



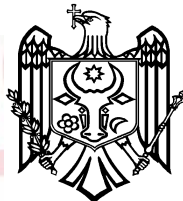

## **Brief introduction**

This is a national dissemination event organized by the Pestalozzi Programme of the Council of Europe in cooperation with the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Moldova.

Seminar goals:

- To improve managerial skills and managerial effectiveness in schools.
- To promote training activities in the field of educational management and leadership in the context of initial and continuous training programs of teachers and managers;
- To promote and consolidate in schools an educational leadership based on the principles of equity and learning.

Participants:

- 30 managers of general secondary education institutions.

Facilitators:

- 3 experts (two from the Pestalozzi Programme and one national facilitator)

## Event evaluation

The event gathered 30 participants from the Capital and other regions of the country – they were evenly distributed, half being from Chisinau and the other half from different counties in the Republic. 28 completed the questionnaire distributed at the end of the event. None of the participants was dissatisfied with the methods used in the seminar.

The scale 1-5 was used for evaluation, 1 being very low/not satisfied/not useful and 5 – very high/very satisfied/very useful.

The participants were asked to highlight what were (in their opinion) three of the things they found useful whether professional and/or personal – in terms of values, skills and knowledge. Among these they listed:

- Planning/Setting Goals
- Motivating strategies
- Involvement/Teamwork
- Time Management
- Self-Management
- Leadership
- Analysing and interpreting data and situations
- Diagnosing problems and identifying relevant causal factors
- Predicting and forecasting
- Communicating
- Implementing actions and monitoring them.
- Strategies of interaction with all the educational actors (teachers, students, parents)

Most of the participants expressed a desire to participate in further such events organized by the Pestalozzi Programme as they view them as a means to improve, a great opportunity for professional improvement; it broadened their understanding of the importance of continuous professional and personal improvement, improve leadership skills and proved an encouragement for personal reflection on training needs.

*“I would like to. It was a very interesting experience.”*

*“I want to improve myself as a teacher and as a manager. These kinds of training activities are a great opportunity for professional improvement. I am looking forward to participate in other trainings organized by Pestalozzi Programme.”*

*“Yes – if I will have the opportunity to participate in such kind of activities.”*

*“Yes, I would like to participate at other training events organized by CoE and Pestalozzi Programme. This seminar made me understand the importance of continuous professional and personal improvement.”*

*“I am a young school manager and I lack experience. I find this kind of training very useful for me because I want to improve my leadership skills. That is why I will use every training opportunity especially offered by Pestalozzi Programme.”*
