















Special Investigation Techniques

Drawing on various international and regional instruments, SITs comprise a number of investigative techniques, such as:

- surveillance, including interception of communication
- covert investigations (i.e. undercover agents)
- controlled delivery
- informants
- Joint Investigation Teams (JITs)
- witness protection

The adjudication of some SITs (notably surveillance (viewed broadly) and covert investigations, have resulted in landmark jurisprudence, notably by the European Court of Human Rights.




