

The European Forum for Restorative Justice (EFRJ) is organising the following events:

- On 13 November 2023, Paris, France. The EFRJ annual meeting of the **European Restorative Justice Policy Network** (ERJPN), that brings together representatives of the Ministries dealing with restorative justice or related matters in Europe, to create links across borders, offer exchange of information and support for further developing restorative justice policies in European countries. The main topics of the 2023 meeting will be the use of restorative justice in cases of violence against women and the Istanbul Convention as well as the European Commission proposed revision of the Victims' Rights Directive.
- On 19 25 November 2023. Every year, on the 3rd week of November, it is Restorative Justice Week. During this international campaign individual pioneers and well-established organisations working in the field of restorative justice organise a series of events to raise awareness about restorative justice. This year's theme highlights the relevance of restorative justice when it comes to facing the great challenges of our times. - On 5 9 February 2024, Leuven, Belgium. The EFRJ is organizing its 2nd Winter Academy. The Winter Academy creates an international learning opportunity for those interested in restorative justice and its high-quality applications in different contexts. It includes three parallel practice-oriented courses led by experienced trainers. The event also offers common learning activities for the participants of all courses to allow cross-disciplinary exchange and shared learning experience. The three courses will address the following topics: Facilitating restorative justice processes in cases involving children and young people; Trauma informed approach; Restorative training facilitation. - On 28 May 2024 Tallinn, Estonia. The EFRJ is organising a **one day training** on countering systemic power in restorative practice.
- On 29-31 May 2024, Tallinn, Estonia. The EFRJ is organising its **12th International Conference** that will focus on the potential of restorative justice at dark times, times when conflict, war and violence are either present or threaten most nations, regions and communities. While restorative justice is widely used to respond to interpersonal conflicts and to challenge existing punitive justice systems, this conference wishes to open the discussion on the role of restorative justice in responding to larger scale war, conflict, and violence and their implications, while at the same time transforming those structural and entrenched societal dynamics that feed them.
