the plan of action for the protection of children in street situation.

She is also involved with child rights at the international level and is currently the chairperson of the Ad Hoc Committee on the Rights of the Child of the Council of Europe, as well as member of the Lanzarote Committee for the Protection of Children from Sexual exploitation and abuse. Since 2014, she is the national focal point for the Council of European Network of Children's Rights Coordinators.

Ms. Verzivolli has graduated in International Development Studies M.Sc. at the Geneva Graduate Institute (HEID). She has previously worked on the issues of child's right to health, food and nutrition, business and human rights, women's rights and sustainable livelihoods. She has a broad experience in international advocacy working closely with international organisations and human rights bodies, and in particular the Committee on the Rights of the Child.
