

# RAINBOW YOUTH FOR SPORTING EQUALITY (RYSE)





#### Main aim:

improve experiences for lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, intersex and queer young people in sport by creating training for sports educators on LGBTIQ+ issues and experiences in sport.









### RYSE STEPS





- Partnership:
- LEAP Sports Scotland (GBR), EUSA Institute, assisted by Out in Slovenia (SLO), Queer Sport Split (CRO)
- Research: local focus groups (youth) and consultation events (sport educators)









### **RYSE TOOLS**







- Trainings: targeting sport educators
- Online module: wider accessibility and use









## RYSE CHARTER: FINDINGS & AREAS OF IMPROVEMENT





- Gendered Sport
- Changing Rooms
- Language

- Statement of Inclusion









## **Example: Language What can be improved?**





Co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union

- 1. Use inclusive or neutral language
- 2. Ask people for their pronouns
- 3. Stay away from all stereotyping
- 4. Use positive affirmations
- 5. Respect diversity
- 6. Embrace and encourage inclusion
- 7. Address the inappropriate and offensive language, by providing explanations or sanctioning

# RYSE & EUSA: IMPLEMENTATION AND CHALLENGES





#### - INTERNAL REGULATIONS

EUSA Development Strategy, Rules & Regulations, Code of Ethics, Incidents Policy [currently implemented on sexual orientation but not yet on gender identity and expression]

#### - COMPETITIONS

Currently male and female categories in competitions, not yet having a clear policy for trans\* athletes [Cf. International sports-governing bodies]

#### - POLITICAL CONTEXT

Having members - national university sports associations in 47 countries
