KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

Better treatment for victims of trafficking

Increased knowledge of health professionals in contact with potential victims of trafficking in particular for proactive identification and referral.

Increased capacity to fight against economic crime

Better institutional capacities of staff from the State Commission for Prevention of Corruption on matters related to financial crimes, with a particular focus on money laundering vulnerabilities.

Enhanced awareness about free legal aid

Promotional activities concerning the Law on Free Legal Aid reached more than 120 000 rights-holders.

HIGHLIGHT

The action "Combating Hatred and Intolerance" supported an initiative of the Ministry for Labour and Social Policy, namely a caravan with open-air events called "Leave a Mark", aiming to reach out to people, especially youth, and provoke discussions about gender equality and the fight against hate speech and discrimination, including personal experience in overcoming barriers and contributing sustainable change in society.
