Objectives

- To explore the UN 2250 on Youth Peace and Security and its relevance for young people in Euro-Arab co-operation
- To share and recognize needs and challenges faced by young people and youth organisations in their work for peacebuilding, security and dialogue
- To share practices and experiences in peacebuilding for mutual learning
