Moreover, in the framework of the distribution support programme (scheme I), the Board decided, after examining the non-national European films distributed during the third trimester, to grant €80 367 to 8 distributors for 15 films distributed in the following 7 countries : Bosnia and Herzegovina, Hungary, Romania, Serbia, Switzerland, “The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia” and Turkey.
