

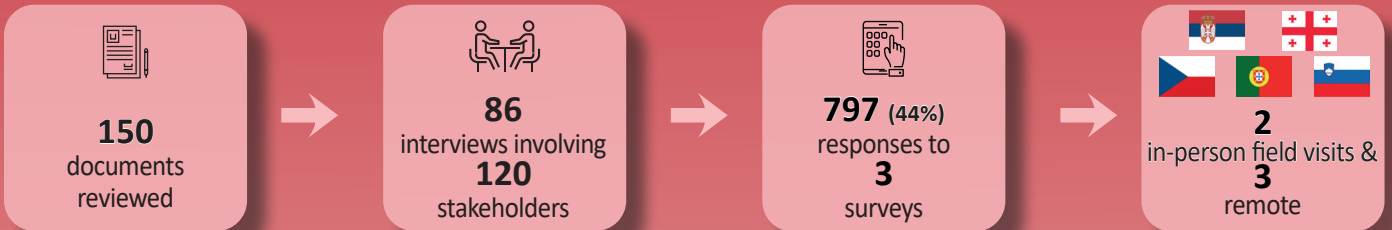
EVALUATION OF CIVIL SOCIETY PARTICIPATION IN CO-OPERATION ACTIVITIES (2023)

- ▶ Relevance: optimising co-operation activities' opportunities
- ▶ Efficiency: fairness and transparency towards inclusion and diversity
- ▶ Effectiveness: bringing co-operation activities closer to citizens
- ▶ Coherence: Council of Europe uniqueness with civil society and authorities

Strengths and ways to improve

- 1 The Council of Europe successfully manages politically sensitive relationships such as between CSOs and authorities
- 2 Civil society participation in co-operation activities improves project results and reinforces CSOs' influence over authorities regarding human rights
- 3 Greater potential links at organisational level with local CSOs not fully taken advantage of
- 4 More depth and breadth to civil society participation in co-operation activities desirable
