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1. Judicial organisation in Czech Republic (2021 data)

The Czech Republic has a four-tier court system.

In 2021, the number of courts considered as legal entities is 98. Namely, there are 97 courts of general jurisdiction.

There are no first instance specialised courts. However, there is one highest instance specialised court which is the Supreme Administrative Court.

Among the 97 legal entities of general jurisdiction, 86 act at first instance, 10 at second instance and one at third instance. In terms of geographic locations, there are 107 courts among which 89 are of first instance. In fact, 6 Regional courts and 3 district courts have their branches in other cities.

According to 2021 data, the total number of professional judges sitting in courts (all instances) in Czech Republic is 2 990, which is -0,6% less than in previous cycle.

More precisely, in the Czech Republic, there are 28,43 professional judges per 100 000 inhabitants (this figure is above the EU median of 24,11 judges per 100 000 inhabitants) and about 3,32 nonjudge staff per judge.

There is no significant difference compared with previous cycle when this ratio was at 3,30 non-judge staff per judge.

In this cycle, the total number of female professional judges (all instances) is 1 798, which represents 60,1% of the total number of judges.

The total number of judges is distributed among the different judicial instances in the following way: 1 819 are sitting in first instance courts (of which 1 213 are Female); 1 065 are sitting in second instance courts (of which 560 are Female) and 106 are sitting in Supreme Court (of which 25 are Female).

Compared with the EU distribution of professional judges per instance, the trend in the Czech Republic is similar. The number of first instance judges is predominant but lower than at the EU level. The number of second instance judges is higher than the EU median, while the number of third instance judges is slightly lower.

As regards the distribution of the number of judges among the different judicial instances, the Czech Republic presents some peculiarities which should be mentioned. Indeed, the Czech Republic has a four-tier system. The number of judges of the two High Courts is included in the number of second instance judges. This methodology of presentation of data is applied since 2013, while for the previous evaluations, magistrates of the High Courts were considered as third instance judges.

As regards the distribution male/female, it has to be specified that female judges do not have the majority only at third instance.

In 2021, the Czech Republic has 9 914 non-judge staff (of which 8 646 are Female). The total number of non-judge staff in comparison with the previous cycle reveals a decrease of -0,1%. The category "other" encompasses judicial trainees or staff in charge of court documentation, press centre and telephone exchange. The judicial trainee is entitled to perform the acts of the court under the conditions and to the extent specified in factual and time plan of the preparatory service which is compiled by the chairman of the regional court after consultation with the advisory board for the education of trainees. Nowadays, there are few judicial trainees and in 2022 the title is replaced by a "judicial candidate".

In 2021, criminal law cases appear to be the fastest in the Czech Republic, more specifically in the second instance, which is similar to the trend observed in the EU for the reference year. At the same time, third instance administrative law cases are the longest in the Czech Republic, and somewhat above the EU median for this type of cases. In all matters, the total length of proceedings in the Czech Republic is well below the EU median, especially for civil litigious cases but also criminal law cases.

At first instance, the Clearance Rate indicator is satisfactory for all types of cases, exceeding the 100% threshold. The Disposition Time is also below the EU median for all types of cases.

At second instance, courts also seem to efficiently deal with cases, as the Clearance Rate is above the 100% threshold for civil litigious and criminal law cases. Accordingly, the Disposition Time is below the EU median for both types of cases.

For the third instance, the Clearance Rate indicator is satisfactory for civil litigious and criminal law cases, while for administrative law cases, courts seem to be less efficient, with a Clearance Rate below the 100% threshold. Accordingly, the Disposition Time is below the EU median for civil litigious and criminal law cases, while for administrative law cases it followed its upward trend and appears well above the EU median.

With a Clearance Rate calculated at 103,5% in 2021, the Czech Republic seems to be able to deal with its first instance Civil (and commercial) litigious cases. Between 2020 and 2021, the Clearance Rate has increased by 5,5 points.

There are many reasons why the prosecution could be discontinued and it is difficult to say under which category they should be included. However, the reasons may include the following: 1. if such prosecution concerns a person who is exempt from the competencies of the law enforcement authorities or a person for whom the law requires an official consent for their prosecution, if such consent was not awarded by an entitled authority, unless the exemption is temporary or unless the criminal prosecution of the person is inadmissible due to lack of consent only temporarily; 2. if it concerns a person who is below the age of criminal responsibility;

3. if it is against a person whose mental illness, that occurred after the criminal offence was committed, makes it permanently impossible for them to understand the purpose of the criminal prosecution; 4. many others.

The availability of writing assistance tools depends on the court agenda. Some information systems for specific agendas can automatically create documents based on the predefined template, data stored in the system and the selected procedural action by a user. Some older information systems have a dedicated external application that allows the creation of the required documents based on user input (application called "APSTR"), and for some court agenda the writing assistance tools are not available at all.

Regarding the process of coordinating new templates, the origin of the templates varies. Some are developed by the Ministry of Justice, others are created on the national level in cooperation with experts and court staff. Templates created at the national level can be and are modified in some court agendas at the local level by individual courts or in some cases by individual users.

Most courtrooms have installed specific voice recording tools for recording several separate audio tracks. The project regarding "spoken word-to-text conversion" was realized in the proof-of-concept stage. Based on the results of the project and other factors, the spoken word-to-text project has been included in the National Recovery Plan and will be realized in the upcoming years.

All Czech courts are using for budgetary and financial management an information system called IRES. This system is used to generate and manage payment transactions, record assets, receivables, payables and other related areas. Although the IRES system (in the sense of all local court distributions) communicates with the National Treasury, which could be thought of as a centralized point where data is consolidated at the national level, it is not a tool/system that allows for easy data consolidation or direct analytical activities for the benefit of judicial agendas.

The IRES system is not primarily used for the justice expenses management of exclusively judicial items such as court fees, litigation costs, etc. This data is not available to the chiefs judges of the courts from the IRES system in a comprehensive form and on a court-by-court basis. Selected judicial information systems that manage the certain justice agenda are able to report the necessary information on justice expense data. These information systems then use IRES to make and record payments.
