# Eurotransplant

- Allocation of deceased donor organs for 8 European countries
- Based on mandates from National competent Authorities formalized in country contracts
- One harmonized waiting list
- One central point for donor registration
- Elaborated set of matching rules based on:
  - Latest available scientific evidence
  - Joint rules for cross boarder allocation
  - National rules for national allocation
  - Ethical standards

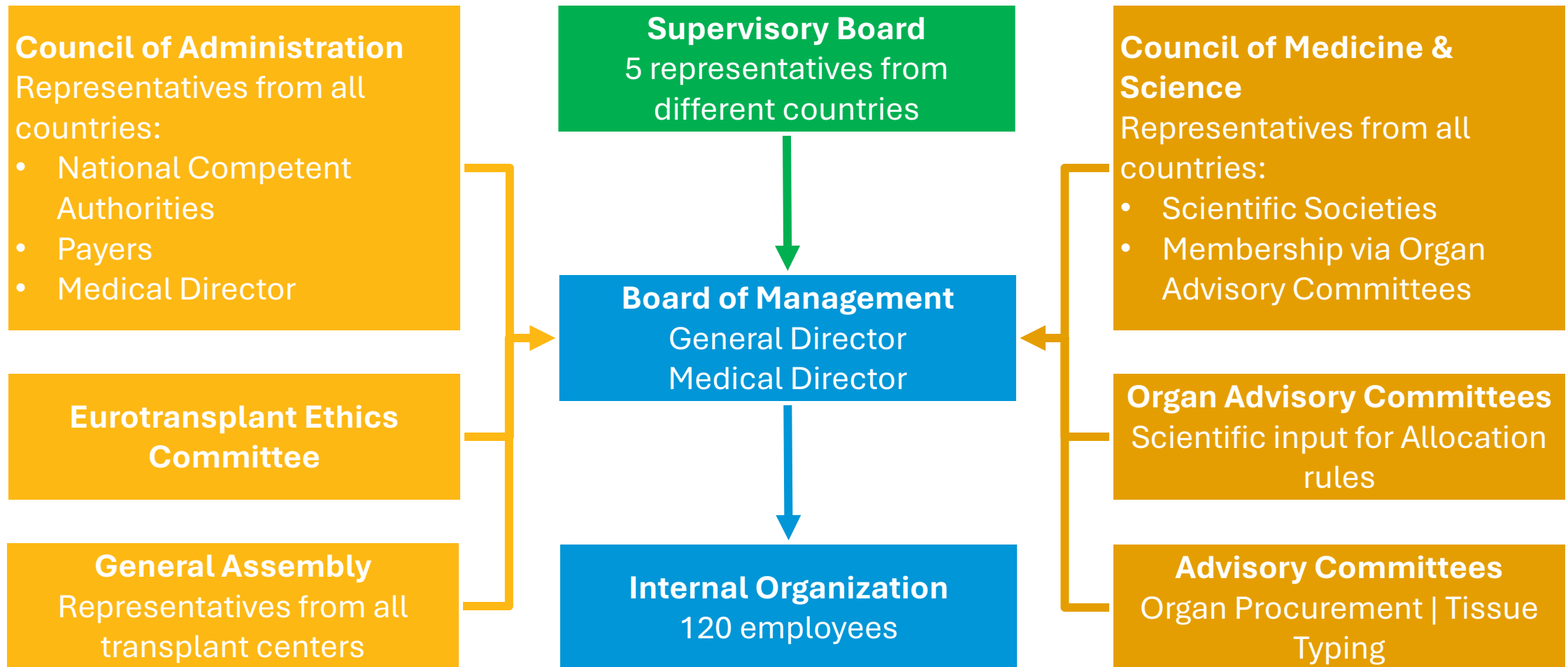

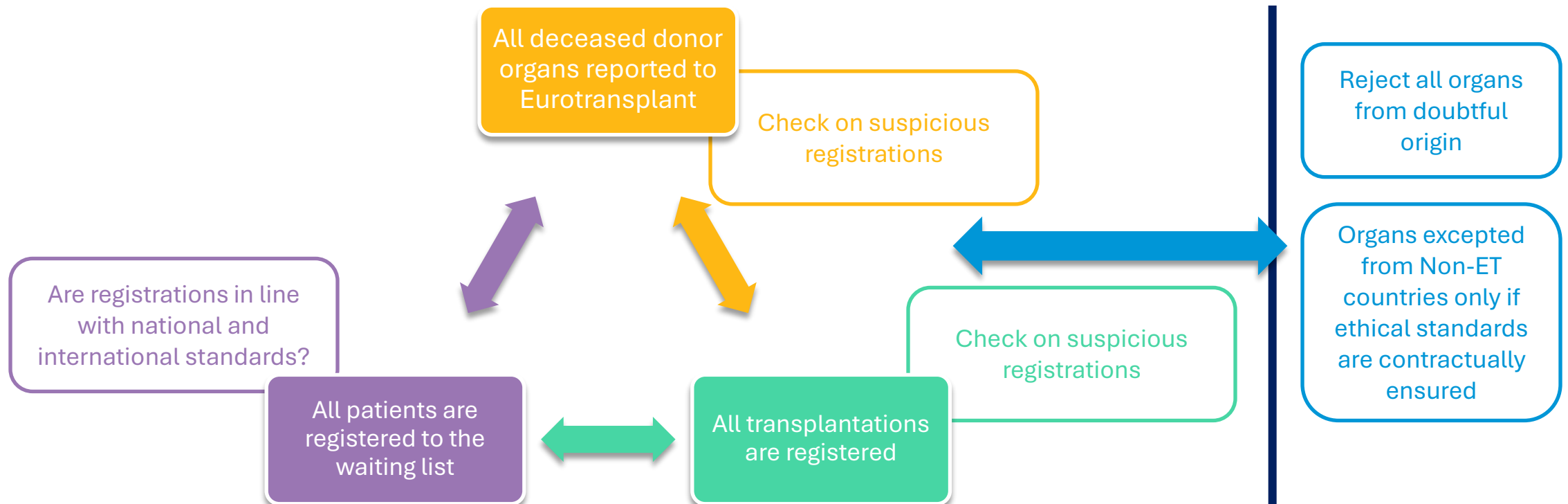
