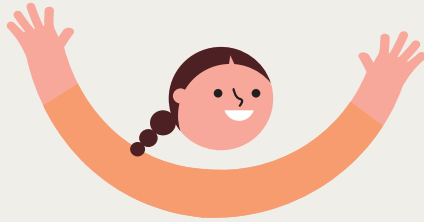
Scenarios in which they are applied:

- The child combines distance learning at a Ukrainian school with attending a school in their country of residence.
- The child studies at a Saturday or Sunday Ukrainian school, as well as at a formal school in their country of residence.
- The child studies only at a school in their country of residence.
- The child studies only at a Ukrainian school (remotely or via the UIS).



DISTANCE LEARNING AT A UKRAINIAN SCHOOL

Is available in two formats



The country of residence requires attending a local school



Host country school

UKRAINIAN STUDIES COMPONENT

This is a shortened program adapted for children studying abroad.

The program includes:

- Only 5–8 hours per week instead of the standard 25–38 hours of the full school curriculum.
- A focus on subjects essential for preserving national identity: Ukrainian language, Ukrainian literature, history of Ukraine, geography, defence of Ukraine, and civic education.



On the new platform, parents can submit an application without any unnecessary difficulties.

LEARNING IN SATURDAY OR SUNDAY SCHOOLS ABROAD

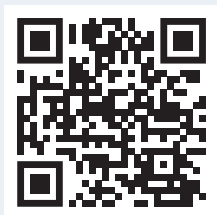
If your child attends a Saturday or Sunday school abroad, they can have their learning outcomes formally acknowledged within the Ukrainian education system.



For this:

- The Saturday or Sunday school teaches the Ukrainian Studies Component.
- The school undergoes verification by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine.

Learning outcomes from other subjects (for example, mathematics or science) that a child completes at a local school are recognized by the Ukrainian school according to established scales.

UKRAINIAN INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL

This is a state educational institution that provides access to high-quality Ukrainian education regardless of the child's place of residence.

Education is delivered through a flexible externship model, allowing students to choose a convenient format and pace. Upon completion of the academic year, students receive state-issued education certificates recognized in Ukraine and fully compliant with all educational standards.

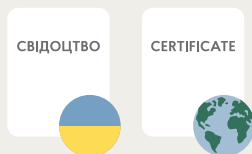

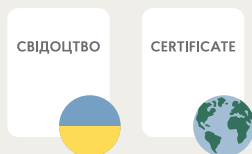

The child studies only at a school in another country.

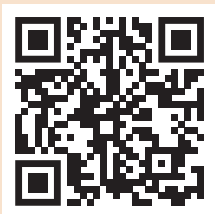
