EXAMPLE OF AN BEGINNERS HATE SPEECH ANALYSIS

A French journalist <u>Eric Brunet shared an article from a right-wing news magazine 'Valeurs actuelles"</u> on Twitter about a farm in Rhone, France which is being squatted by a Roma family.

The comments below his post included a lot of hate speech against the Roma and Traveller community. Below is one example which we will analyse:

"If that kind of thing happened to me. I would not say anything to the police, and I would set fire to the house. No mercy."

Is the group targeted by the expression a potentially vulnerable group?

What type of acts of violence / discrimination have been carried out in recent years against the group targeted by the expression (worst act)?

In the <u>Written comments by the European Roma Rights Centre concerning France to the European</u> <u>Committee against Racism and Intolerance (ECRI)</u>, several acts of racist physical violence have recently been committed against members of the Roma community.



Status of the speaker? A regular citizen.



Any past actions of the speaker with regards to the group targeted by the expression? None that could be seen from his Twitter account (public account).

Any reaction of the speaker after promoting the hate message? None.

Expressed on a public post on Twitter.

Comment under a Twitter post, likely moderately efficient at reaching the intended audience.
