Compendium SURVEY: Barriers to Freedom of Artistic Expression

• AIM:

Identify Potential Status Quo and Developments of FoAE in European Countries from 2 Perspectives:

- 1. gather objective information about legal and administrative frameworks
- 2. gather subjective opinions about the related challenges and barriers
- Survey Responses: 35 countries



Survey Results: Status Quo of Freedom of Artistic Expression

PART of LEGAL FRAMEWORK

- Freedom of Expressions
 - Is part of the constitutions of **46** countries
 - Freedom of Artistic Expressions is explicitly named

in the constitutions of **30** countries





Survey Results: Status Quo of Freedom of Artistic Expression

MEASURES

- the right to participate in cultural life: **71.4** %
- the right to have artistic work supported, distributed, remunerated: 70.6 %
- the right to freedom of movement: 64.6 %
- the right to freedom of association: 62.9 %
- the right to protection of social and economic rights: 61.8 %
- the right to create without censorship or intimidation: 48.6 %

GOOD PRACTICE EXAMPLES

- Basic income for artists (pilot project in Ireland)
- Social securities for artists (as e.g. in Poland and Germany)
- Fair Pay Measures (as e.g. in Austria)
- Cultural participation measures (as e.g. in Latvia)
- Ethical guidelines (as e.g. in Finland and Luxembourg)

Survey Conclusions: QUO VADIS Freedom of Artistic Expression



GENERAL TREND in EUROPE

- In Europe, freedom of artistic expression is officially at a good level, both in terms of law and measures that govern this right
- There is however a clear potential for improvement in the area of monitoring, complaints, awareness raising and policy discourse
- FoAE is in a good current state, but **over time FoAE it is facing more restrictions**
- Political climate restricts most FoAE instrument: access to funding
- It is an to fight for our rights
- The first rights to be challenged are often cultural rights and FoAE
- **OUR DUTY:** Future Monitoring of Freedom of Artistic Expressions → **More FoAE Surveys**
