- External relations of the Assembly cover national parliaments of member states, of non-member states, international parliamentary assemblies and international intergovernmental organisations and are governed by decisions of the Bureau of the Assembly.
- Whilst relations with national parliaments are covered by the provisions of membership, special guest or observer status, the PACE has developed its contacts with other international parliamentary assemblies such as the European Parliament, the Parliamentary Assembly of the OSCE, the Inter-Parliamentary Union, Benelux, the Nordic Council, PABSEC, CIS and others.
