She has dedicated her entire career to higher education and educational innovation. She completed a Master's degree at ESC, followed by her studies in Business Management and Human Resources at HEC, Paris.

A fervent activist for the defense of human rights and interculturality, Claude has been involved in associations from a very young age and later served as a local elected official.

Convinced of the importance of cooperation, today she continues her work as the Chairwoman of the FEDE for higher and professional education, promoting civic skills, democratic values, and sustainable development.
