- **Information, disinformation, and democracy:** exploring informed youth participation in democratic processes

Proposed activity:

- Online training - Youth Information Mediator (JIMMY)

### **3. Continuing to advance the implementation of the European Youth Information Quality Label, with the invaluable support of our Task Force**



- Establish a new European Quality Label Task Force
- Organise two application periods and two info-sessions per year
- Allow the European Quality Label Task Force to meet twice a year - at least once face-to-face
- Support the Quality Label administration (Labelling Agreement, certification, award ceremony, prizes and database)
- Dissemination and promotion strategy

## 4. Expanding participation in a youth mental health seminar to include youth information providers from additional Council of Europe member states



Proposed activity:

- Seminar on mental health literacy in youth Information work
