



CoE-ERYICA Partnership Activities in 2023

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1. Ensuring quality youth information support young refugees in transition to adulthood

- **Upgrading the YoMIM training course** (both eLearning & F2F) to ensure that its objectives and resources also equip youth information workers to support young people facing forced migration
 - Youth on the Move - Infomobility (YoMIM) trains youth information workers to address the specific information and support needs of young people in the context of cross-European mobility
 - A new module has been added to the course, both in the face-to-face and in the eLearning version, on forced mobility
 - The new module discusses the types of migration and its background, and how to reach out and provide information, guidance and counselling to this target group

1. Ensuring quality youth information support young refugees in transition to adulthood (cont.)

- **Piloting the new YoMIM course online** with youth information workers from across Europe
 - 2 October – 10 November 2023
 - On ERYICA's DOYIT eLearning platform
 - 3 webinars
 - Self-paced and collaborative activities
 - 2 eTrainers and 1 shadow trainer
 - 20 participants from 8 countries registered for the course



2. Implementation and promotion of the European Youth Information Quality Label



The Quality Label is designed and implemented for and with young people and linked to a set of **quality assessment criteria**, mechanisms and tools.

- Two rounds of application (deadlines 30 April and 31 October 2023)
- Two online info sessions
- Label awarded to 2 national/regional organisations and 5 local youth information providers
- Award ceremony at the 34th ERYICA General Assembly
- Next deadline: 30 April 2024



2. Implementation and promotion of the European Youth Information Quality Label (cont.)



European Youth Information Quality Label Task Force

- 2 meetings in 2023:
 - 5 May (online)
 - Helsinki, 7-8 September
- Dissemination strategy revised and updated
- Youth review streamlined
- 3-year review procedure established
- Task Force application for the new mandate (2024-2026) launched
