In the framework of the **Distribution Support Programme**, (Support for marketing and **publicity costs**), the Board has decided to support **21 films** presented by **12 distributors**, for an amount of €153,516.

As a reminder, since 1 January 2017, the Distribution Support Programme is intended only for professionals based in Eurimages member States which do not have access to the <u>EU Creative</u> <u>Europe-MEDIA distribution programme, i.e.</u>: **Armenia, Georgia, Russian Federation, Switzerland and Turkey.**

EURIMAGES is a support fund for cinema co-production, theatrical distribution and exhibition established by the Council of Europe in 1988 (Eurimages@coe.int -<u>http://www.coe.int/Eurimages</u>).

Since it was set up in 1988, EURIMAGES has supported 1834 European co-productions for a total amount of approximately €545 million.
