Activities in 2024



Mandate:

Disaster preparedness (more) and prevention (less)

Structure:

10 national civil protection authorities (4 EU member states, 6 associated countries), all members of Union Civil Protection Mechanism.



Main activities:

- Two decision making regional meetings
- 7 to 10 Disaster Management Training Program (DMTP) events in a format of workshop, seminars and trainings. In 2024, the topics of the events referred to project design, publicprivate partnership, dog handlers in search and rescue operations, use of ICS/DSS, emergency management in dealing with forest fires and stress management.
- Participation of DPPI SEE Secretariat and members states in other relevant events.



Main activities of DPPI SEE Secretariat:

- By invitation, participation in other relevant events.
- In lack of solved legal status in the Parliament of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Secretariat facilitates the involvement of concerned NCPA in competitive project applications and funding programs.
- Secretariat represents DPPI SEE in networks in initiatives as following:
 - DHL and UNDP's GoHelp Program and GARD project.
 - UNICEF (MoU signed in 2024, 7 activities in child sensitive policy in civil protection and DRM will follow until the end of 2026).
 - Serving as a Global focal point for Sphere standards (MoU signed in 2023, as an achievement of continuous implementation of ToT in the last five years)
 - Regional hub for UNDRR MCR campaign. In 2024 worked on action plan for future activities with UNDP and UNDRR.
 - Member of advisory board/steering committee in regional projects encompassing Western Balkans and Türkiye (OSA. Multi-hazard, IPA CARE).
 - Associate entity of RCC specialized for disaster preparedness and prevention, as stated in RCC Strategy 2020-2030.
 - Center in the network of the Council of Europe's EUR-OPA Major Hazards Agreement.
