Who is DaMigra?



- The first nationwide umbrella association of migrant women's self-organizations (MSO) regardless of their origin.
- DaMigra is politically, ideologically and denominationally independent.
- Founded in 2015: Speaks for more than 60 member organizations
- Main resource: voluntary work of migrant women + project funding

DaMigra e.V. represents nationwide the interests of migrant women organizations, and migrant and refuge women vis-à-vis the state, politics and society.




What are we doing? Our objectives:




Our demands:

A Comprehensive participation needs:

- Legal certainty
- Housing security
 - Accommodation of refugee women* and their children in flats and flat-sharing communities
- Non-violence
 - Consistent implementation of the Istanbul Convention
- Recognition of resources
- Participation in labor market
 - effective measurements to stop downward mobility of migrant women
- Social security
 - Participation in social life in one's own community and in the mainstream society
