

Kavot Zillén holds a doctoral degree (LL.D) in Medical Law from Uppsala University in Sweden and is currently a post-doc researcher at the faculty of law, Stockholm University Centre for the Rights of the Child (Barnrättscentrum). Her dissertation focuses on human rights in health care, specifically: the right to health, freedom of religion and the prohibition on discrimination. Her current research is on EU-migrant Childrens Right to Healthcare in Sweden. She has been the Course Director for a Medical Law course at the Faculty of Law and responsible for a course on freedom of religion in secular and religious cultures at the Faculty of Theology in Uppsala. Since 2014 she has been teaching a summer course, together with a colleague, at the Summer Institute in Bioethics at Yale University on comparative human rights and health.
