UN Congress for Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice (Salvador, Brazil, 2010) ► Intergovernmental Expert Group on Cybercrime (meetings 2011 - 2021)

UN General Assembly ► Third Committee ► UNGA Resolution 74/247 (December 2019) ► New treaty process to commence in 2020 (organizational meeting end-August 2020)

UN General Assembly > First Committee > UN Group of Governmental Experts (GGE) on Advancing responsible State behaviour in cyberspace in the context of international security (since 2004)

UN General Assembly ► First Committee ► Open-Ended Working Group on Developments in the Field of ICTs in the Context of International Security (OEWG) (established in 2018)
